

JANICE LYNN (KRAUSE) GADE

(Written text and photographs provided by Janice Lynn (Krause) Gade). **Janice Lynn Krause** was born on June 6, 1970 in Seattle, Washington, and was the daughter of Marlo Charles and Doreen Carol (Baglow) Krause. Janice attended the first grade at Brown Elementary School in Redmond, Oregon. She attended grades two through six at Terrebonne Elementary School and grades seven and eight at Obsidian Junior High School in Redmond, Oregon. Janice Lynn Krause graduated from Redmond High School in June of 1989.

Janice Lynn Krause married **Jason Allen Gade** on November 4, 1989, at Community Presbyterian Church in Redmond, Oregon. Jason Allen Gade was born January 12, 1970 in Portland, Oregon, at Emmanuel Hospital. Jason attended grade schools in Oregon and Kansas, and graduated from Redmond High School, Redmond, Oregon in 1988. They met while attending the same high school. In July of 1988, Jason entered Marine Corps Recruit Training in San Diego, California and graduated from Basic in October, 1988. Janice Lynn Krause accompanied Jason's parents to California for Jason Gade's Boot Camp graduation, at which point Jason and Janice became engaged to be married. Jason Gade's first duty station was in Twentyninepalms, California, where he studied how to repair radio electronics for the Marines. After a year of schooling and a couple of delays Jason Gade returned to Oregon to marry Janice Lynn Krause. Following their marriage, the newlyweds drove back to Southern California where Jason was stationed at Camp Pendleton, California, located just north of San Diego, California. In August of 1990, Jason Gade was deployed to Saudi Arabia as part of a support element during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm. He spent his first wedding anniversary and his twenty-first birthday separated from his wife and family, not to mention his wife who was also pregnant at the time. Jason returned to the United States in April of 1991, a couple of months before the birth of the couple's first child.

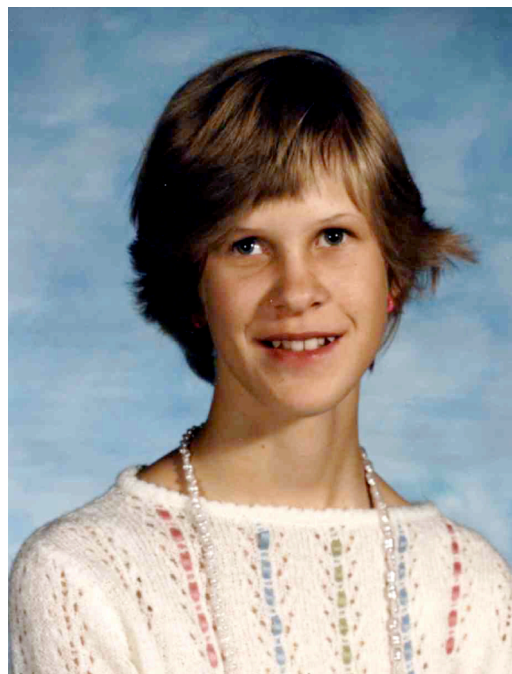
Janice and Jason Gade lived in the Oceanside, California area from November of 1989 until September of 1994 while Jason Gade was in the Marine Corp. In September of 1994, the Gade family moved back to Terrebonne, Oregon, to stay with Janice's parents. At that time Jason worked in Bend installing and repairing two-way radio equipment. In 1996 the Gade family moved to the Portland, Oregon area for better employment opportunities, living variously in West Linn and Forest Grove before eventually settling down in Aloha, Oregon.

Jason Allen and Janice Lynn (Krause) Gade had three children: **Kevin Michael Gade** born on June 29, 1991, **Derek Alexander Gade** born on May 26, 1994, and **Elizabeth Nicole Gade** born on May 30, 2001.

Following the September 11, 2001, attacks against the United States, Jason Gade once again answered the call of duty for his country and enlisted in a local Army National Guard unit, where he served as a communications specialist. In February 2003, Jason Gade's unit left Oregon for Ft. Carson, Colorado, to train for deployment to Kuwait and Iraq in support of Operations Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. Although the unit, First Battalion One-hundred-sixty-second Infantry, spent most of its deployment guarding bases in Kuwait, Jason Gade accompanied a portion of the unit that spent three months in Iraq just south of Baghdad. At the end of the deployment, Jason returned to the United States in April of 2004 where he continued to serve in his unit. In September of 2005, Jason Gade's unit was again called up and deployed to New Orleans, Louisiana, in support of the relief efforts after Hurricane Katrina. After returning to Oregon in November, Jason Gade's enlistment in the National Guard was over and he returned to civilian life. Jason and Janice Gade and their three children enjoyed going to hockey games. The last known address of Jason Allen and Janice Lynn (Krause) Gade was Aloha, Oregon.

