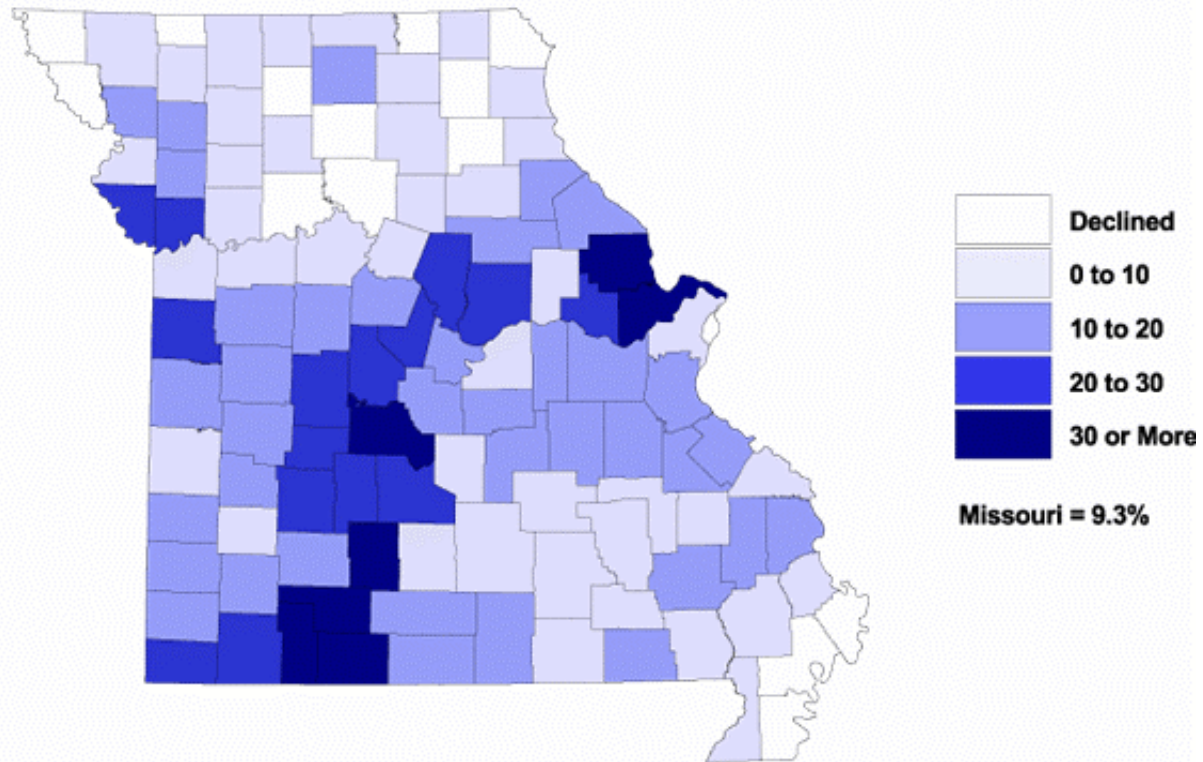

Percent Change in Total Population 1990-2000

