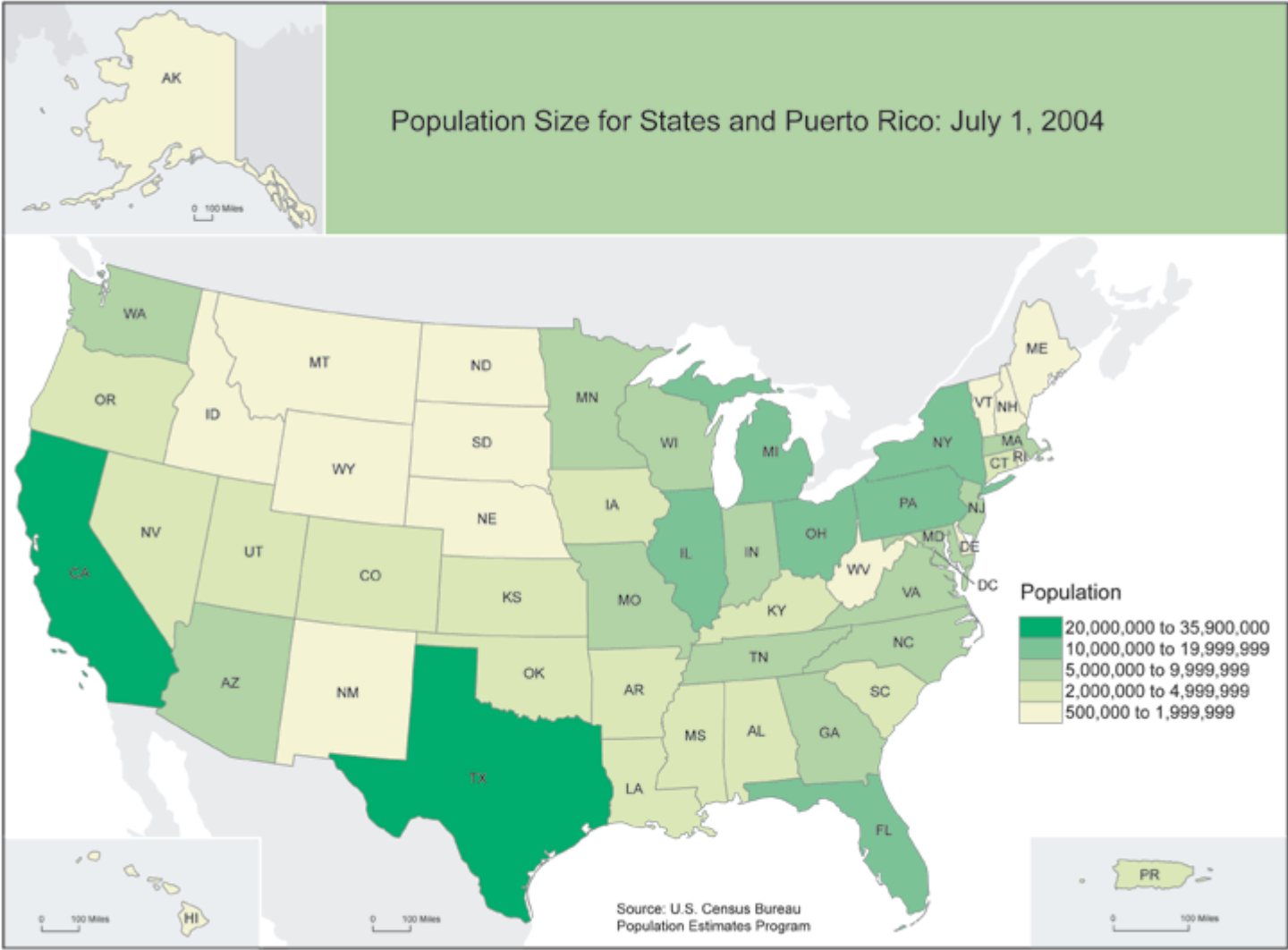

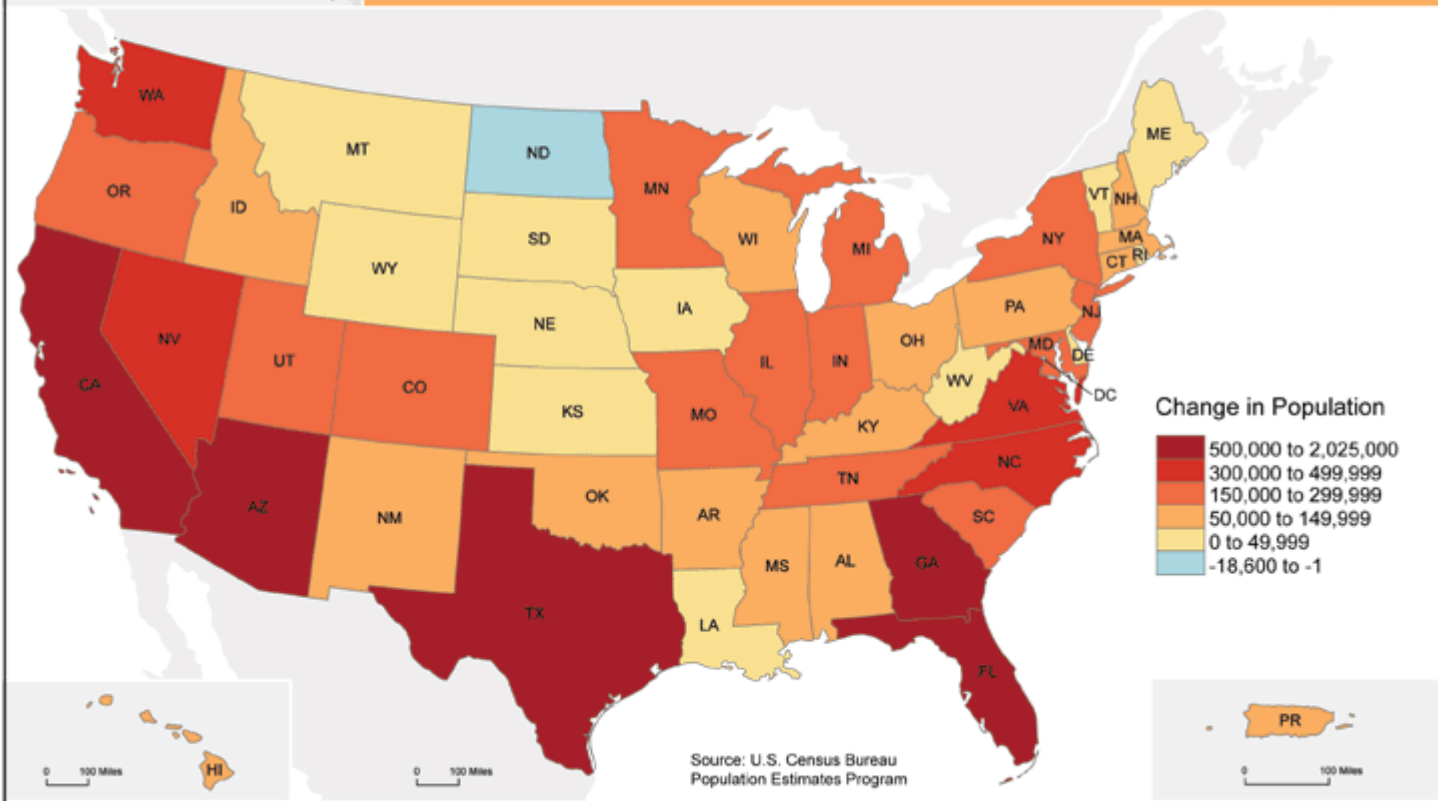

Numerical Change in Population for States and Puerto Rico: April 1, 2000 to July 1, 2004



