## MU entrepreneurs and inventors recognized at inaugural event

*Twenty-three patents of MU technologies were filed in fiscal 2013*

MU FACULTY did not invent the next Facebook during fiscal 2013. They did better, some who benefited from the breakthroughs might say.

On May 1, the University of Missouri celebrated its entrepreneurial spirit through faculty inventions and business creations at a breakfast in the Reynolds Alumni Center's Columns Room. Speaking at the event were Chancellor R. Bowen Loftin; Hank Foley, senior vice chancellor for research and graduate studies; and Steve Wyatt, vice provost for economic development.

Celebrated at the breakfast were businesses using MU technologies and faculty responsible for 23 patents for inventions of novel devices and innovative methods in fiscal 2013.

"It's pretty exciting to see what happens in the future," Wyatt said of MU's entrepreneurial spirit.

Patients needing an organ transplant might soon thank four MU professors in the Department of Physics and Astronomy for developing through cellular engineering a way to improve availability of human tissues and organs. The team filed the patent for the invention last year.

There are also a slew of MU

technologies already on the market. An athlete who suffers a catastrophic cartilage tear in the knee might make a 100 percent recovery thanks to a faculty member's invention that repairs damage to the meniscus.

## Staff Recognition Week celebrates 175 years of MU

*May 19-23 celebration includes awards, tours, seminars*

THE STAFF ADVISORY COUNCIL had an easy time choosing the theme for the annual Staff Recognition Week, kicking off May 19. This year it's "175 Years of Mizzou." The council wants to celebrate not only MU's more than 8,000 administrative, service and support employees but also the university's 175th birthday.

Starting the week is the Staff Recognition Awards Ceremony at 1:30 p.m. May 19 in Jesse Auditorium. The ceremony honors staff members who have reached a major anniversary in service at MU and recognizes the winners of the Chancellor's Outstanding Staff Awards, the Barbara S. Uehling Award for Administrative Excellence, the Mick Deaver Memorial Award and the Mizzou Alumni Association Award for Alumni Relations Excellence. The ceremony will include a slideshow featuring 175 faces and 175 places of Mizzou.

"Our goal was to seek out 175 different people and locations of MU because we have the tendency to forget we're not all right here on campus," said council President Becky Stafford. "The university is spread [throughout Columbia]."

New this year is a partnership between the staff council and MizzouRec, which from 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. May 22 will host at the MizzouRec complex a Fun Day of activities, including live music, Frisbee, washers, sand volleyball, a bungee run and dunking booth

"Chancellor Loftin has graciously agreed to sit in the dunking booth," Stafford said.

Staff members can also make use of the pool and Tiger Grotto, the 35-foot Scrogg's Peak climbing tower and the basketball courts.

## Faculty, staff and students weigh in on attributes of University of Missouri's next provost

*Senate Committee student says tenured faculty aren't always best teachers*

MEMBERS of the executive search firm Isaacson, Miller took part in a public forum April 30 in which the MU community discussed the hoped-for qualities of the next provost.

The event in Monsanto Auditorium in the Bond Life Sciences Center began with a question from the firm's president, Elizabeth Ramos: "What changes would you like to see with a new provost?"

Jack Schultz, director of the Bond Life Sciences Center, said he wants the new provost to have the ability to help break down academic boundaries. He also stressed that great communication skills should be an important characteristic of the provost, since the provost is in charge of all academic activities and policies.

Faculty members agreed that they would like to see more appreciation and recognition from the new provost.

Nancy West, director of the

Honors College, said she wants the provost to be a faculty advocate who can "boost morale in disciplines."

Members of Missouri Students Association's Senate Committee spoke for students.

#### Professor Judy Wall is chair of the provost search committee.

Jordan Bruening said that not all professors with tenure are great teachers, and it's a point for the new provost to consider.

"We're paying to take that class, and somebody who isn't a great teacher makes us feel we aren't getting our money's worth," Bruening said.

Other points made were that the new provost should have a close connection with faculty, staff

and students, be willing to make needed changes, and strive to increase MU's stature as an interdisciplinary research institution.