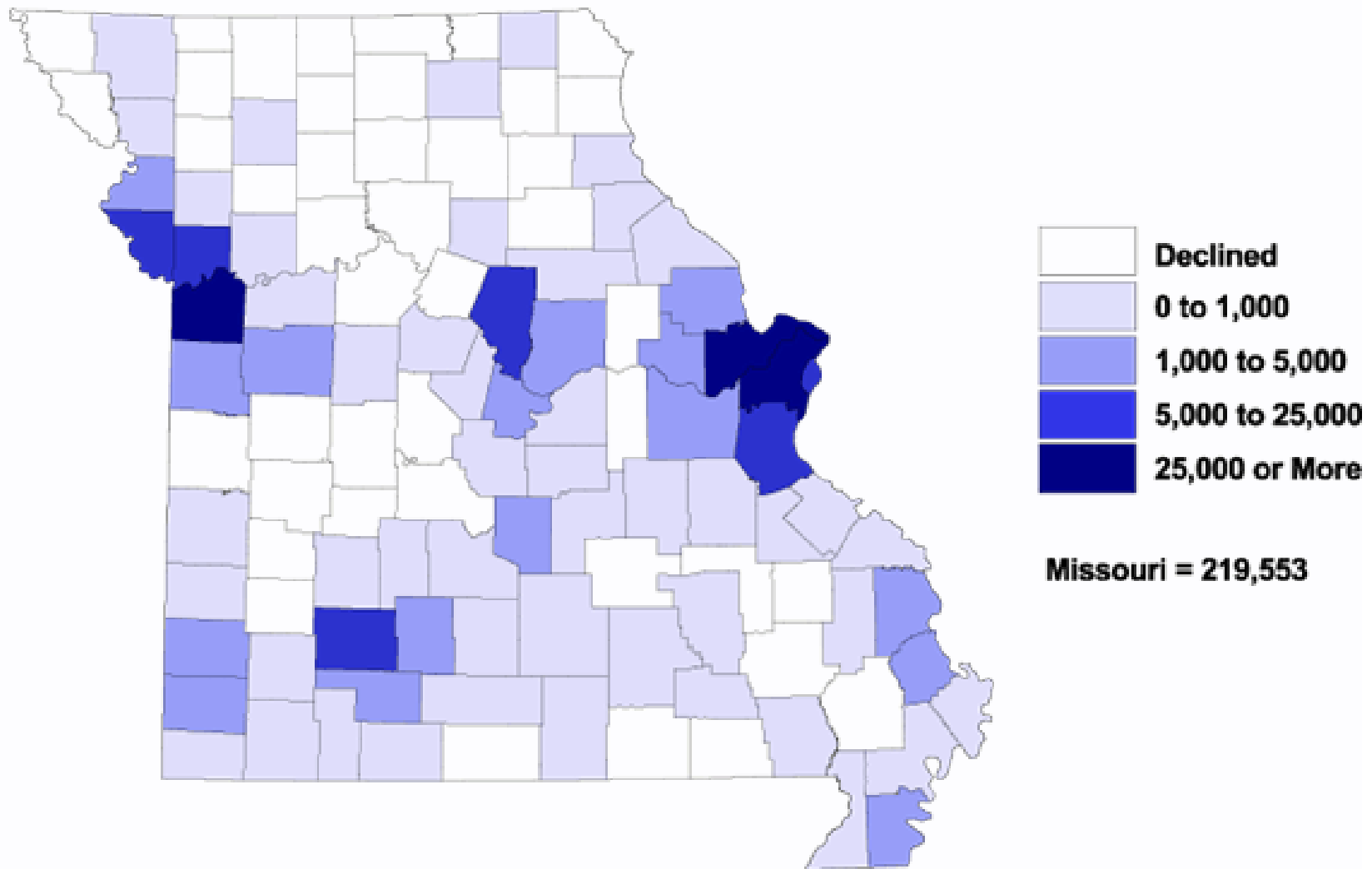

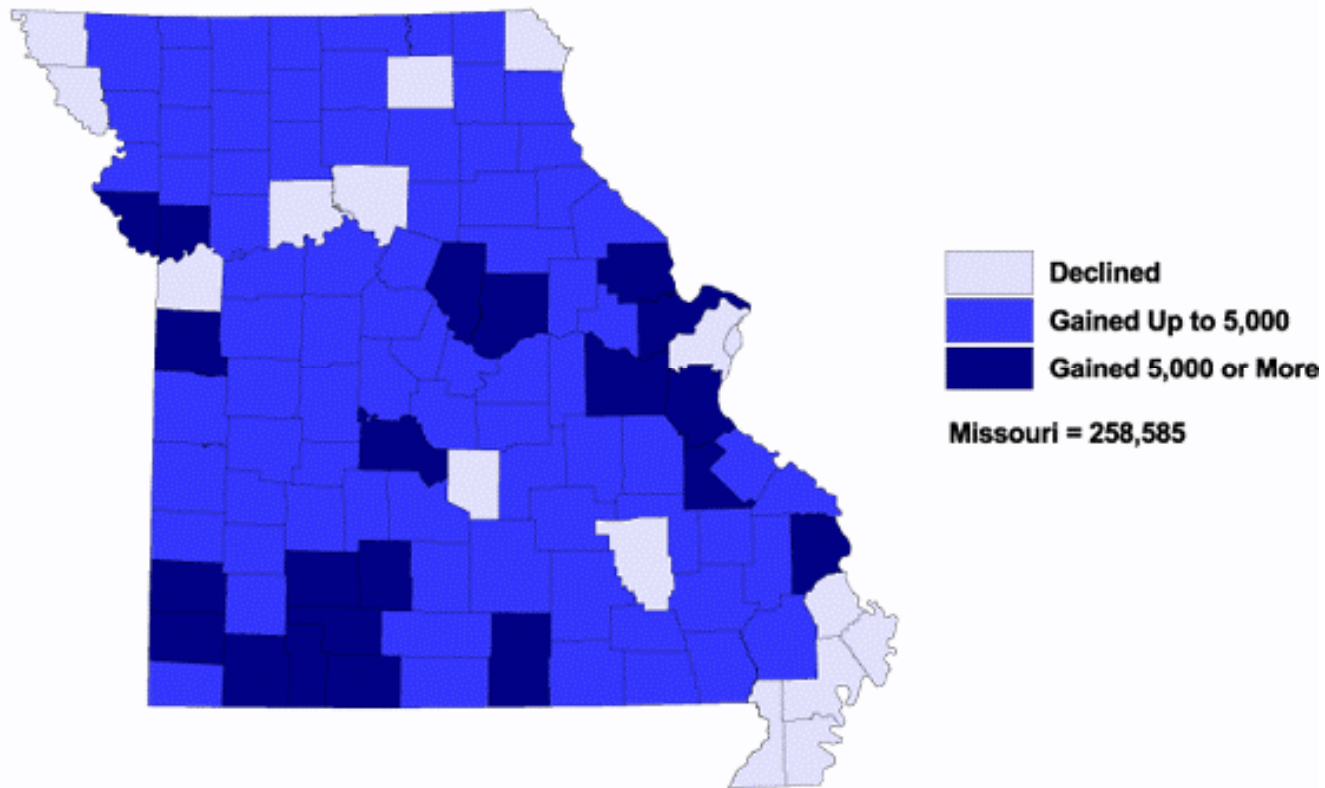

