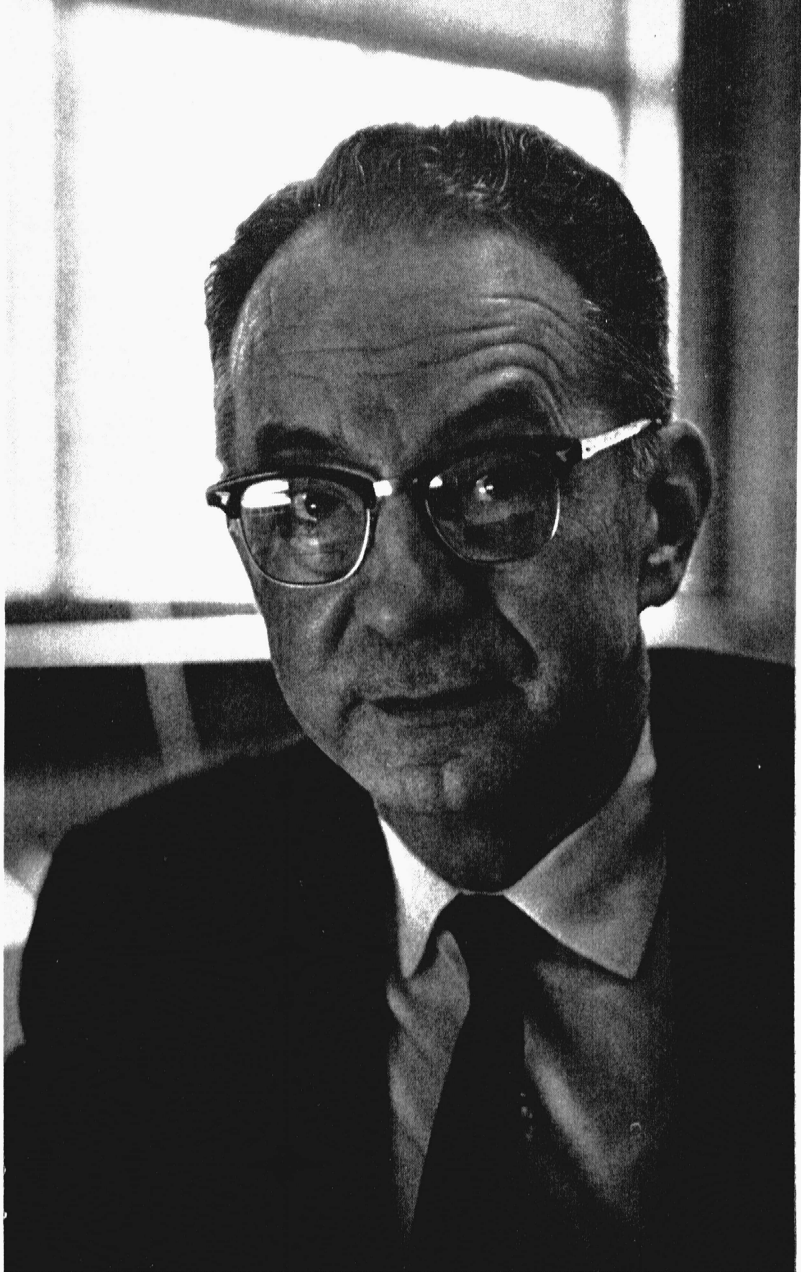

Artley Receives Distinguished Faculty Award

DR. A. STERL ARTLEY, professor of education, received the \$1,000 Distinguished Faculty Award of the University Alumni Association at the University's 124th annual Commencement exercises held in Memorial Stadium. Dr. Artley was selected by a faculty-alumni committee from twenty nominees. The award is made annually to a faculty member with a distinguished teaching record who has shown keen interest in academic progress of students. Dr. Artley is nationally recognized as an authority on child reading techniques. Before joining the faculty here in 1946, he taught for eleven years in Pennsylvania elementary and secondary schools and supervised the reading clinic at Pennsylvania State University. His award was presented by B. W. Robinson.
