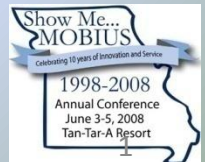

Why Would I Want to Submit an Enhancement Request?

- Something is Missing
 - Used to be in an earlier version



- Shouldn't Millennium be able to do this?

What Do I Do Next?

- Send email to the Innopac electronic discussion list

- Send email to the MOBIUS Users discussion forum
 - MOBIUS-USERS-L@PO.MISSOURI.EDU]
- Check known problems
- Check new version/release information



After All That ...

- Formulate an enhancement request to IUG



Parts of the Enhancement Request

- Problem
 - Describe the problem
- Enhancement suggestion
 - What would solve the problem?
- Decide what module/functionality
- If there is something in the III manual, indicate the page

Sample Enhancement Request

- Problem:
 - Currently, items on reserve provide no link to the professor and/or course. The only point of access is via course id number, which must be copied, pasted and searched in the Course Reserves or Search/Holds mode. This is very cumbersome for staff when they need to determine for whom or for which course the item is on reserve; several steps must be taken in order to obtain the desired information.




Sample Enhancement Request

- Proposed Solution:
 - Provide a link from item records on reserve to corresponding course(s) and professor(s).

One last thing before the actual submission

- Check the Mantis system to see if it has already been submitted.
- If there, read the enhancement
 - Add comments, improvements to the notes box

Friday, April 11, 2008 at midnight (11:59 PM Pacific Daylight Time USA) - Voting closes


- * Only one ballot per member library will be accepted; please consult with your colleagues prior to ballot submission.

2008 IUG Enhancement Schedule

- 2008 Enhancements - Deadline for submissions on Dec. 14, 2007 at midnight (Pacific Time USA)
- 2009 Enhancements - Cycle began on December 15, 2007 at 12:01 (PST)
- March 10, 2008 - Ballot published on IUG website and IUG voting starts
- April 11, 2008 - IUG voting ends at 11:59pm (Pacific Time USA) - firm deadline
- **April 21, 2008 - Ballot results posted to IUG website and sent to III**

FE Enhancement Schedule

- Jan. 8, 2008 - FE trading deadline between categories
- Jan. 9, 2008 – FE's given the # of ballot items per category
- Feb. 15, 2008 - FEs have first good draft of ballot items in Mantis
- Feb. 22, 2008 - FEs send final draft of ballot items to Coordinators
- Mar. 3, 2008 - Final draft from FEs is complete with all necessary edits
- Mar. 10, 2008 - Final ballot published on IUG website and IUG voting starts
- Apr. 11, 2008 - IUG voting ends at midnight (Pacific Time USA) - firm deadline
- Apr. 21, 2008 - Ballot results posted to IUG website and sent to III
- Apr. 27, 2008 – FE's meet at IUG – Critique, suggest, summarize

2008 Enhancement Voting

- 40 Functional Experts
- 1500+ requests by 218 libraries
- 250 for ballot
- 50 – Telnet, can Millennium can't
- 57% of membership voted
- Percentage as basis for number of ballot items per category
- 75 top vote getters submitted to III

INN-Reach Enhancements

- Separate process
- Separate discussion list
- Not very active
- 2009 – INN-Reach enhancements will become part of IUG process
- MOBIUS = One vote