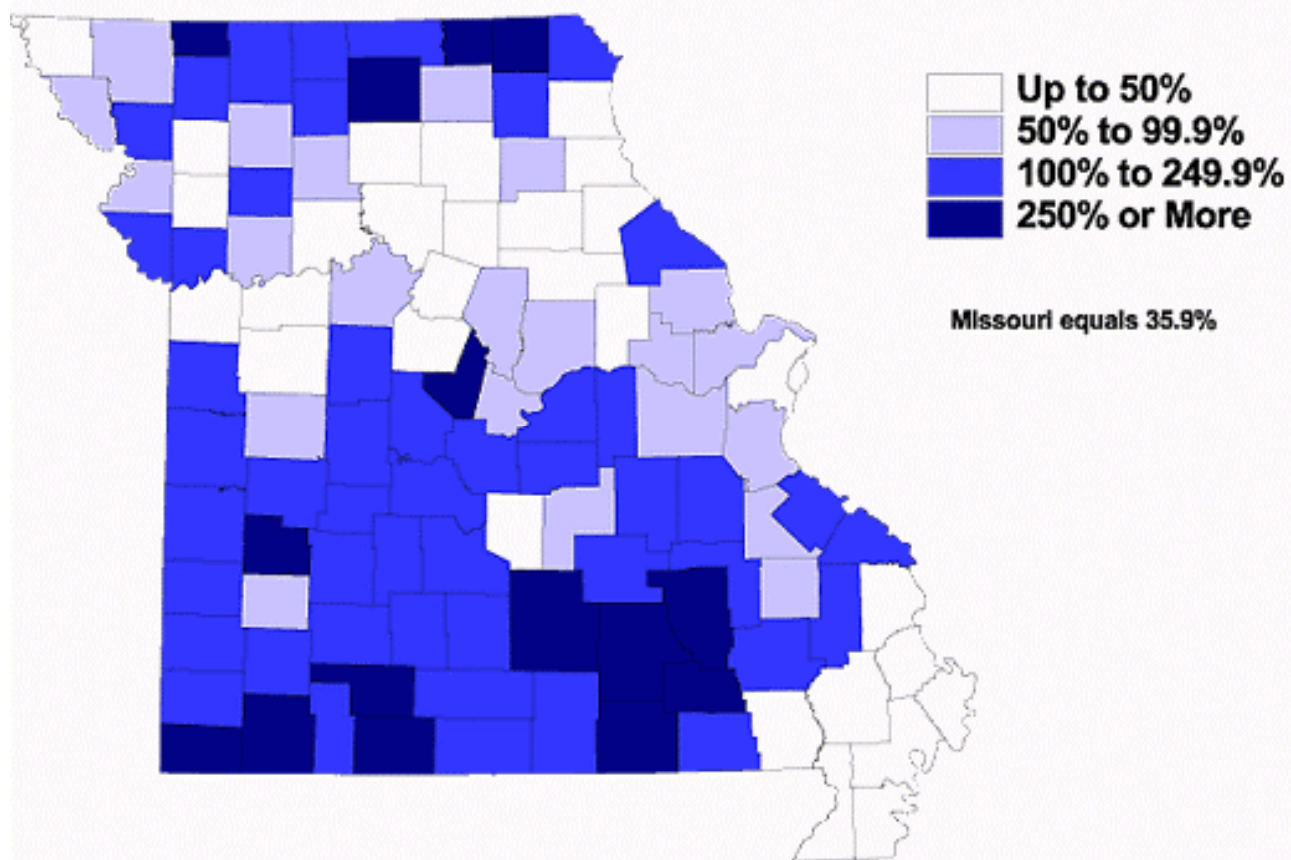
Net Migration of the Total Population 1990-2000