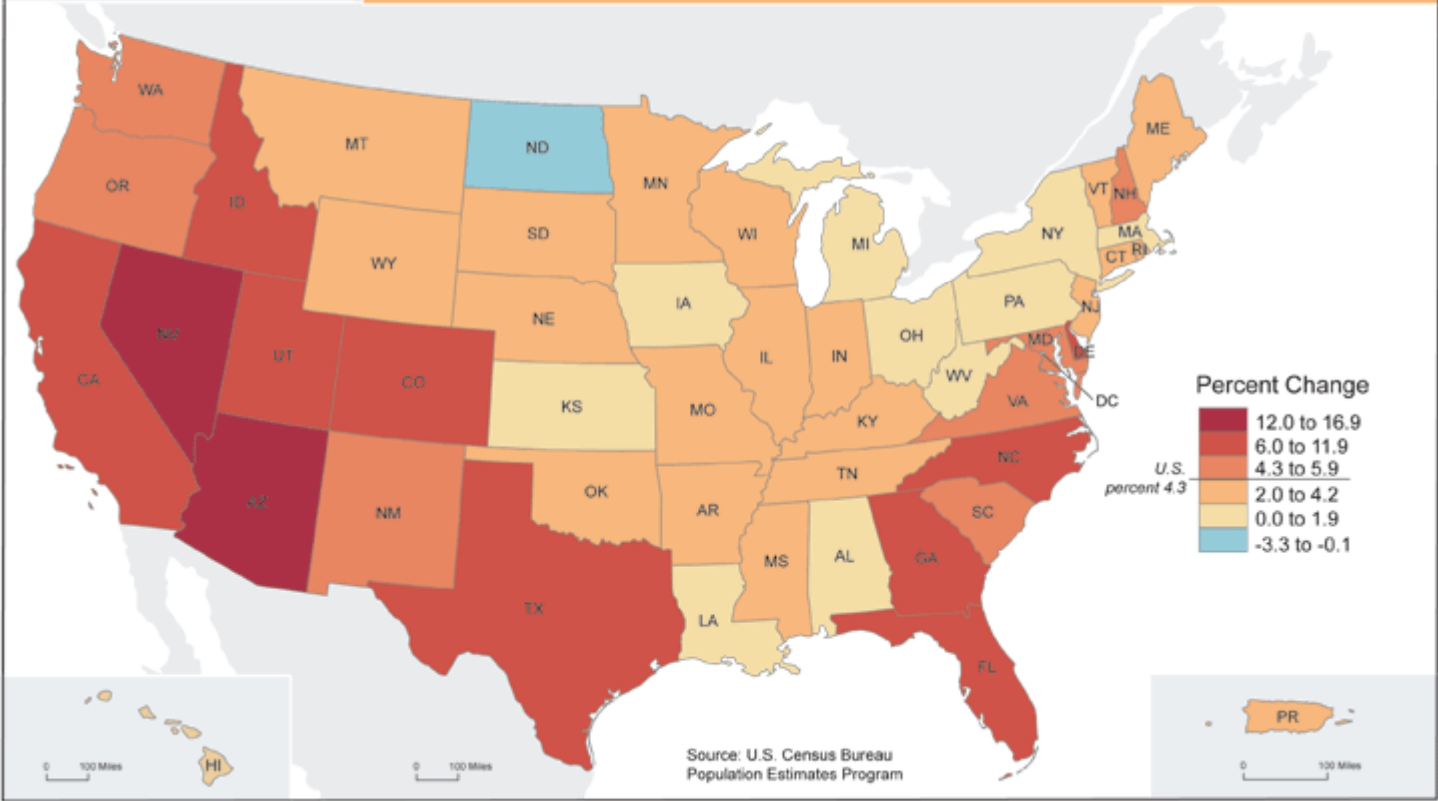

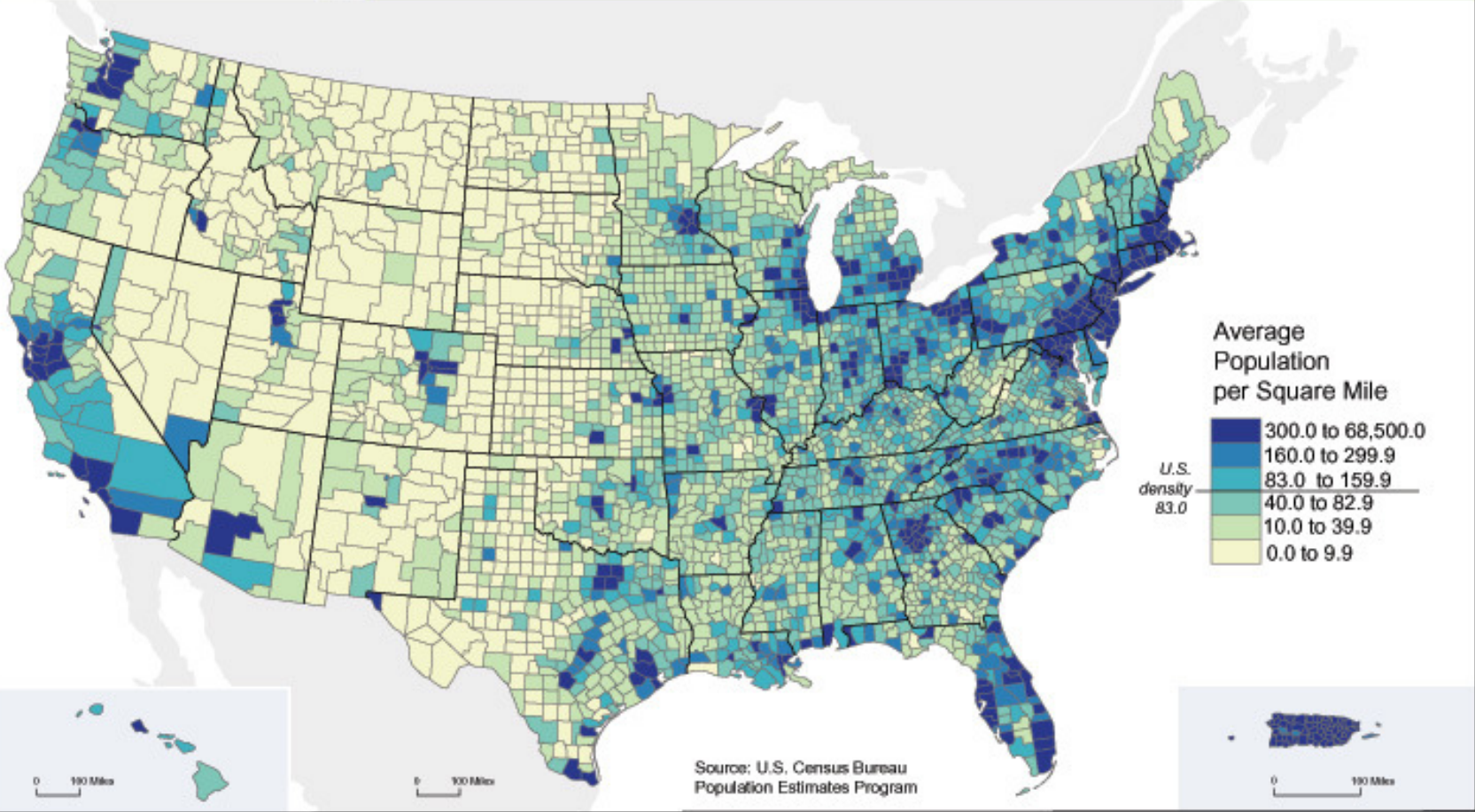

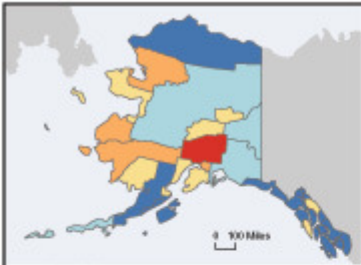
Percentage Change in Population, for States and Puerto Rico: April 1, 2000 to July 1, 2004



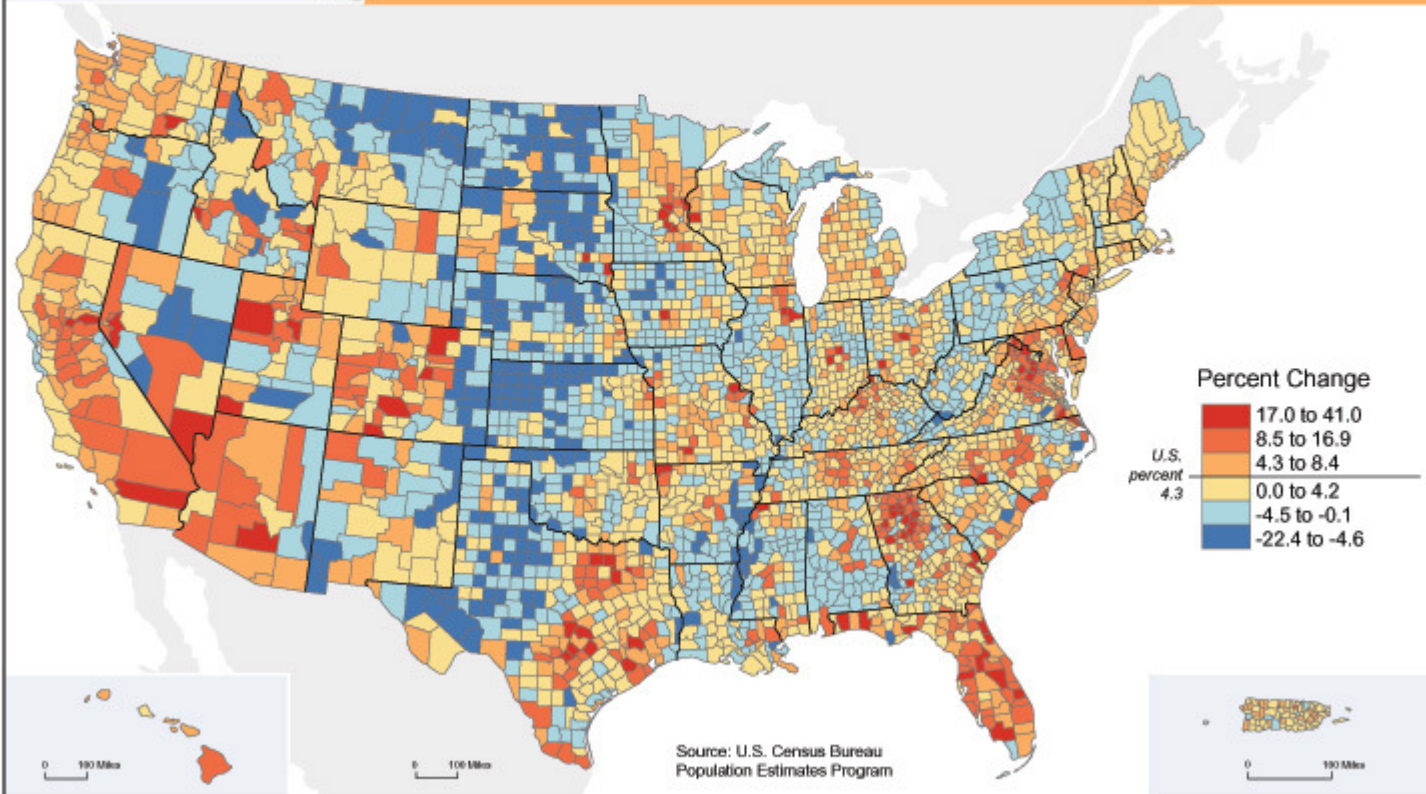
Population Density for Counties: July 1, 2004



