NOTE ON ACADEMIC DRESS

The history of academic dress goes back to the Medieval European universities of the fourteenth century. European universities continue to follow varied patterns in cut and color of gown and type of headdress. In the United States, the universities have standardized the academic dress so that its features are common and uniform throughout the country. The standard dress in the United States is as follows:

A. *The Gown.* The color is always black, the material serge, worsted, poplin, or silk. The pattern varies with the degree held; pointed sleeves for the Bachelor's degree; long, closed sleeves with a slit for the arm for the Master's degree; and round, open sleeves for the Doctor's degree. The Bachelor's and Master's gowns have no trimmings. The Doctor's gown is faced down the front with black velvet and three bars of the same across the sleeves; or the color of this velvet may be that of the faculty or subject to which the degree pertains.

B. *The Hood.* Hoods are not worn for the Bachelor's degree. The Master's Hood is shorter than the Doctor's Hood and lacks the panels of the Doctor's Hood. Hoods are lined with the colors of the school, two colors being shown by charging one color with chevrons of another color. The binding or edging of the Hood is velvet of the color pertaining to the subject of the degree.

C. *The Cap.* The Standard Cap is the mortarboard, always black in color. While the standard Tassel is always black, except that Doctor's caps may have gold ones, it is the custom at the University of Missouri at Commencement, for Tassels to be used of the color indicating the subject in which the degree is taken.

D. *Colors for Subjects.*