Percent Change in Racial Minority Population, 1990-2000

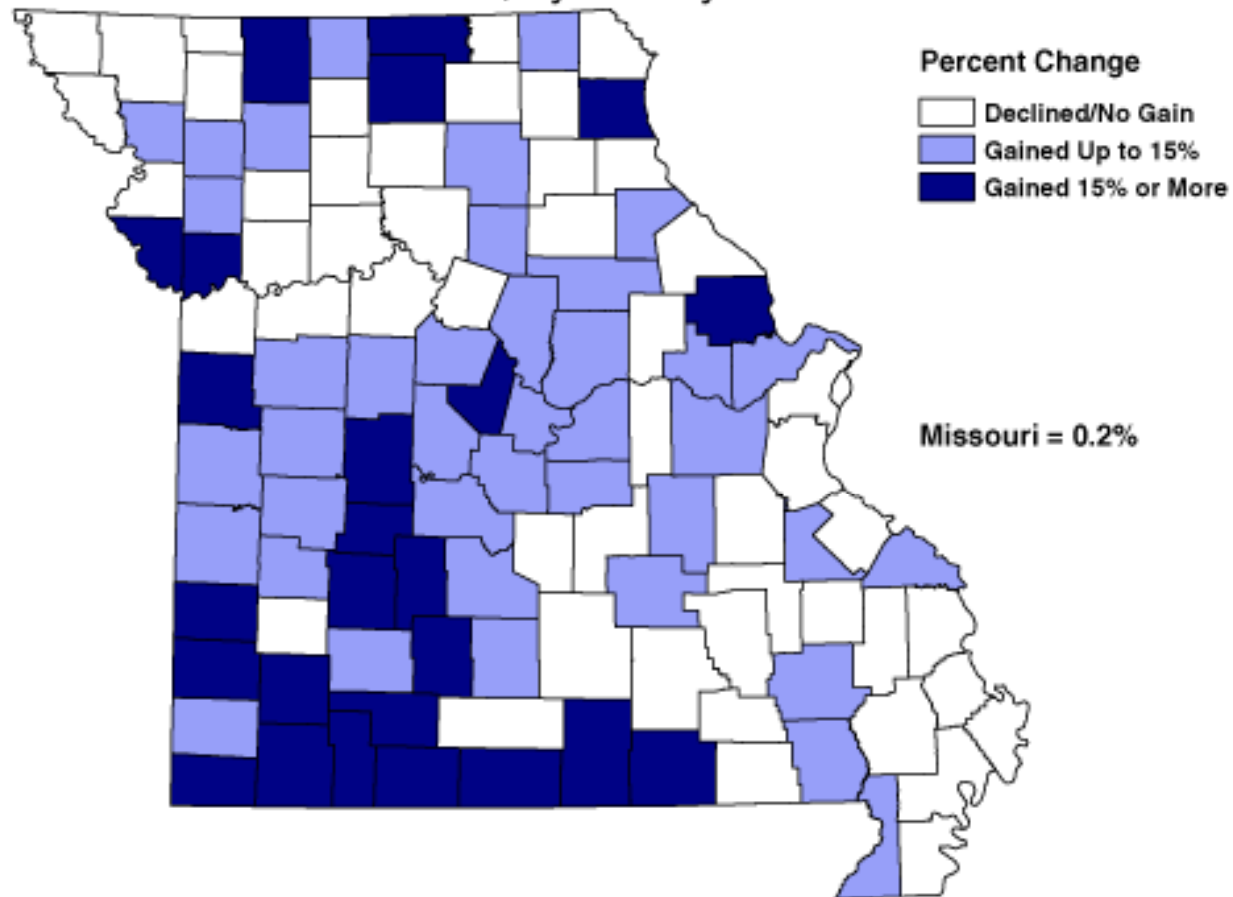

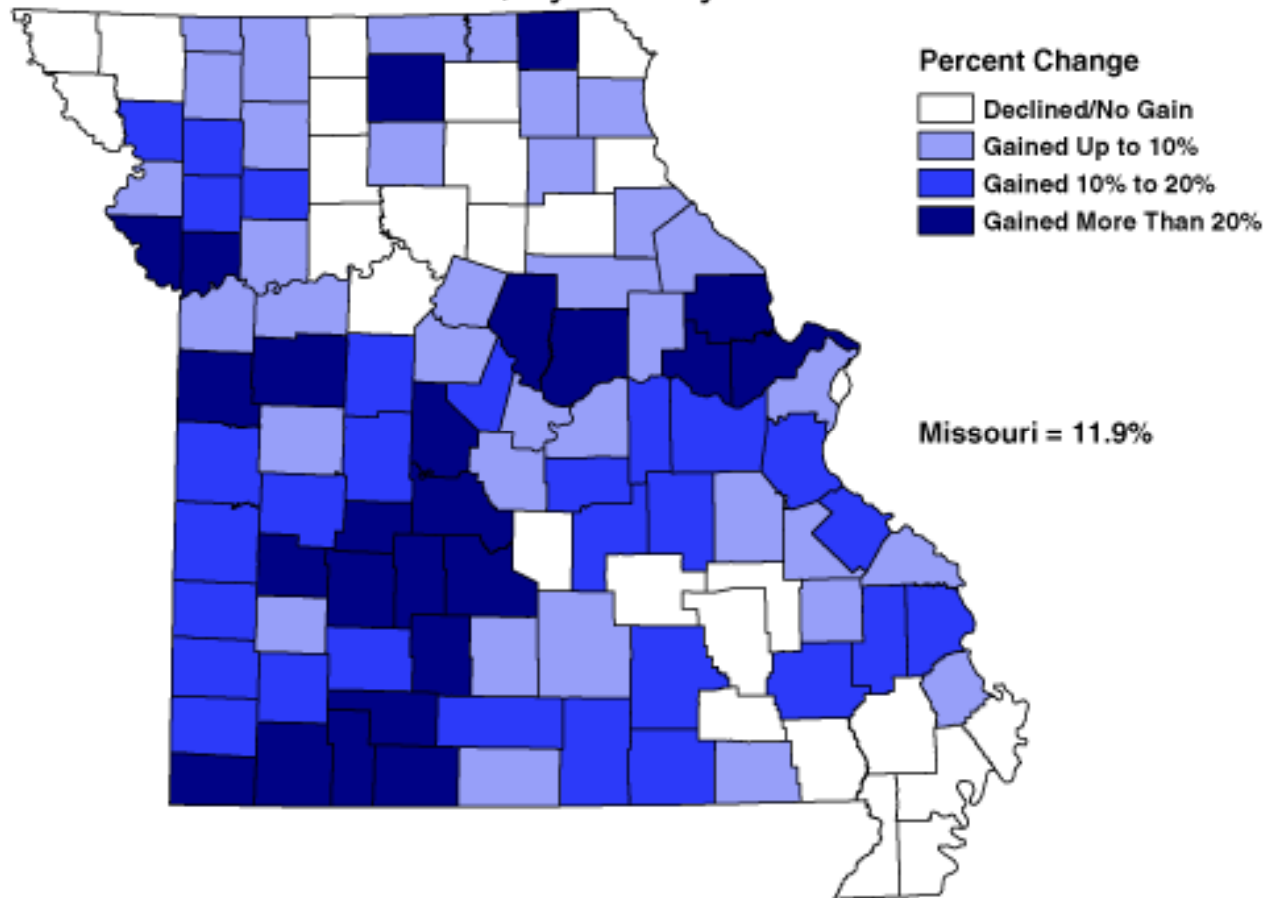

Percent Change in Population Age 5 to 17 Years In Missouri, by County 1990 - 2000