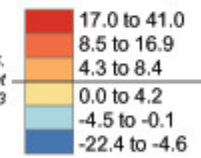

April 1, 2000 to July 1, 2004

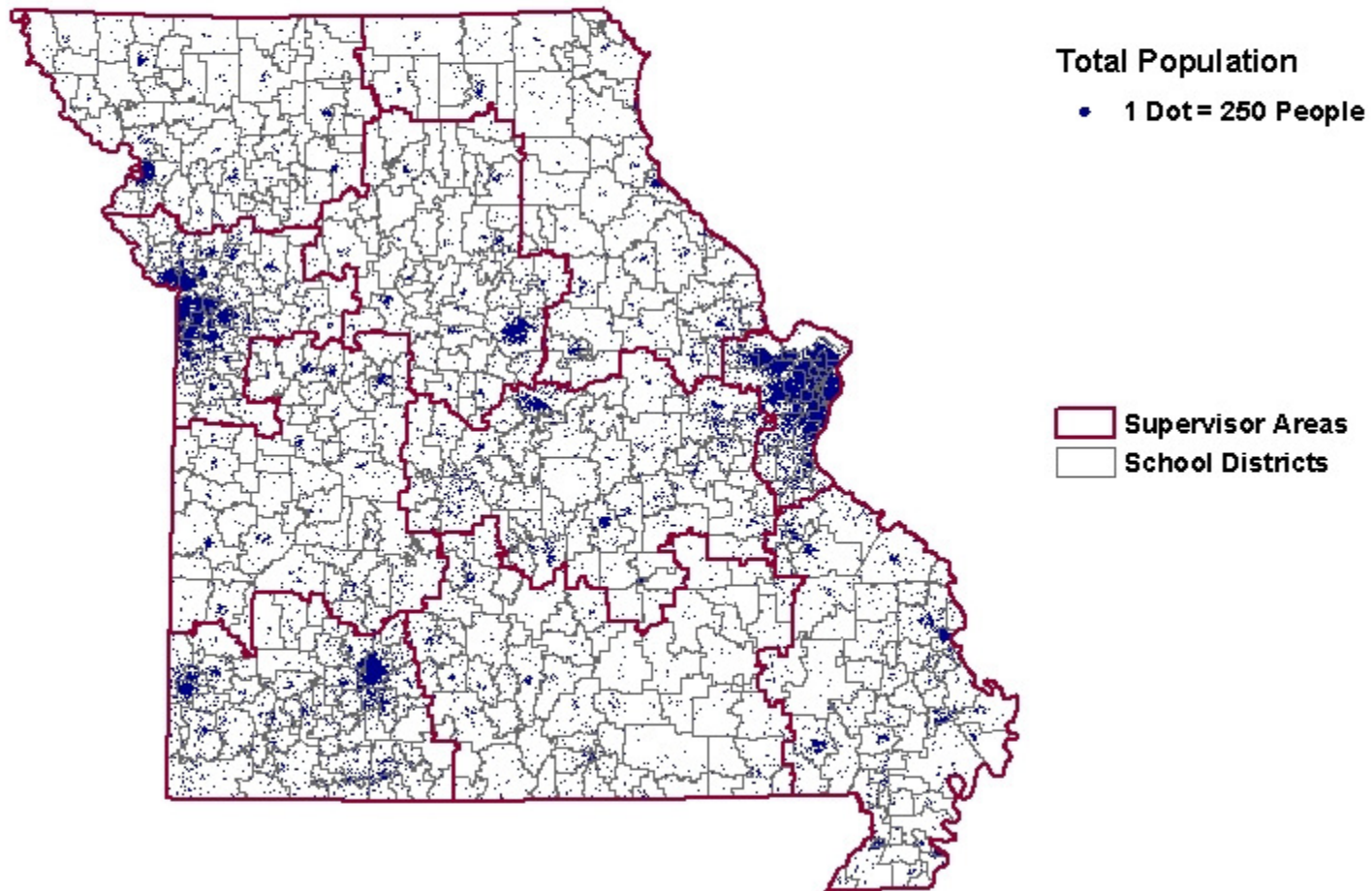

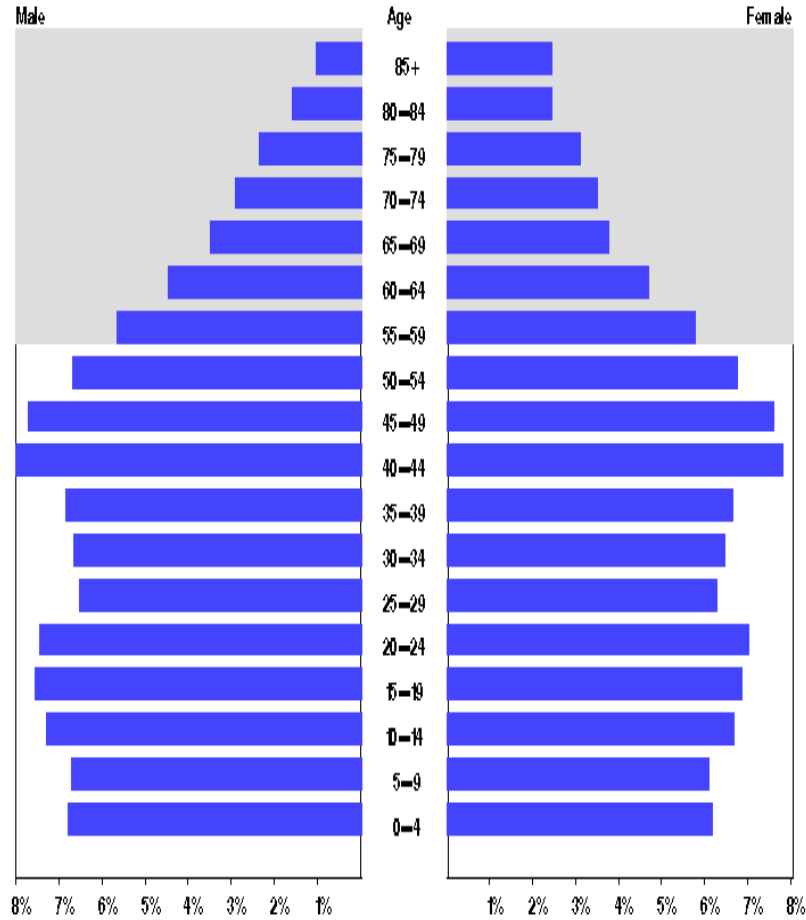

Total Population by Block Group, 2000

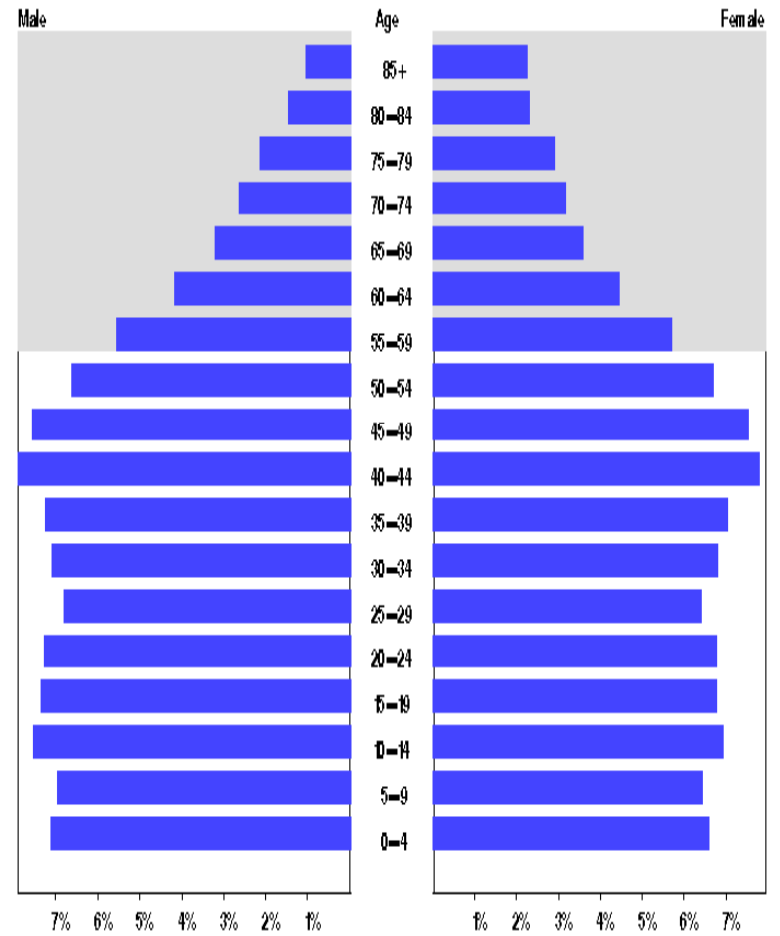

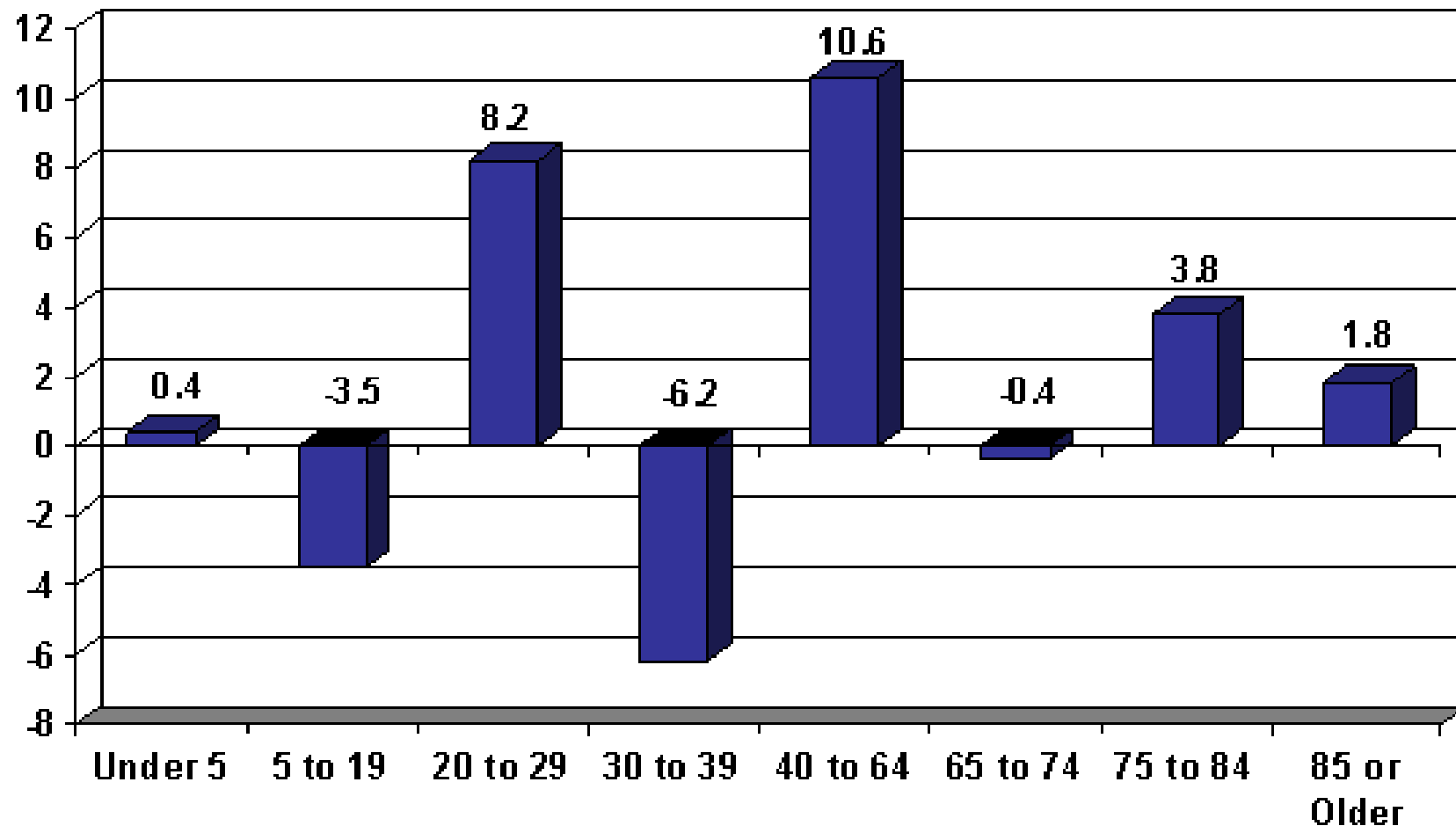
Population by Age & Sex: 2004

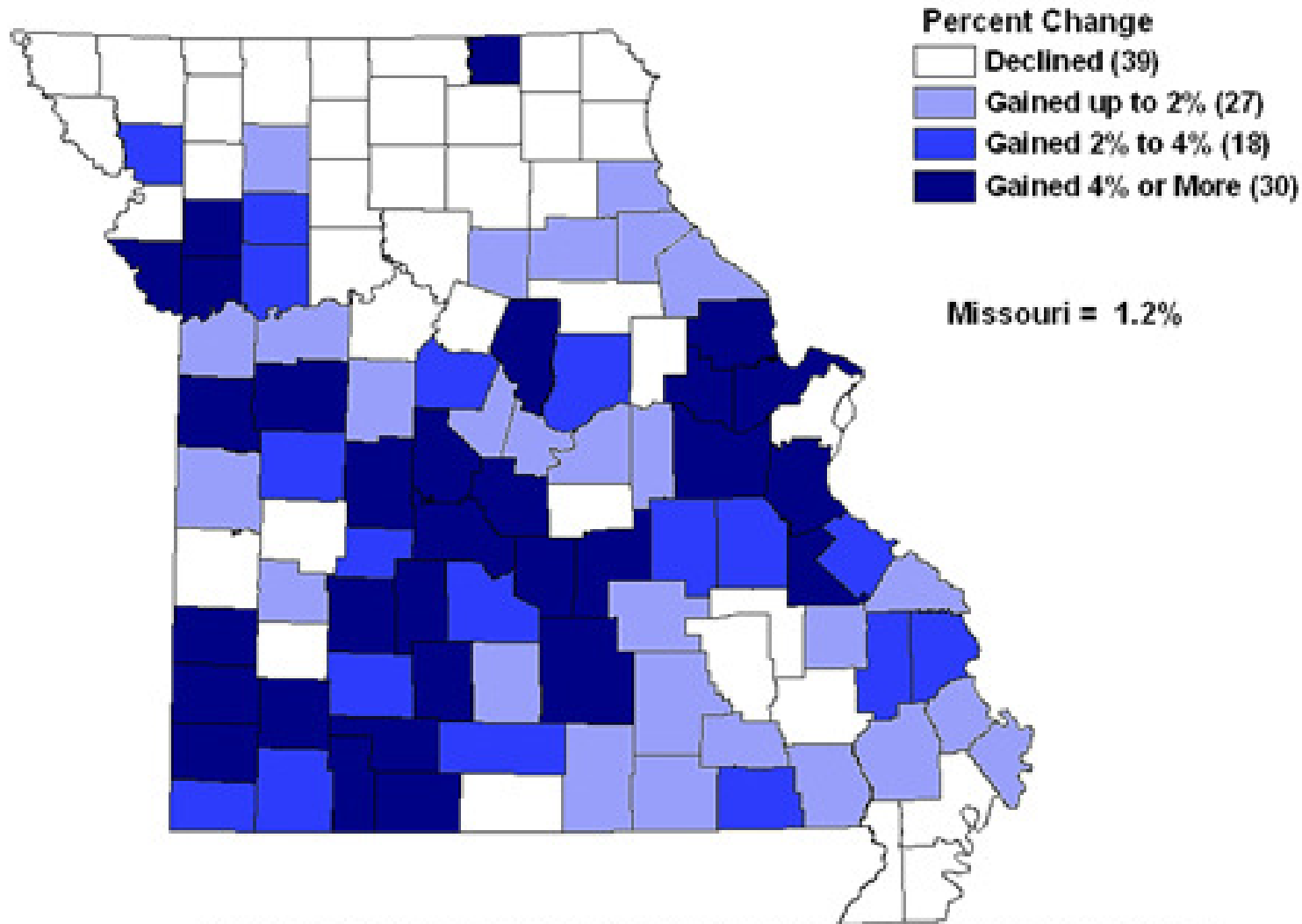