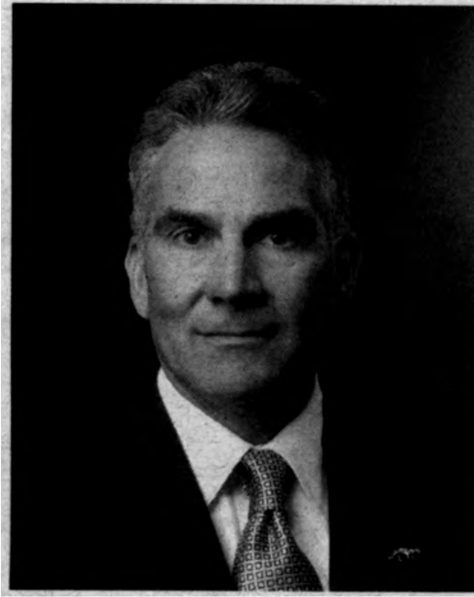
After the search firm meets with campus constituencies, it will synthesize the forum information into a position profile.

The profile document should offer a realistic summary of the challenges, measures of success and ideal qualifications for the position, members of the search firm said. Once the search committee has reviewed and approved this document, the firm will share it broadly with prospective candidates and key sources.

The search firm will work closely with the 15-member provost search committee, led by Judy Wall, joint Curators Professor of Biochemistry and Molecular Microbiology and Immunology. Eight faculty and a dean are on the committee.

## MIKE ALDEN

Director  
Intercollegiate Athletics

*Barbara S. Uehling Award for Administrative Excellence*

Mike Alden oversees all aspects of MU's Department of Intercollegiate Athletics. He also works with representatives of the National Collegiate Athletic Association and state and federal government officials on policies influencing college sports.

Alden has increased the department's budget from \$13.7 million to \$74 million since he became the director in 1998. He oversees about 200 full-time staff members and 650 part-time employees and graduate assistants. In 2012, he played a major role in moving Missouri from the Big 12 to the Southeastern Conference. The result has been increased revenue and interest from alumni.

"I've said many times that Mike Alden is the reason I'm at the University of Missouri," said football Coach Gary Pinkel. "I wouldn't have come here if he hadn't shown me his vision and belief that this could be a special place.

"His leadership has been instrumental in giving our program the resources we've needed to compete in the top conference in the nation," Pinkel continued. "Mike's got an astute mind for business and leadership and absolutely deserves to share credit for any success we have."

The community also has benefitted from Alden's involvement in the Food Bank for Central and Northeast Missouri, True North, the Muscular Dystrophy Association and other local organizations.



## BARBARA BREEN

Administrative Manager  
Office of Research

*Chancellor's Outstanding Staff Award*

During Barb Breen's more than three decades of service to MU, she has encountered many changes in technology and governmental and regulatory requirements. Breen, the administrative manager in the Office of Research, has remained the go-to person when it comes to issues ranging from human resources to fiscal operations for an office that supports about 450 staff with an annual budget of more than \$37 million. Breen is known for being impartial and fair.

"Barb's unruffled demeanor, professionalism and leadership style contributes to calm and steady attitudes within the Dalton Cardiovascular Research Center and departments with whom we work," said Gerald Meininger, director of the center.

Kate Wilson, senior staff specialist in the Sponsored Programs Administration, said Breen's focus goes beyond her role in the Office of Research and expands to the university as a whole, serving as an ambassador to the entire campus.

She has "the requisite skills and abilities sought in most leadership positions: excellent communication, organizational understanding, financial mastery and seasoned management expertise," said Karen Touzeau, association vice chancellor for Human Resource Services. "Her commitment to quality and service is unassailable."



## JOSH HARTLEY

System Support Analyst Expert  
Division of Biological Sciences  
College of Arts and Science

*Chancellor's Outstanding Staff Award*

When there is a problem with technology, the response is often confusion and frustration. That's not the case with Josh Hartley, a system support analyst expert for the Division of Biological Sciences, said co-worker Barb Sonderman, coordinator of the greenhouse facilities in the division. Hartley is always calm and laid back. "And he always fixes the problem, too," Sonderman said.