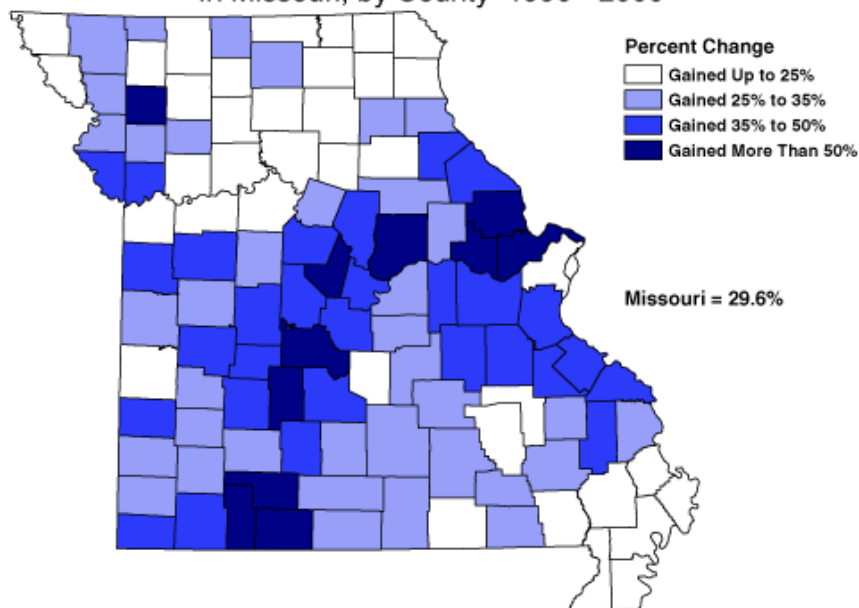

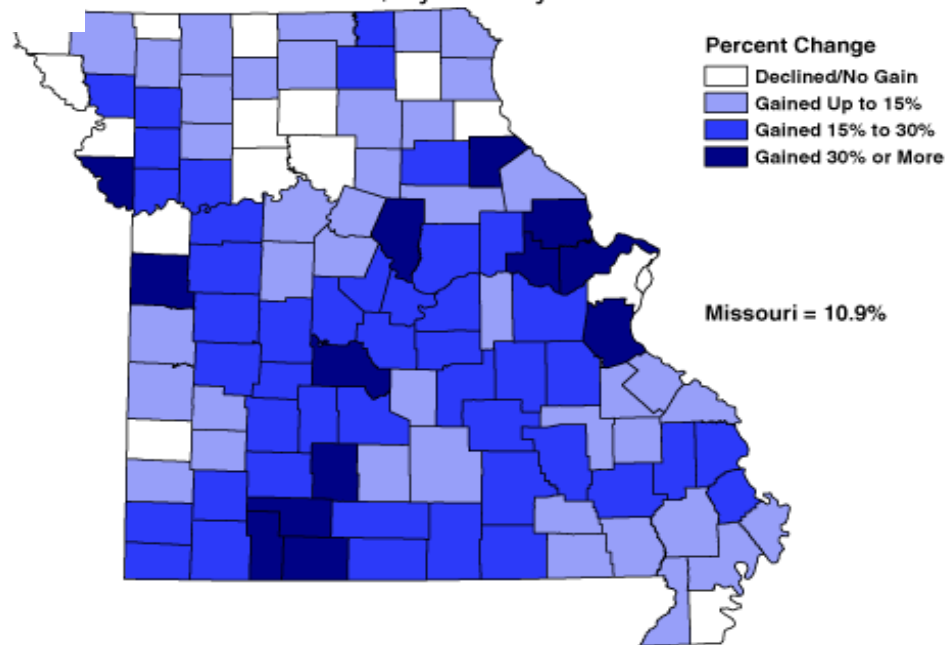
Percent Change in Population Age 35 to 54 Years In Missouri, by County 1990 - 2000

Percent Change in Population Age 55 to 64 Years In Missouri, by County 1990 - 2000

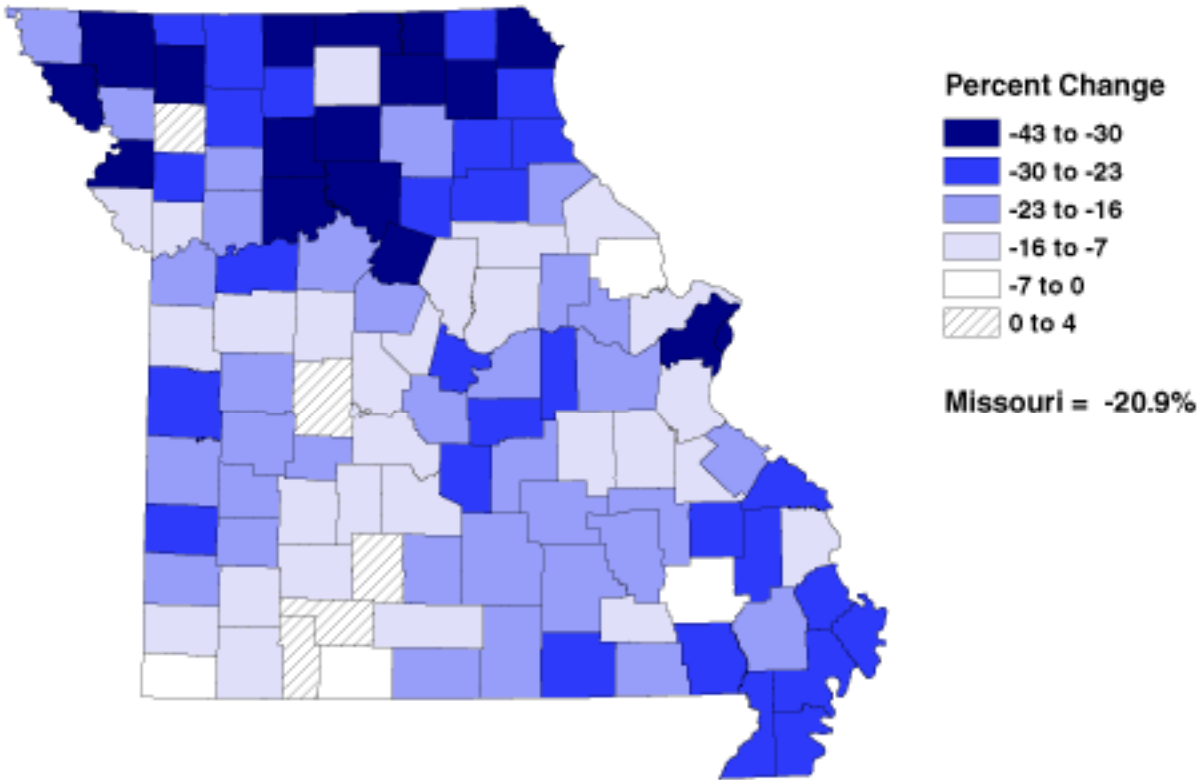

Percent Change of Missouri's Adult Population Age 25 Years or Older without a High School Diploma by County, 1990-2000