Percent Change in Missouri Population by Selected Age Cohorts, 2000-2004



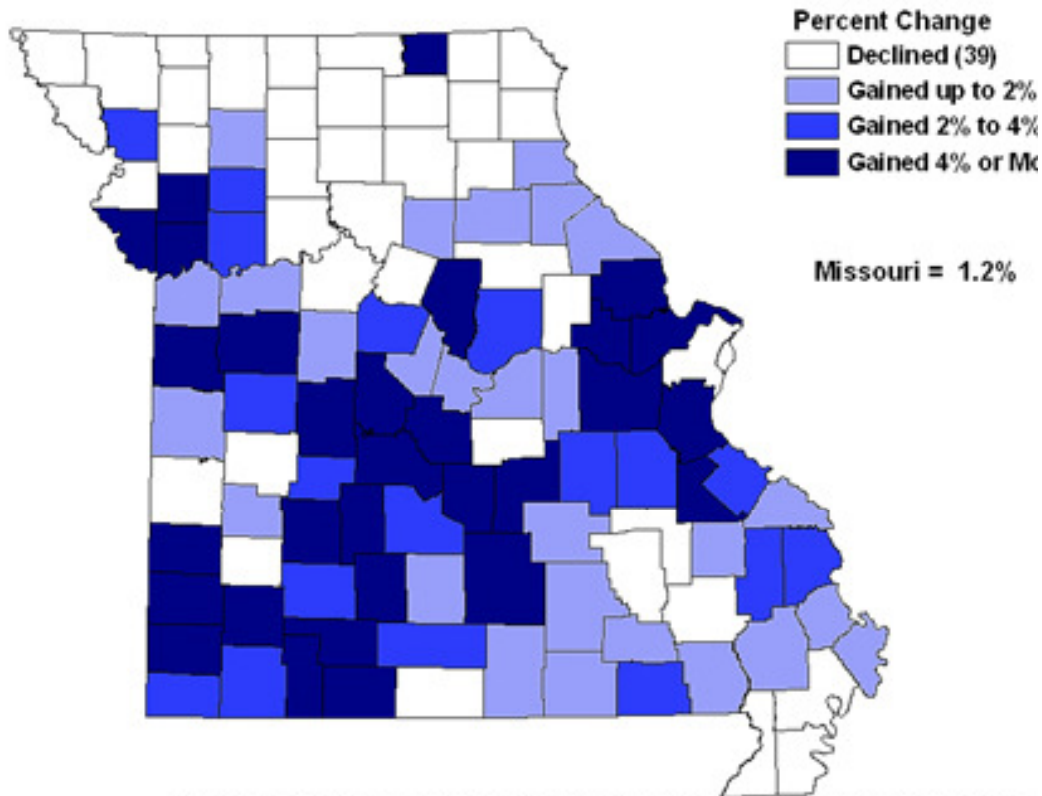

Percent Change in Missouri Population by County 2000-2004



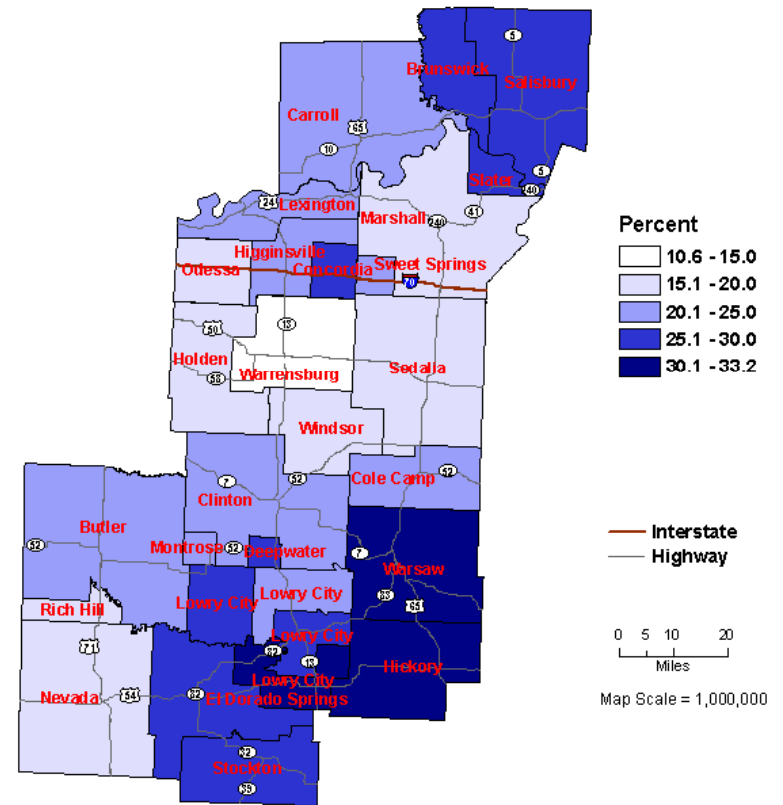

Percent Change in Missouri Population by County 2000-2004



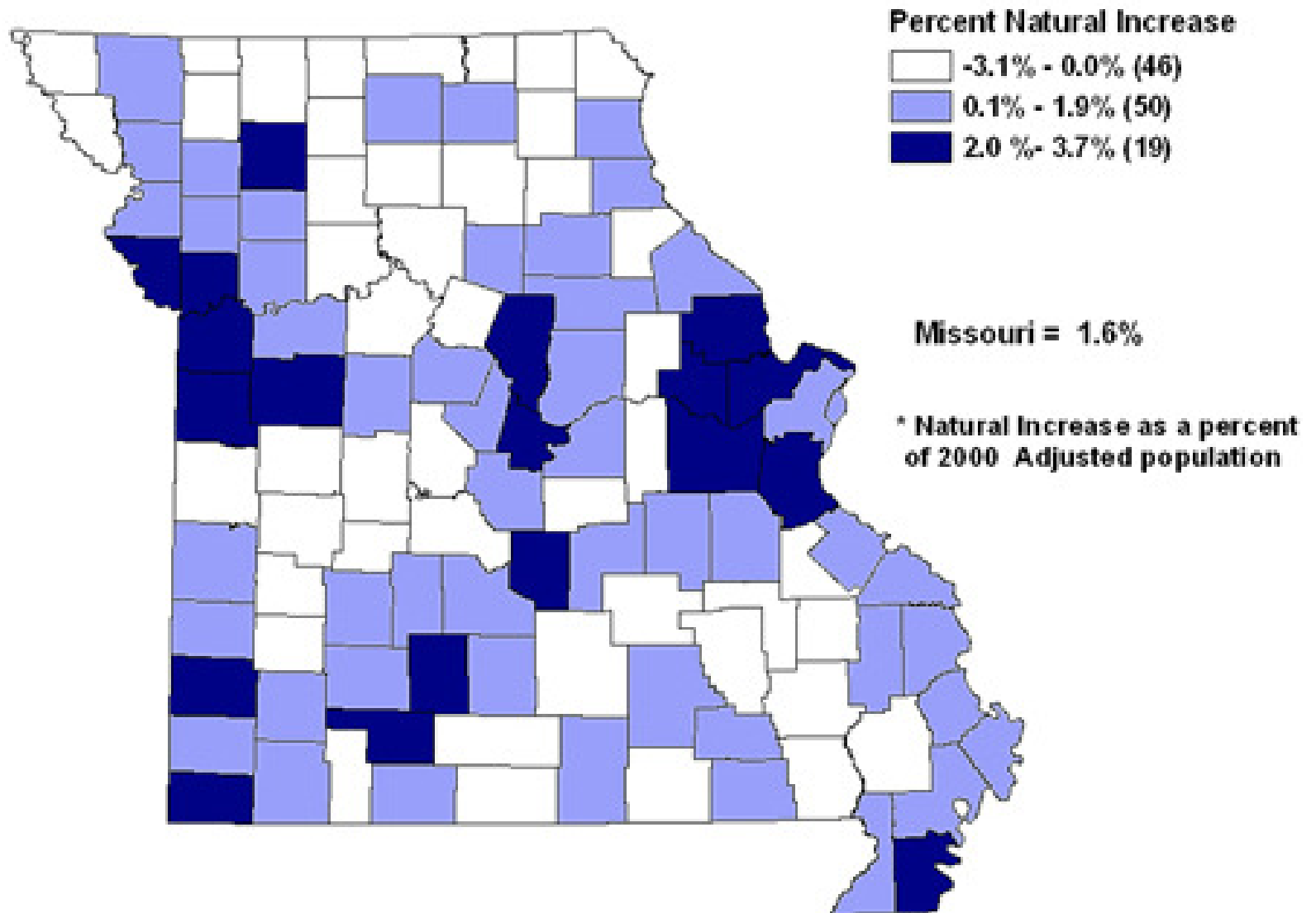

Percent of the Total Population Age 60 and Older by Service Area Within the 13-County Region 2000