Hartley helps install, maintain and repair IT equipment in the division, which includes more than 500 computer systems and research equipment. He also maintains the division's 150 instructional computing labs; file, terminal and backup servers; and a large library system containing data for more than 180 computer volumes with more than 30 terabytes of data. He regularly works with faculty, staff and students concerning their computer needs, including configuring devices, software and research equipment.

Lisa Scheese, an academic adviser in the division, calls on Hartley whenever she needs help with a hardware or software issue or with website development.

"Not only is he willing, but he's also patient and works with you to identify the problem without using technical jargon that's over someone's head and never makes someone feel dumb for overlooking a simple fix," she said.

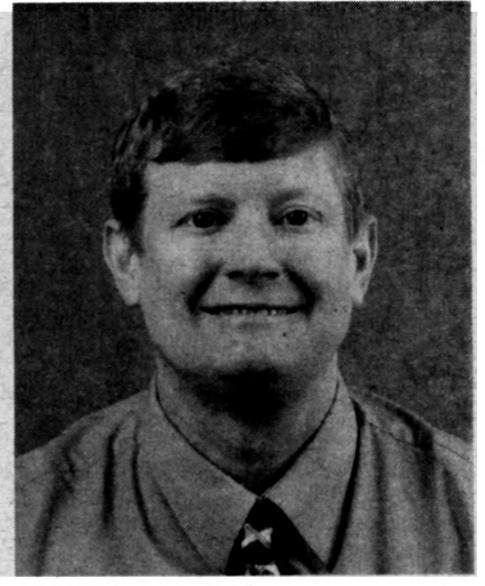
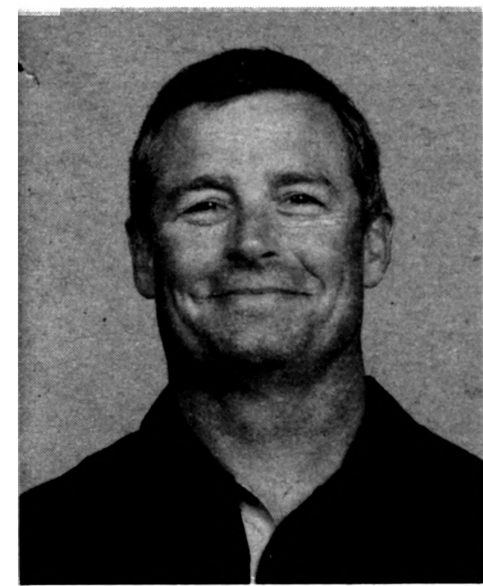

When football Coach Gary Pinkel is out of town, Andy Hill picks up the slack.

As associate head coach of the Missouri Tigers football team since 2012, Hill represents staff in Pinkel's absence. He also is an MU ambassador, making appearances and speaking at public events. His job duties include recruitment in the Midwest, particularly in the Kansas City area.

Hill has coached 12 seasons under Pinkel and 17 seasons overall at MU, making him the longest-tenured coach on the Tigers football staff. He started as a wide receivers coach, and in 2009 he began also coaching tight ends. Following the 2012 season, he was promoted to associate head coach and assumed the duties of coaching quarterbacks.

Hill, who graduated from MU in 1985, has a talent for building relationships among past, current and future MU students.

"He is always willing to give his time above and beyond the call of duty. He makes our alumni feel special to the university through his interactions with them," said nominator Bryan Maggard, senior associate athletic director for academic services.

"He is truly a player's coach as he fosters genuine relationships with all members of our football team," Maggard said. "This in turn allows for the relationships to continue after graduation."

## TERESA HOWARD

Executive Assistant to the Dean  
College of Human Environmental Sciences

Gwynn Hall, which houses the College of Human Environmental Sciences, recently re-opened after 15 months of renovations. Dean Stephen Jorgensen said that without his executive assistant, Teresa Howard, the renovations wouldn't have been such a success.