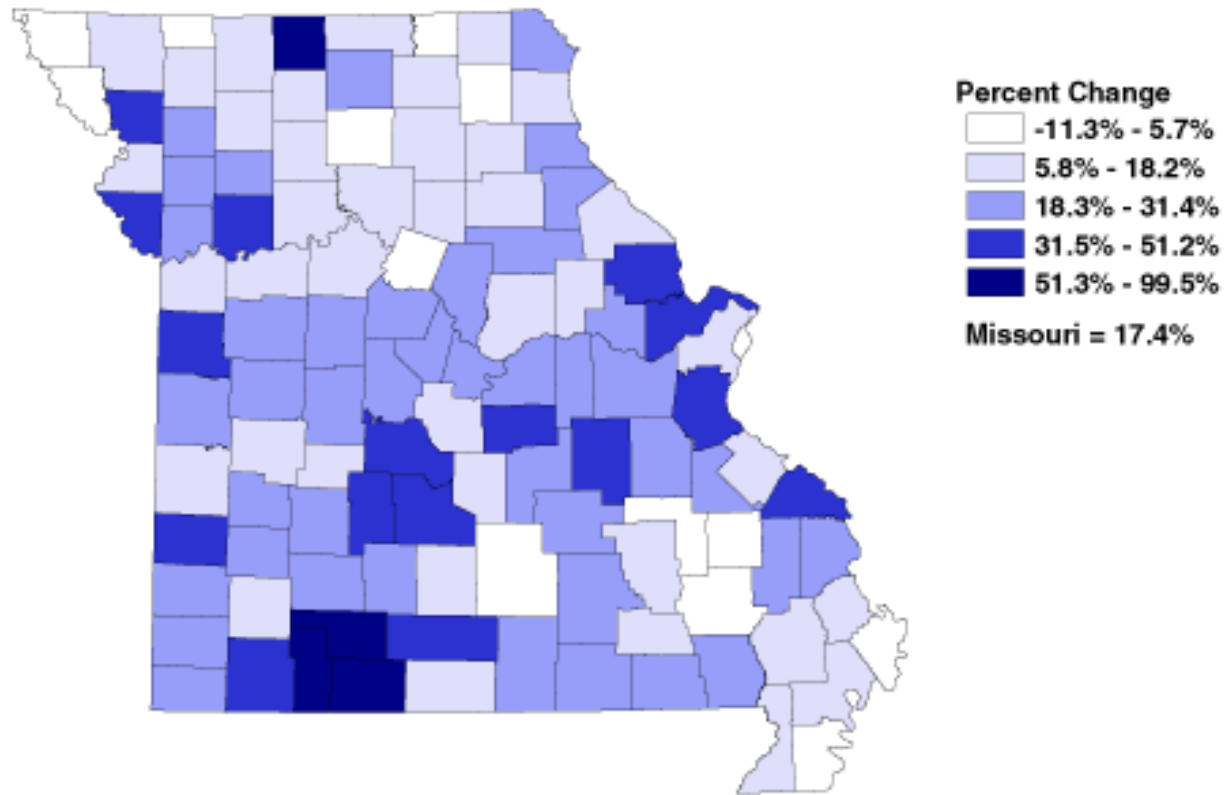

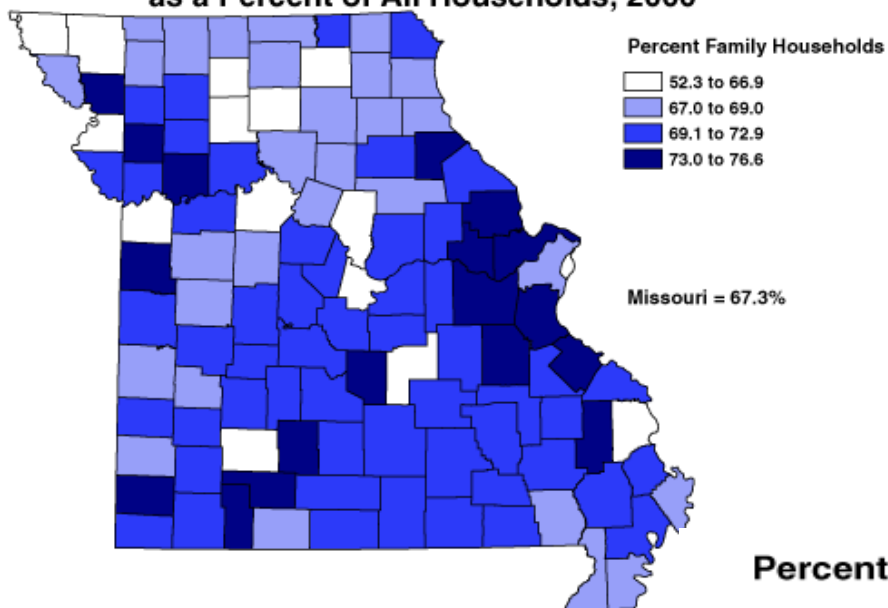

Percent Change in Total Full-Time and Part-Time Employment 1990-2000



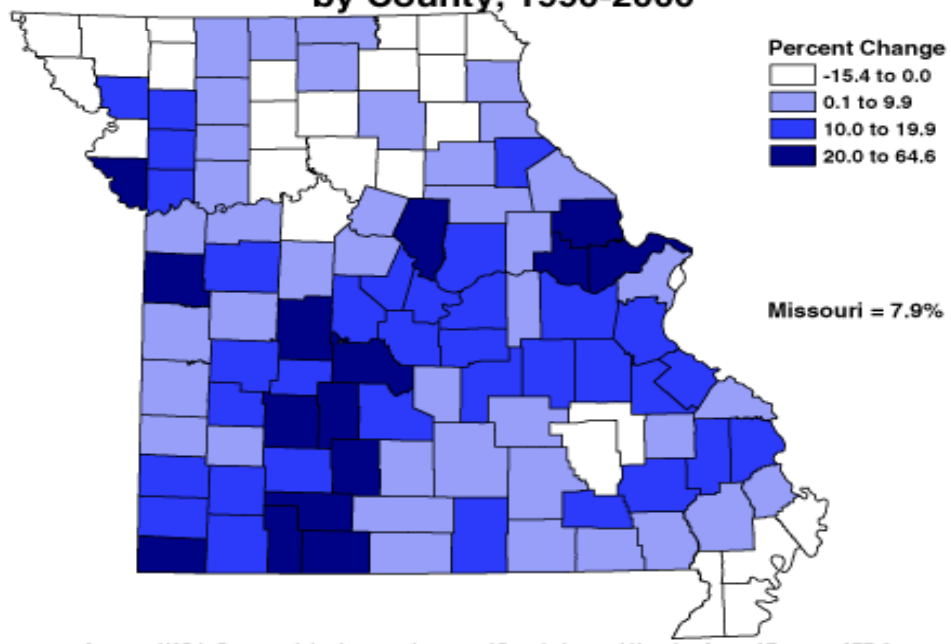