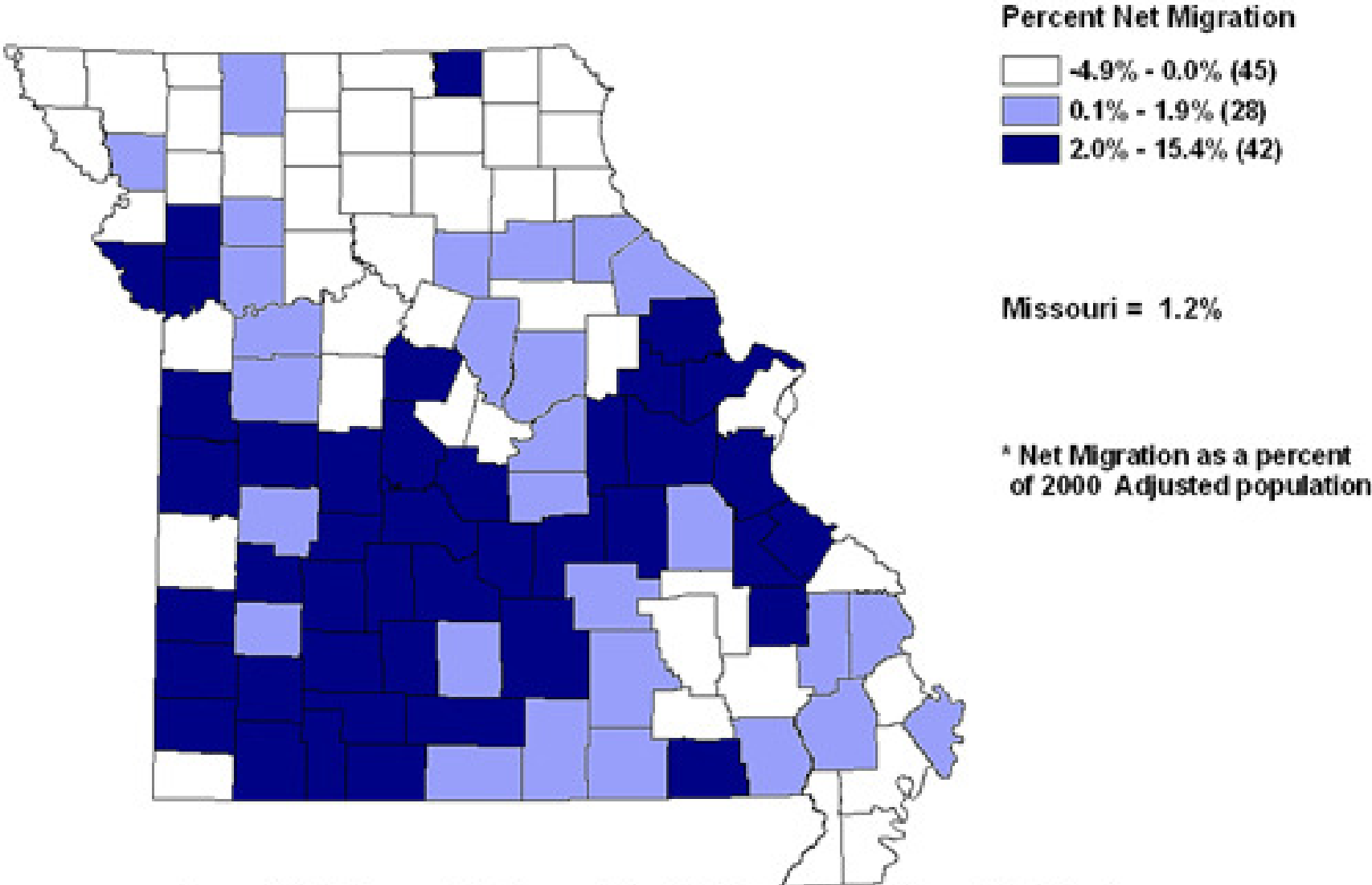

Percent Natural Increase* in Missouri, by County 2000-2004



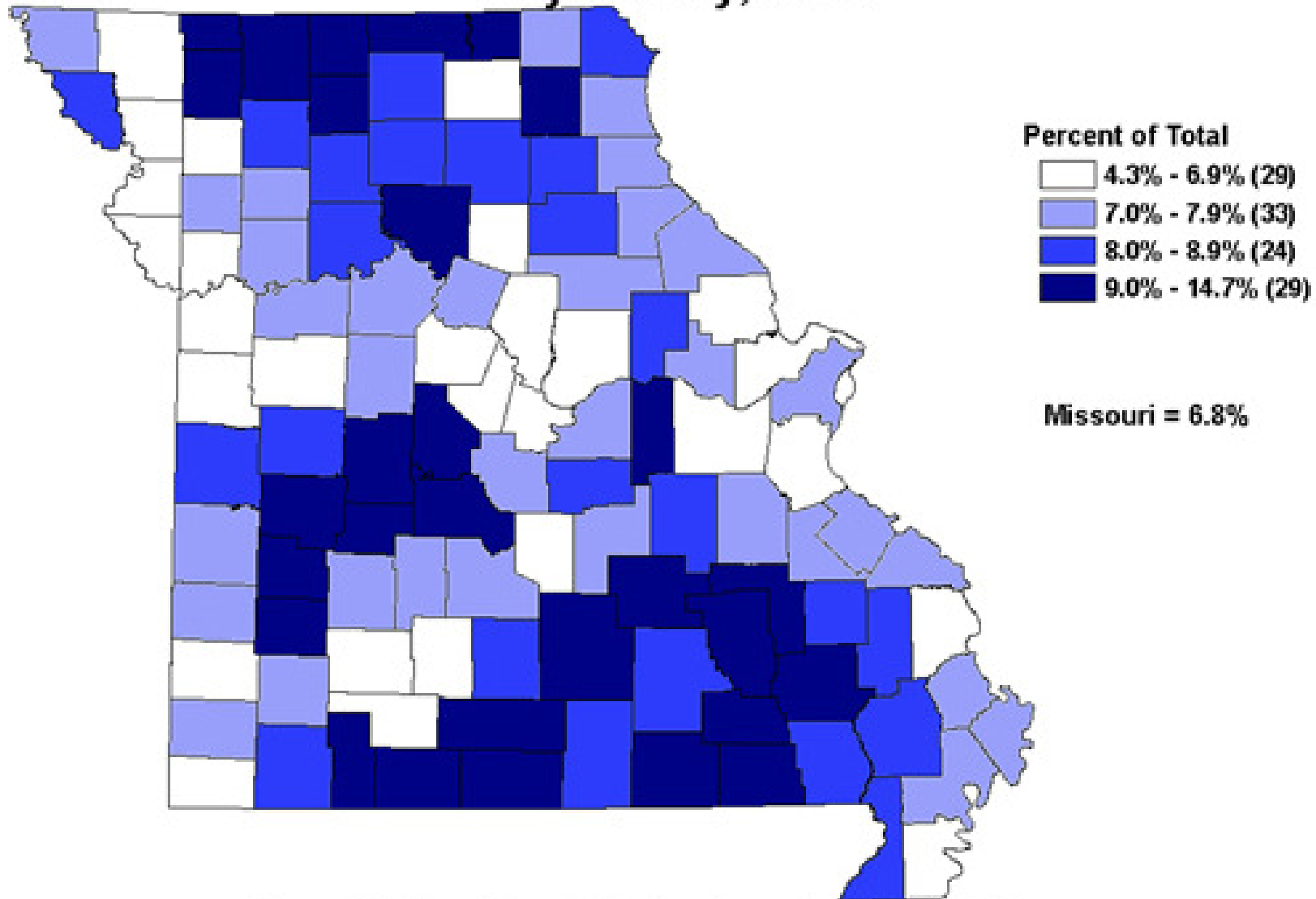

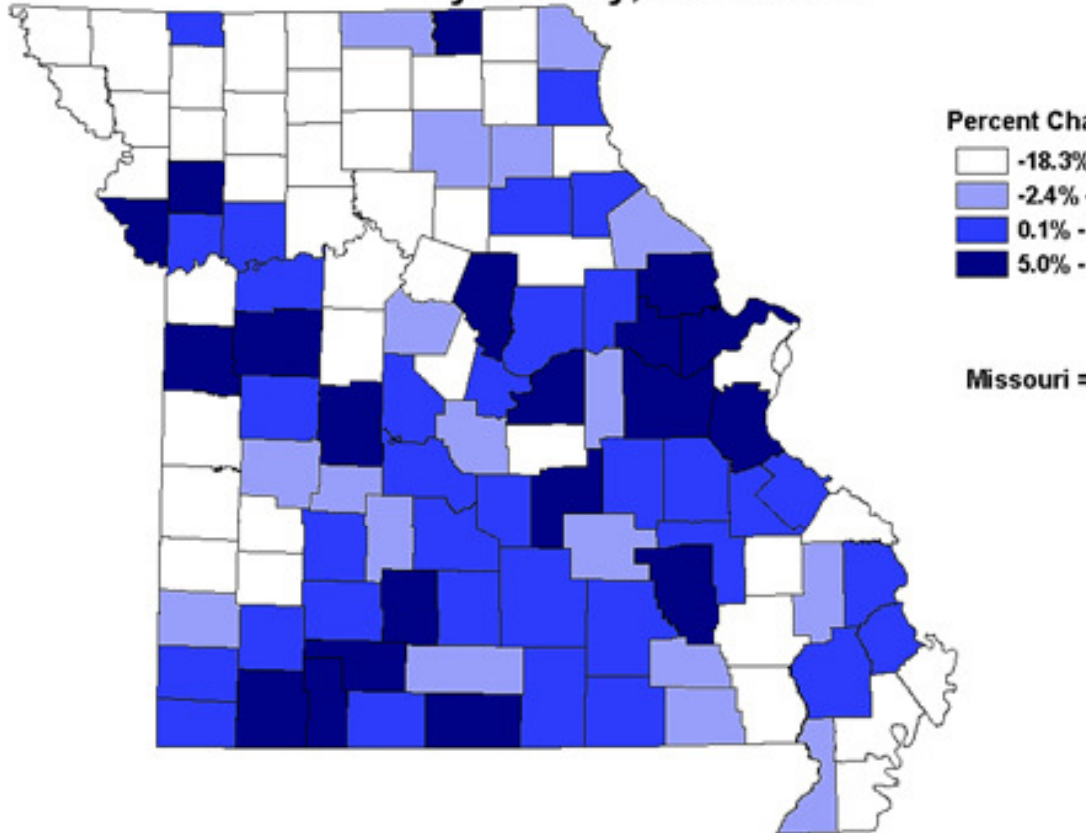
Percent of Missouri Population Age 65 to 74 by County, 2004