Howard, who has worked for MU for 31 years, served as the liaison between the college and Campus Facilities, keeping track of not only room dimensions and research laboratory equipment but also room keys and office furniture configuration.

"We simply could not have done this without her," Jorgensen said. "Moreover, she did this on top of her other duties," including directing the operations of the dean's office; providing faculty and staff support; developing and implementing policies and procedures; managing internal communications; reviewing expenditures; and overseeing special events.

For 20 years, Cheryl Poelling has handled big and small tasks at the law school. She helps with administrative tasks involving law review articles, correspondence, syllabi and course schedules for 62 full-time, part-time and emeritus faculty members. She manages course evaluations and the logistics of midterm exams.

She also helps students. "She knows virtually every law-school related question and is always willing to drop whatever task she is doing to help a student," Strong said. "No matter how difficult a situation may be, she is eternally patient and kind."

"Though we as a faculty feel like we are incredibly well taken care of, we know that the students come first with Cheryl. She goes the extra mile for our students again and again."

As an investigative/crime prevention supervisor, Shawn Spalding has been investigating reported crimes around the campus for more than 19 years. He leads investigations in reports of sexual assaults on campus.

Spalding was lead investigator in the 2007 homicide case involving Jeong H. Im, a retired MU assistant professor at the School of Medicine who was stabbed in an MU parking garage. MU Police announced the solving of the case in January 2013.

Spalding also is in charge of logging and storing all crime evidence.

As an investigator and evidence manager, Spalding is on call 24/7. Even so, he doesn't complain and is always dependable, said MU Police Maj. Doug Schwandt.

"Both his regular responsibilities and the special events he works require not only a firm understanding of city ordinances and state laws, but also someone with experience, patience and common sense," Schwandt said.

CASH, or Campus Augmenting Student Hires program, is an initiative to increase on-campus job opportunities for students. MU provides up to \$400,000 in matching funds each year to campus offices and departments toward compensating part time student workers on campus. Each position is eligible for a maximum compensation match of \$1,000 for the academic year.

Throughout the week, Human Resources Services will host training workshops on topics including "Protecting Yourself from Identity Theft and Fraud," "Show Me

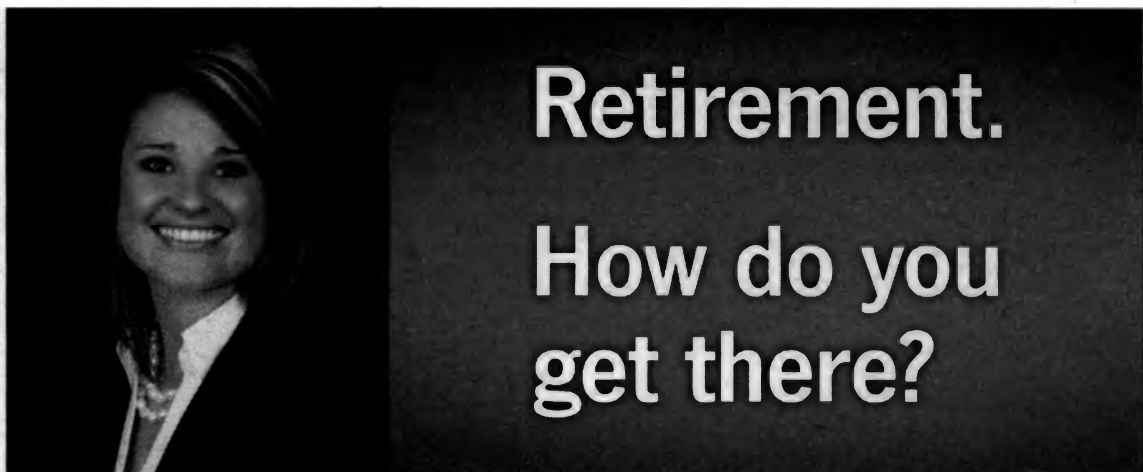

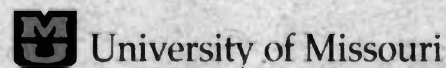