Percent Change in Total Family Households in Missouri, by County, 1990-2000

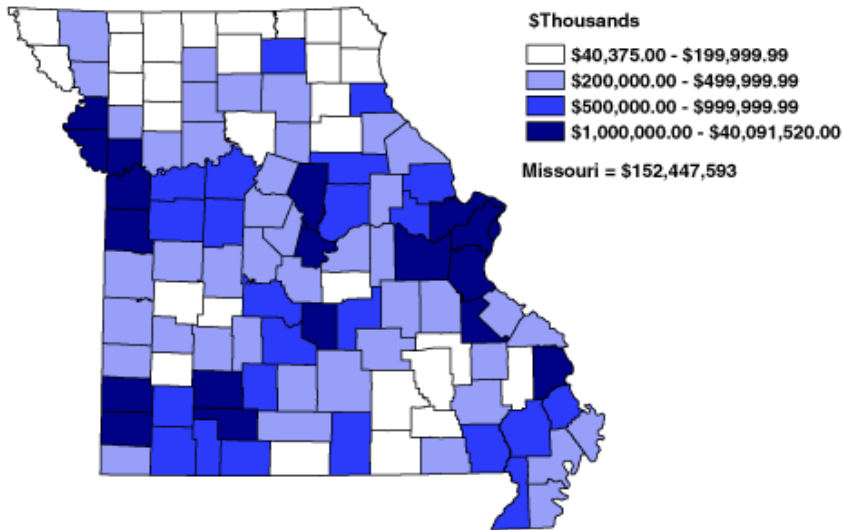

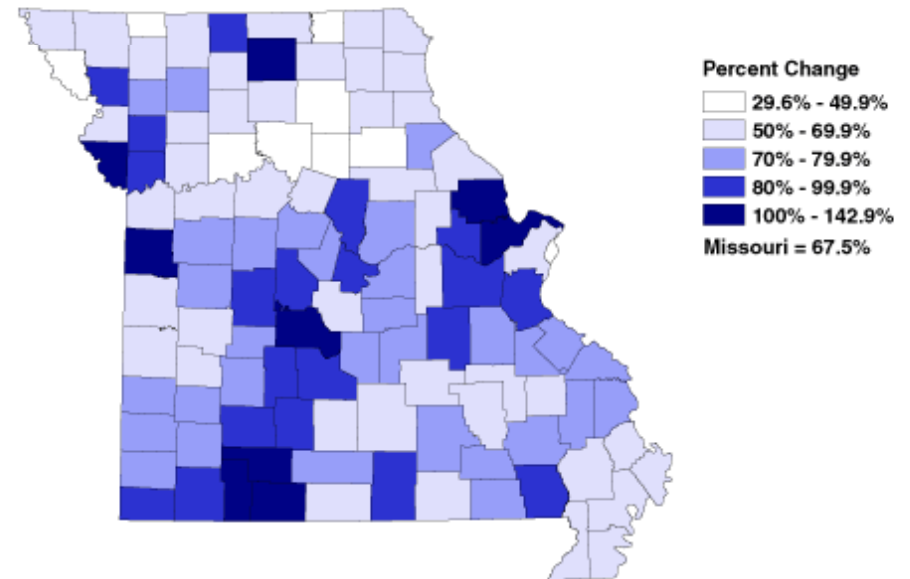

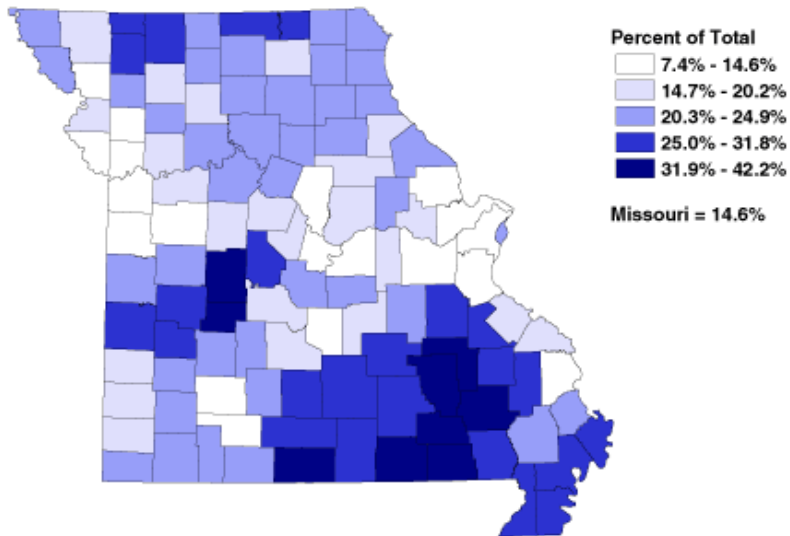
Percent Change in Total Personal Income 1990-2000