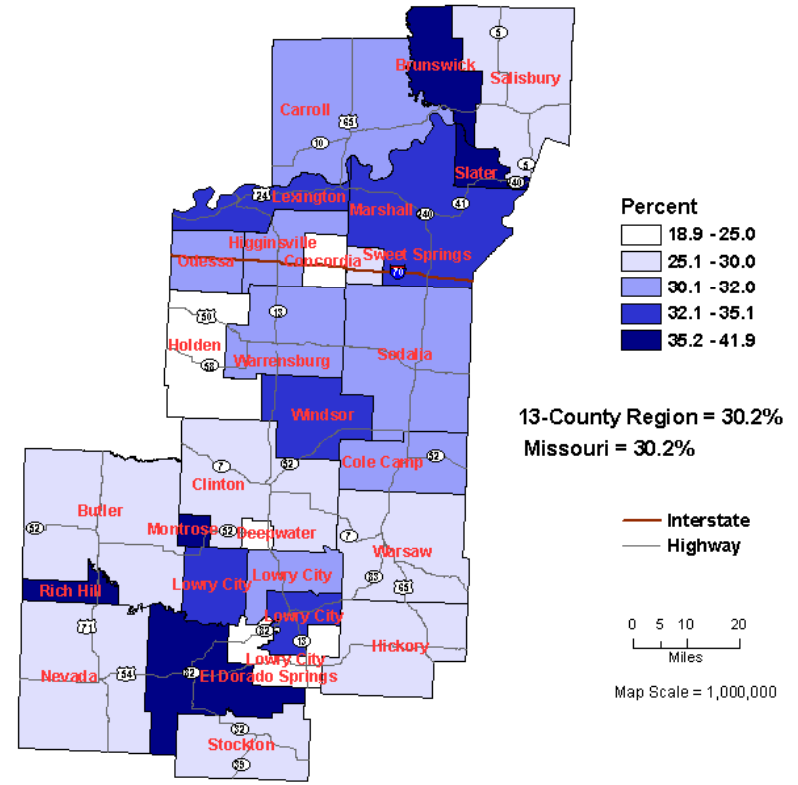

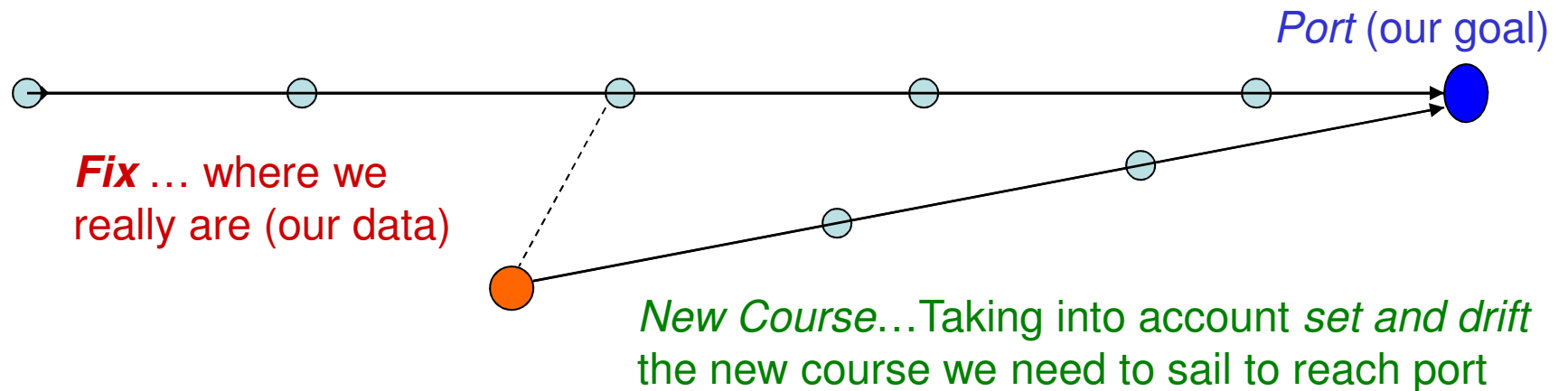

But for data to be useful we have to decide upon a destination – a goal. Then data can be used to help us make decisions—”steer more northerly.”

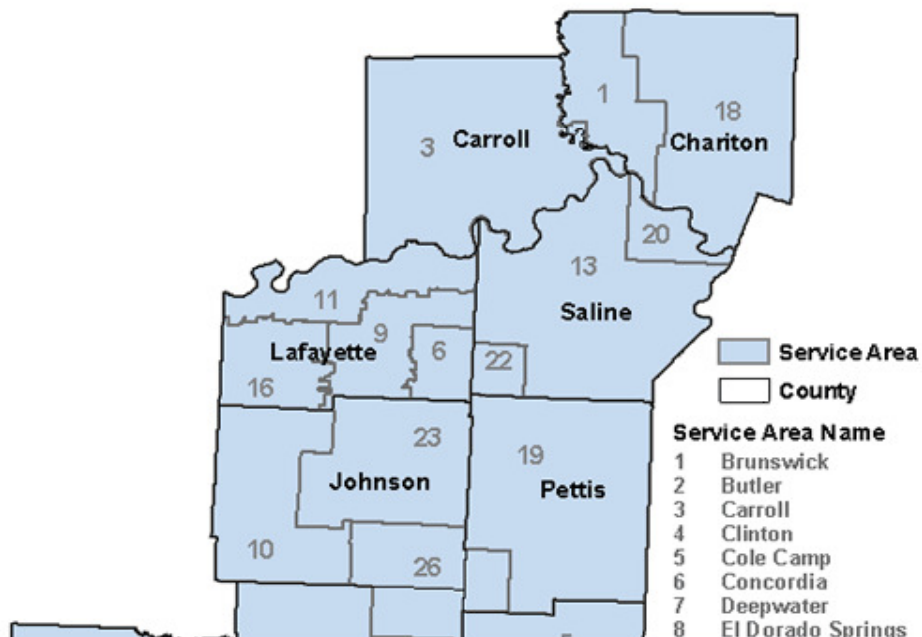
Without a goal—any course will do and data are not very useful.