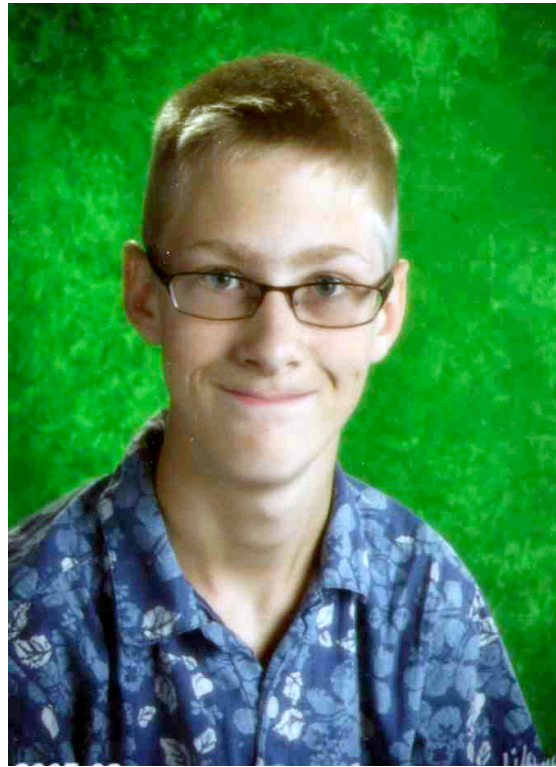

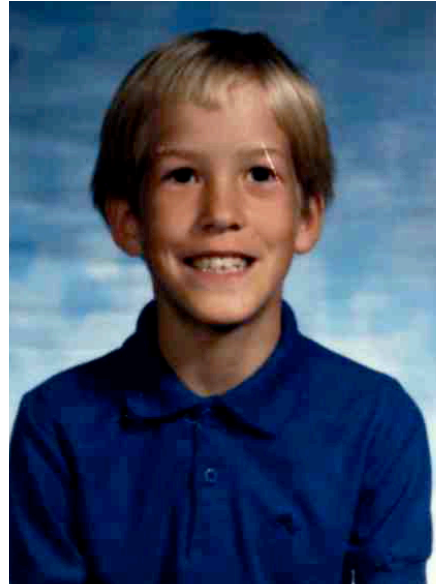

DALE RICHARD KRAUSE

(Written text and photographs provided by Judy Lynn (Krause) Coreson). **Dale Richard Krause** was born December 29, 1944, at St. Luke's Hospital in Fergus Falls, Minnesota, to Julius Otto Krause and LaVerne Florence (Duenow) Krause. Dale had one older brother, Marlo Charles Krause, and a younger sister, Judy Lynn Krause.

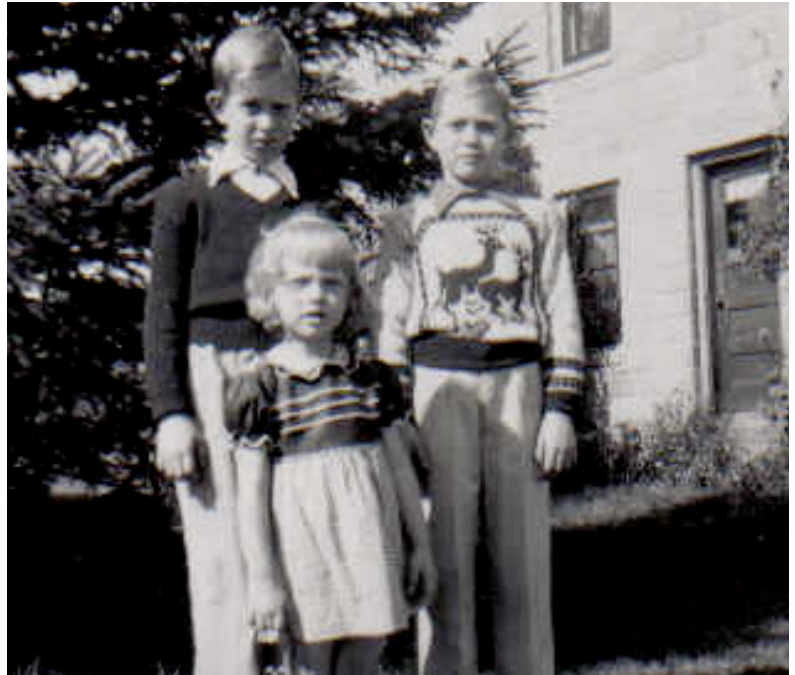
Dale lived with his parents in Wadena, Minnesota, and then moved with his family to the rural area of Friberg Township in Ottertail County north of Fergus Falls, Minnesota. They lived in the former home of his grandparents, Arthur A. and Bertha (Peters) Krause. Dale was baptized and confirmed in the same Immanuel Lutheran Church his grandparents, Arthur A. and Bertha (Peters) Krause, and great grandparents, Adolph R. and Augusta W. (Richter) Krause, previously attended in Friberg Township. As a child, Dale enjoyed bicycle riding, playing games and croquet with family, as well as the family trips in the summers.