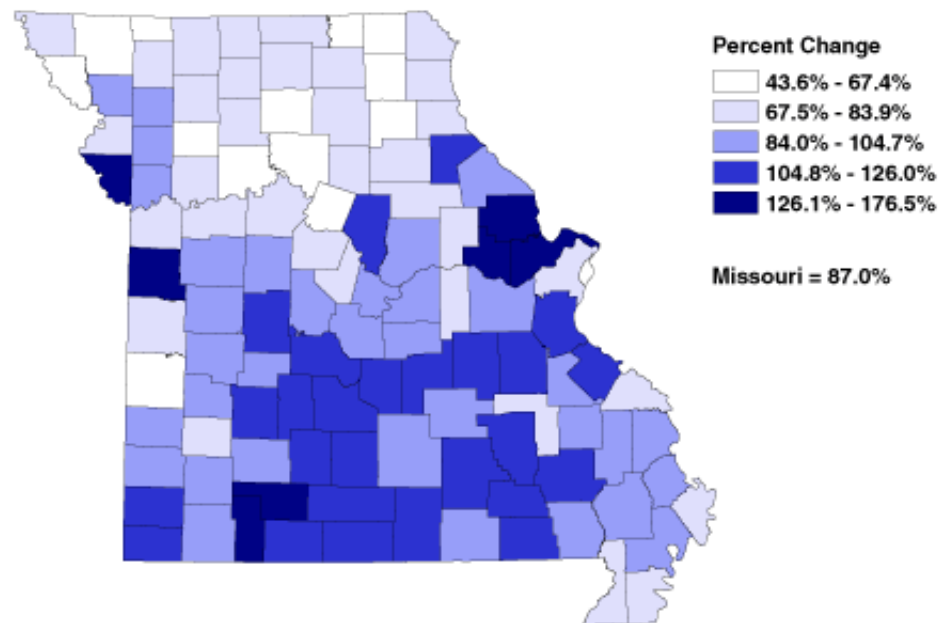

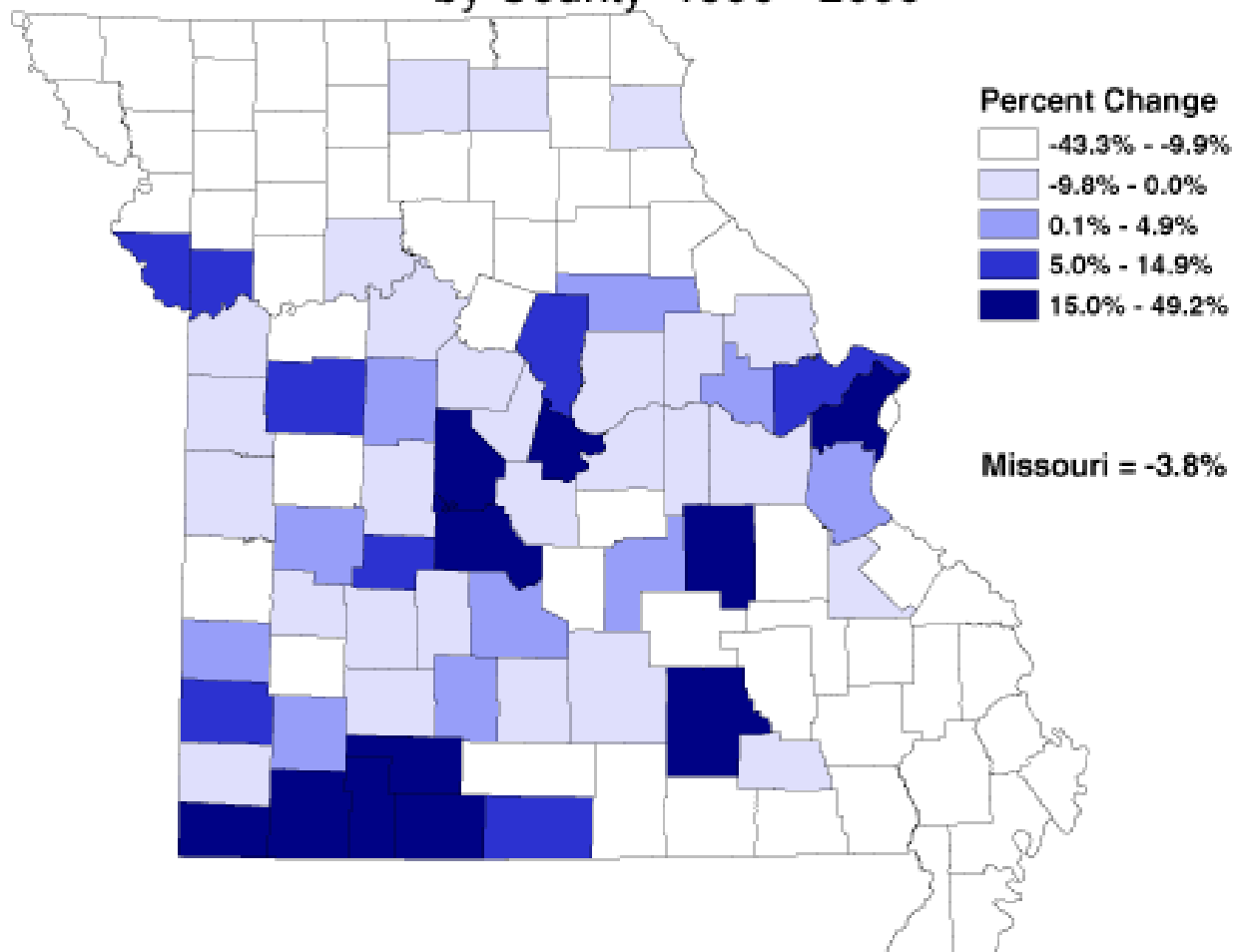
Missouri County Transfer Payments Percent Change, 1990-2000