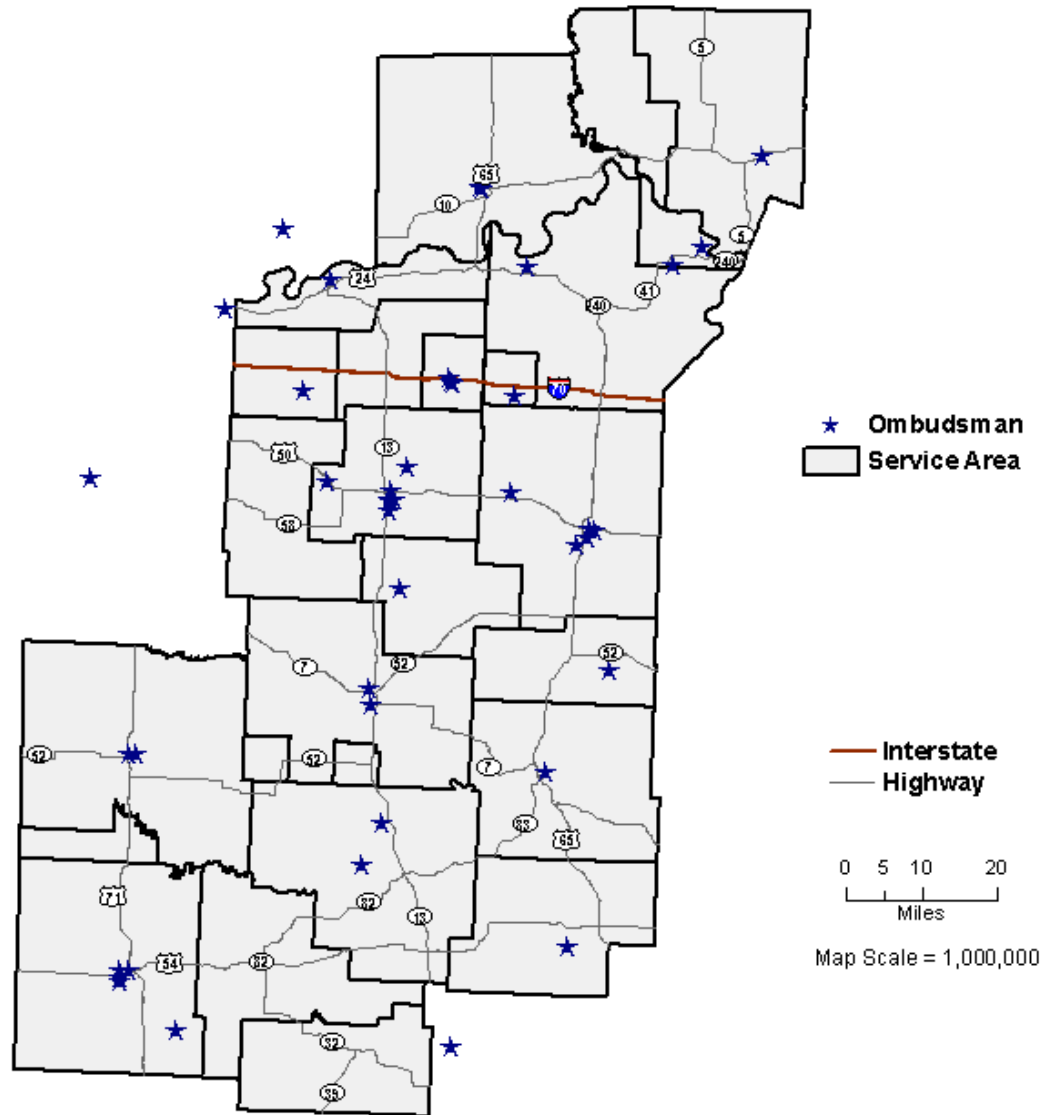

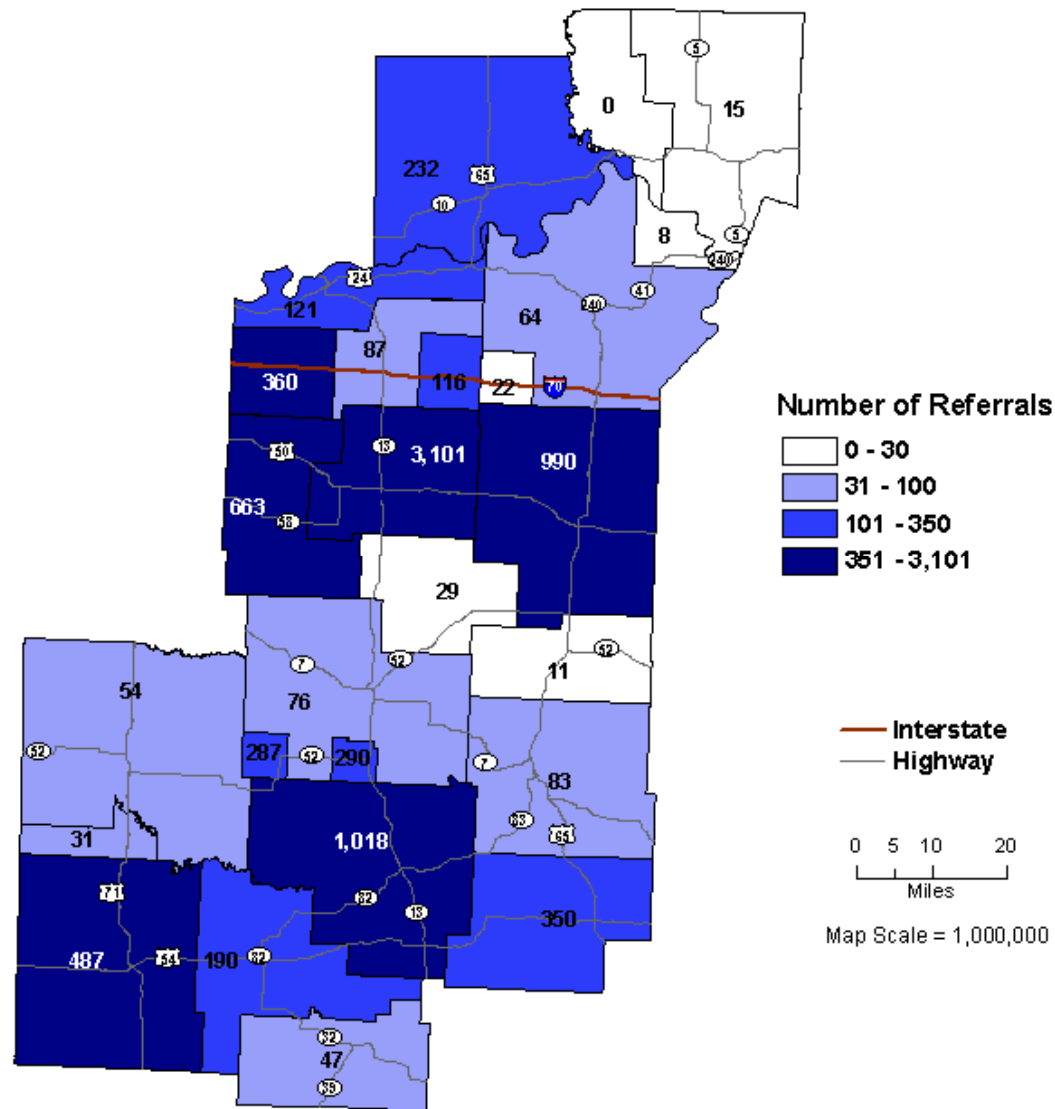

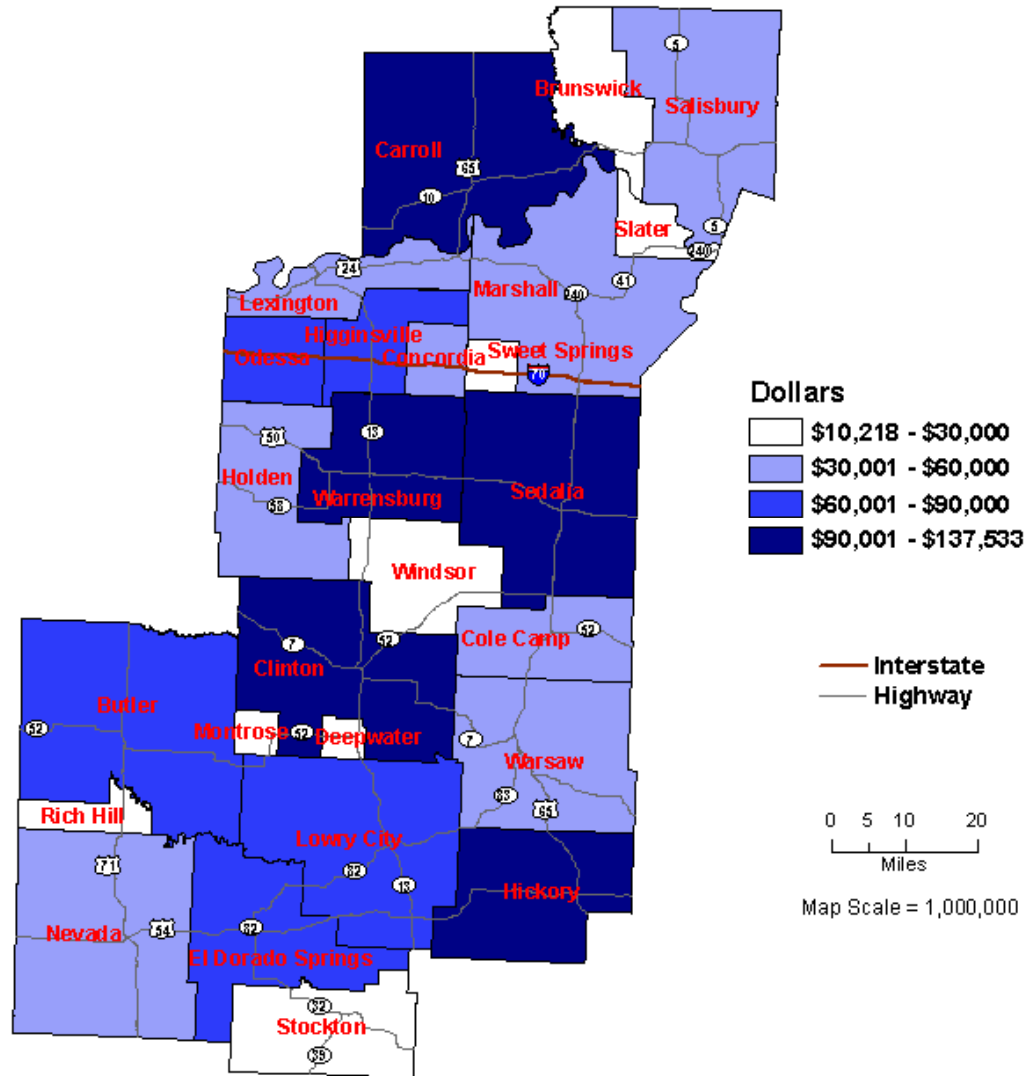
Care Connection Information and Assistance Services by Service Area, 2004