Dale claimed the family rocking chair as his own. Dale attended first through fifth and seventh through eighth grades at District 66, a one-room country school. His mother, aunts, and uncles went to this same country school. His family moved to Salem, Oregon, where Dale attended sixth grade at Keizer Elementary School. After returning from Oregon, his family moved to Fergus Falls, Minnesota. Dale attended the ninth grade at Washington Junior High School and tenth through the twelfth grades at Fergus Falls Senior High School. During his high school years, Dale and his family lived in the same home his grandmother, Bertha (Peters) Krause, had lived in on 420 North Cleveland Avenue. After Dale graduated from high school, he and his parents moved again to Salem, Oregon. He served in the Army from 1962-1965. He received Soldier of the Month award several times.

Dale lived in Salem, Oregon, before moving to Albany, Oregon. He was a furnace operator at Wah Chang Metals. Dale drown in the Willamette River at Albany's Bryants City Park on May 17, 1967 at the age of 22. Internment was at the Willamette National Cemetery in Portland, Oregon.

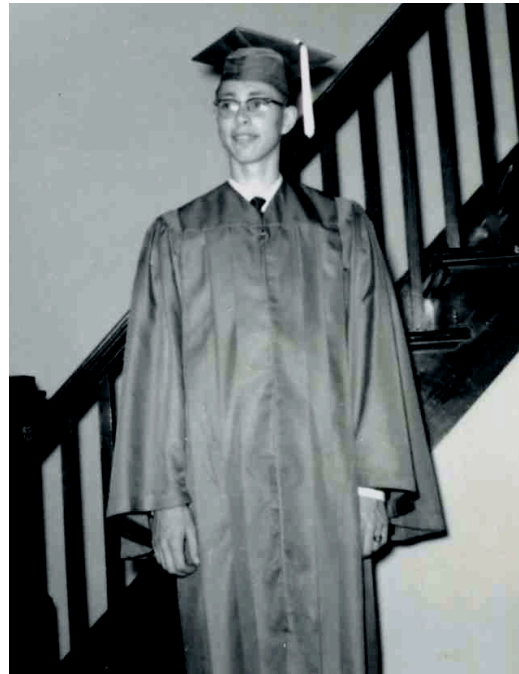

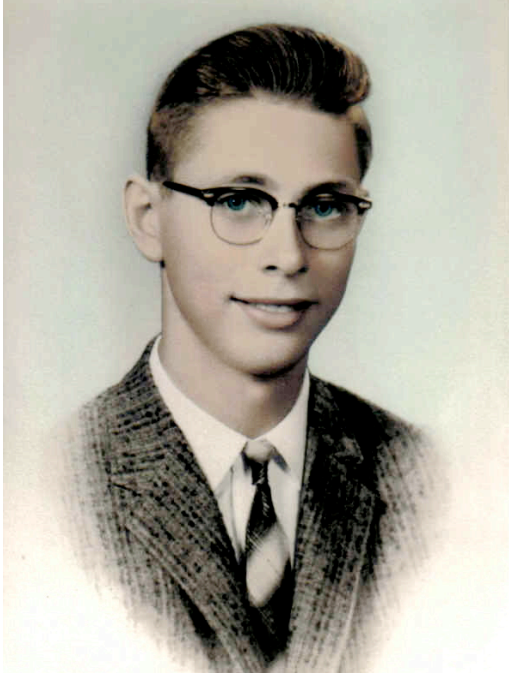

Dale Krause, 22, Drowns in Oregon

Dale Krause, 22, son of Mr. and Mrs. Julius Krause, former residents of Fergus Falls, drowned May 17 while swimming at Albany, Ore., according to word received by relatives here.

The family moved to Salem, Ore., the summer of 1962, the year Dale graduated from Fergus Falls High School.

He was born Dec. 29, 1944, and was baptized and confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran Church of Friberg. He attended grade school in Friberg Township.

Dale served three years in the Army and received the Soldier of the Month award several times. He was employed at Albany, Ore.

Surviving are his parents, a sister, Judy, at home, a brother, Marlo of Seattle, his grandfather, George Duenow of Friberg, several aunts and uncles.

Services are pending with plans for burial in the veterans' cemetery at Portland, Ore.
