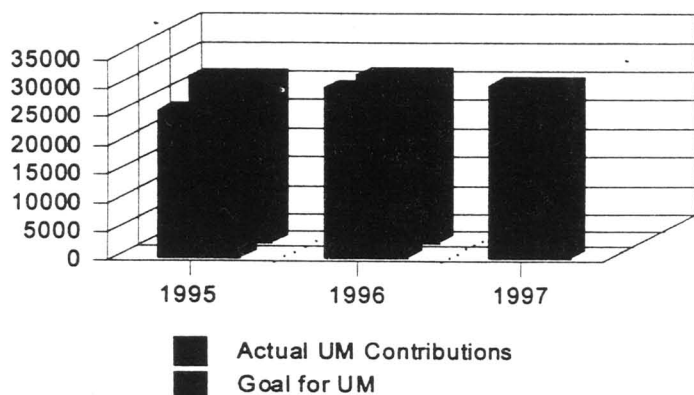

UM United Way Campaign Set to Begin

The United Way Campaign will soon be under way again. Nikki Krawitz, Consultant to the Executive Vice President, will be coordinating this year's activities for the System offices, with the help of Sherri Helm, Secretary to the Executive Vice President. Meetings of the UM Steering committee and departmental key persons have been set for August 21 and August 22, respectively, to help plan this year's events.

“Because in recent years an outstanding job has been done in educating the UM community about United Way, and in raising the levels of contributions, we have an excellent base on which to start this year,” said Nikki Krawitz. “At the System, we have gone from 126 employees contributing \$18,110 to United Way in 1994 to 170 employees contributing \$29,205 in 1996.”

Points to remember about United Way are 1) United Way puts local dollars to work locally; 2) United Way's 30 agencies help more than 70,000 persons in Central Missouri each year; and 3) donors may select agencies they want to support with their gifts or pledges.

The MU/UM kick-off meeting will be September 18 with the Day of Caring scheduled for September 19. Plans are currently

under way to schedule United Way agency tours and a United Way luncheon for UM volunteers.