Community Cash Match Summary by Service Area, 2004

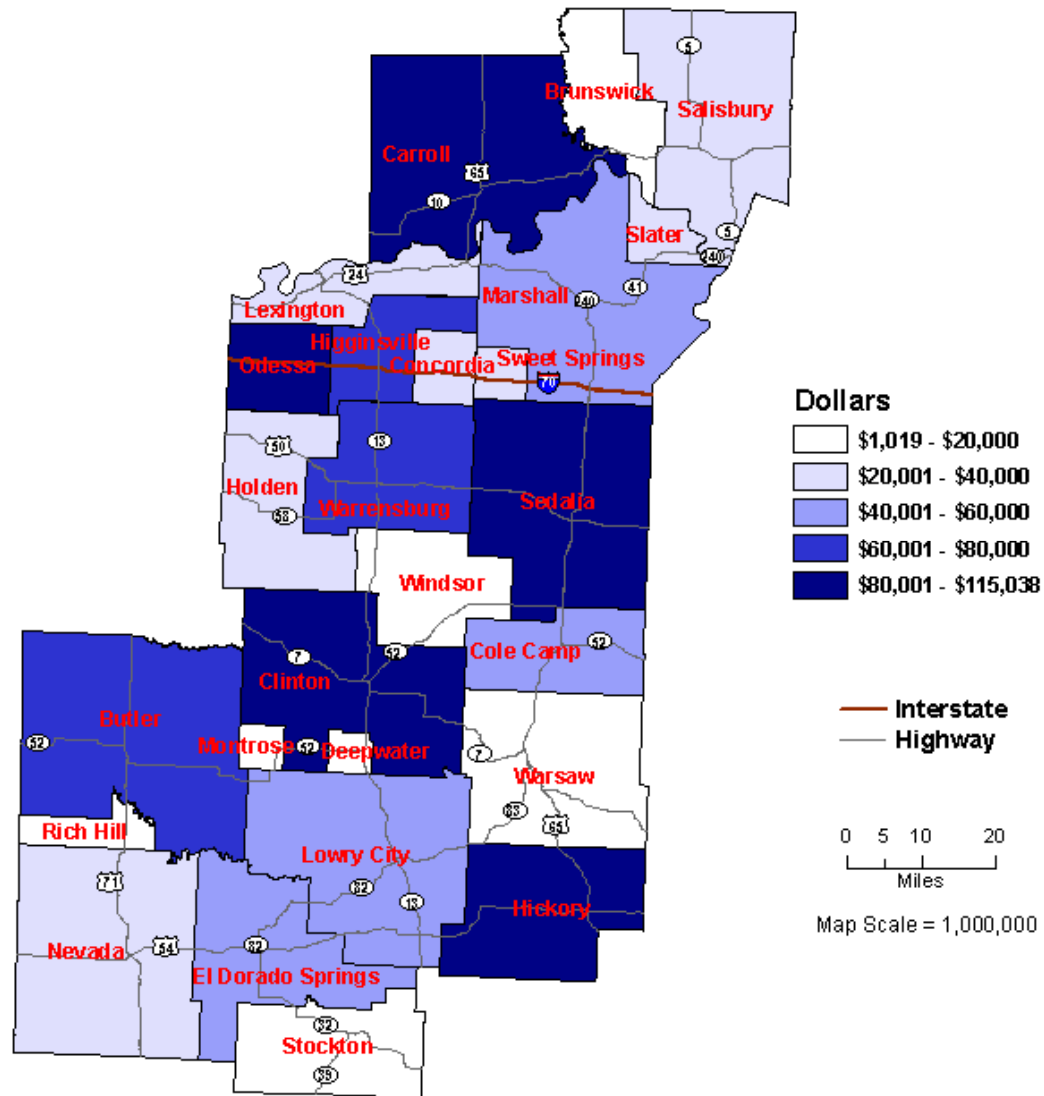

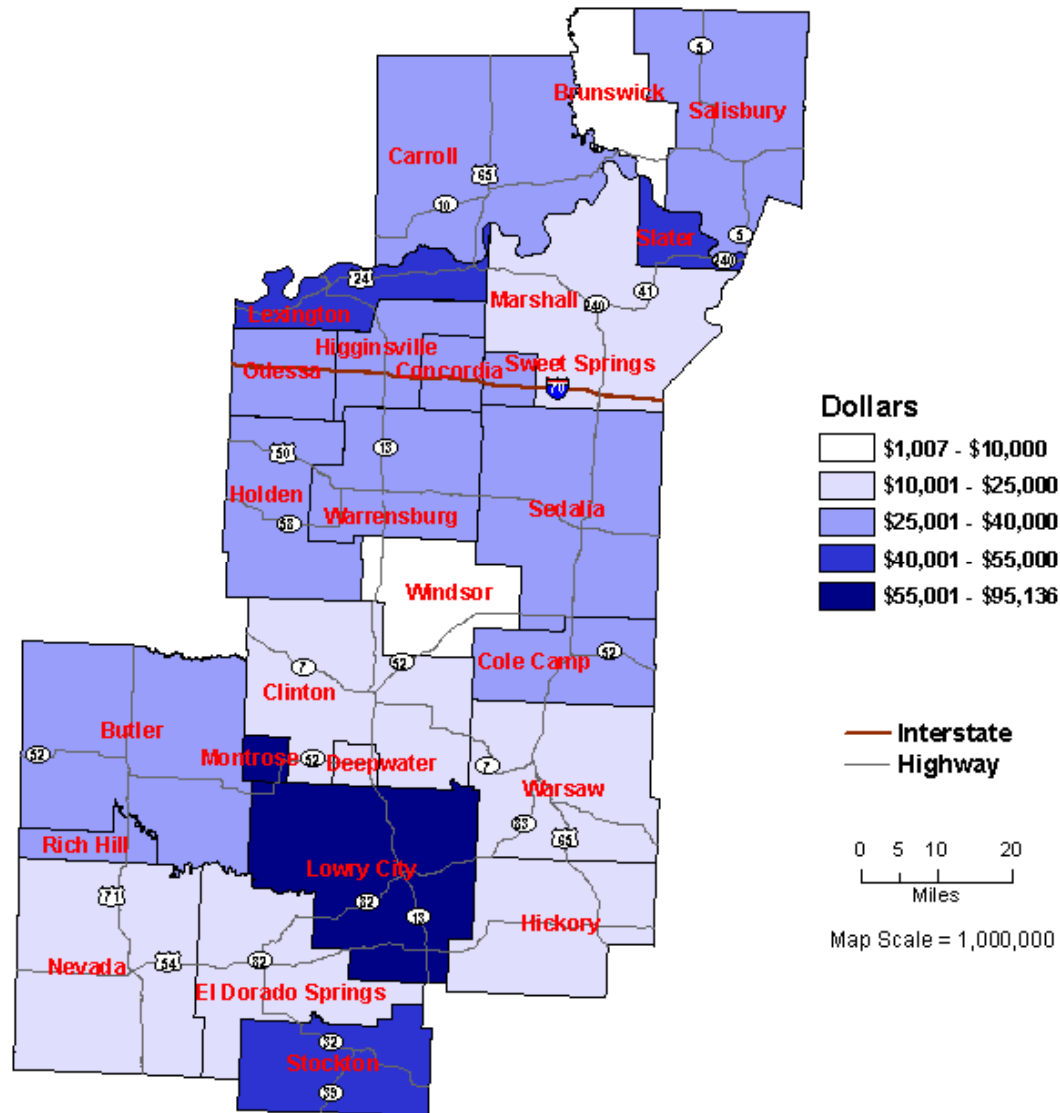
Net Community Match

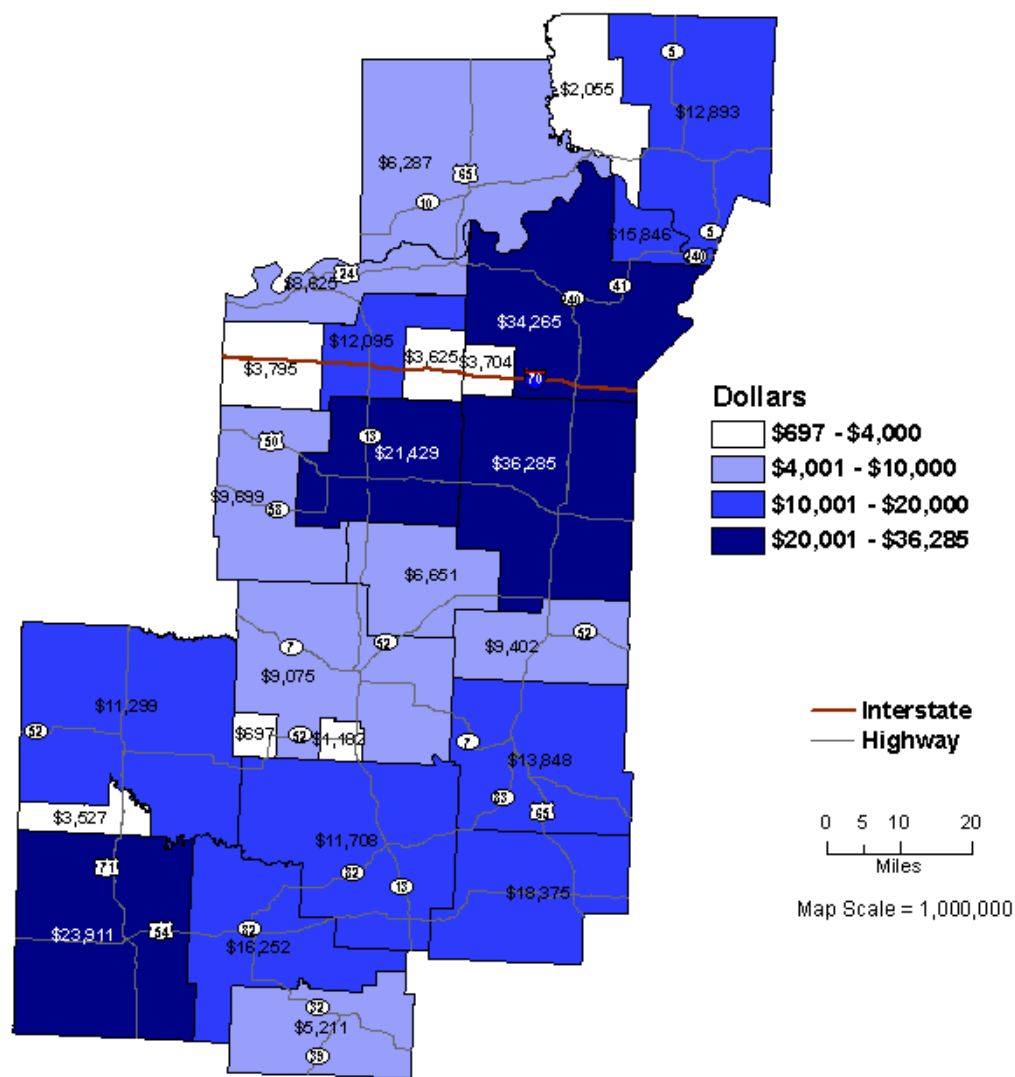
Community Cash Match Summary by Service Area, 2004

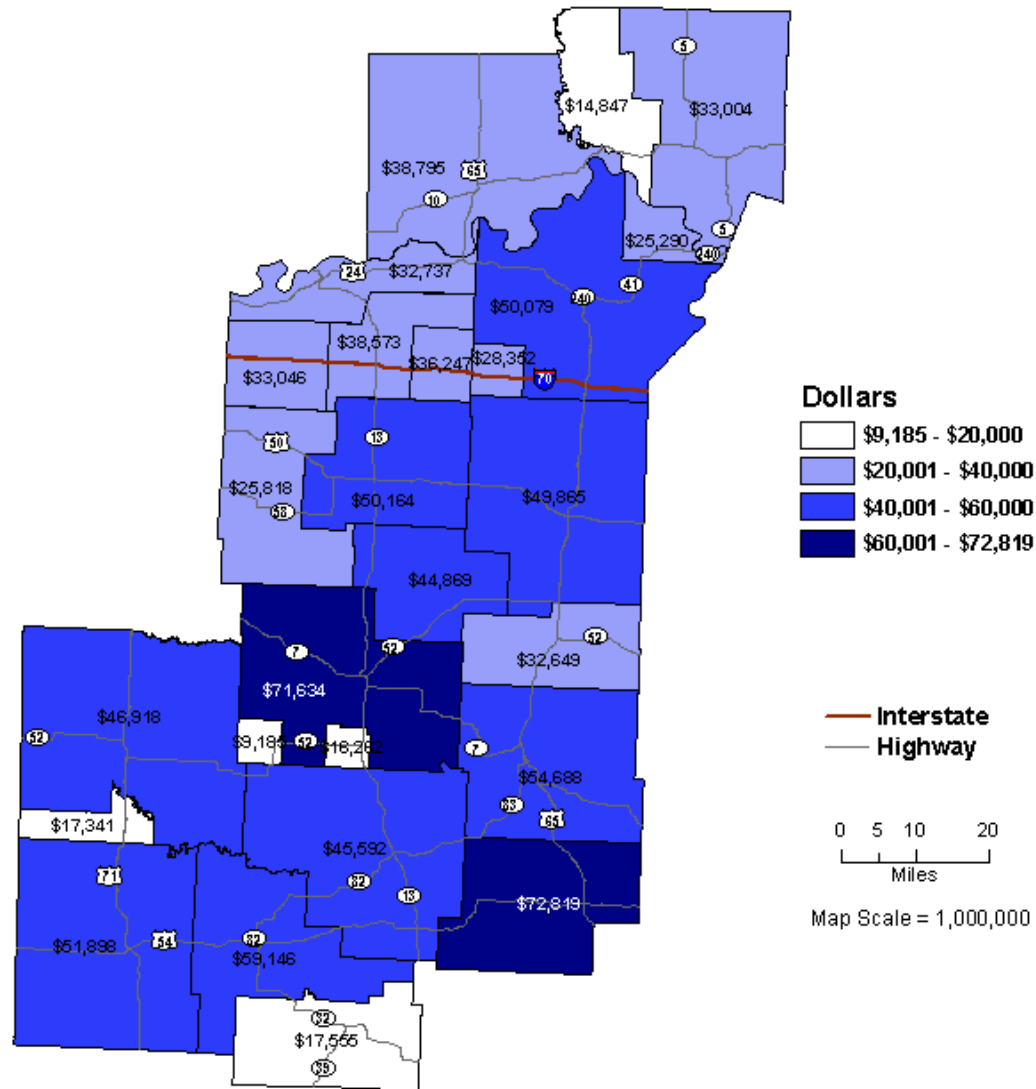
Care Connection Medicaid Dollars by Service Area, 2004

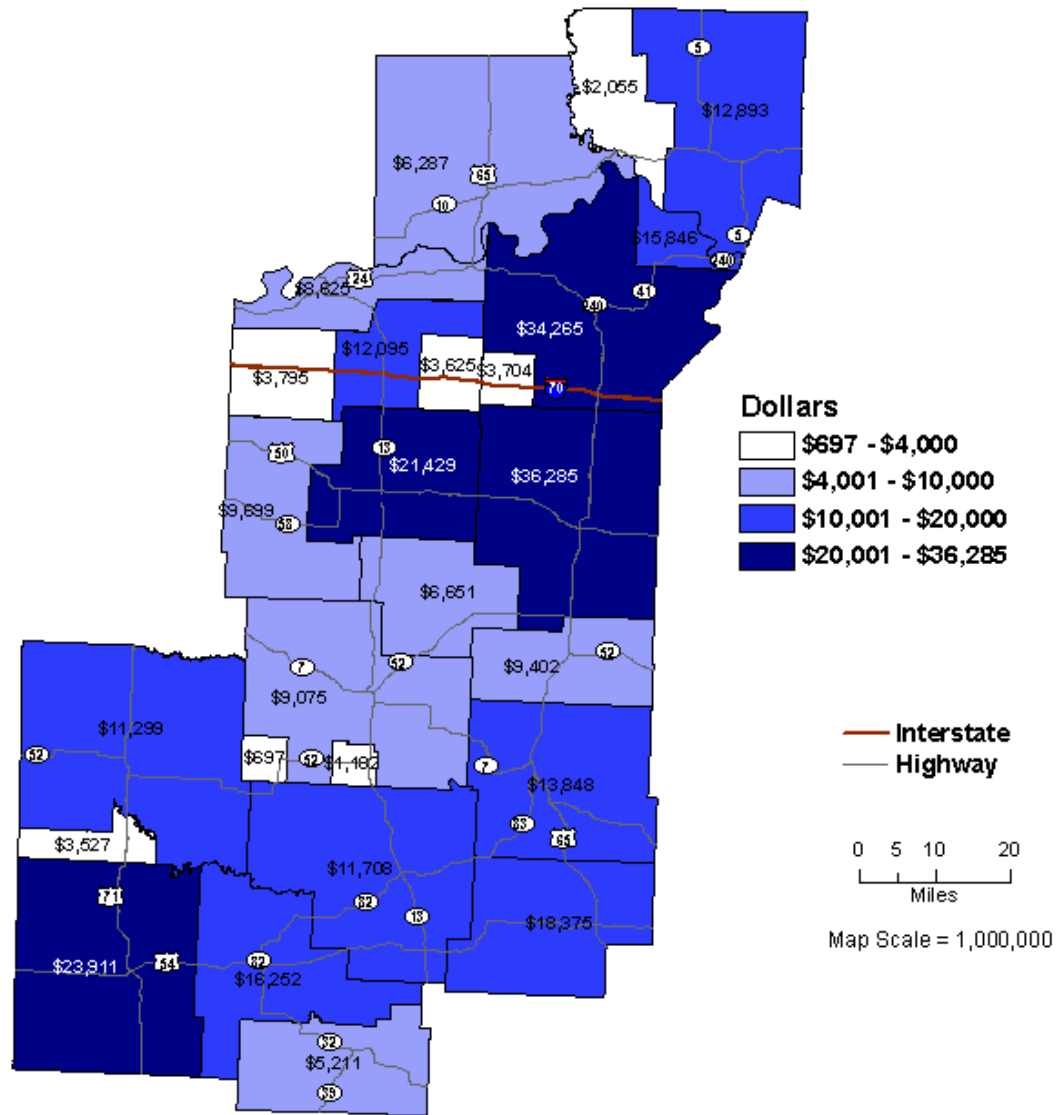

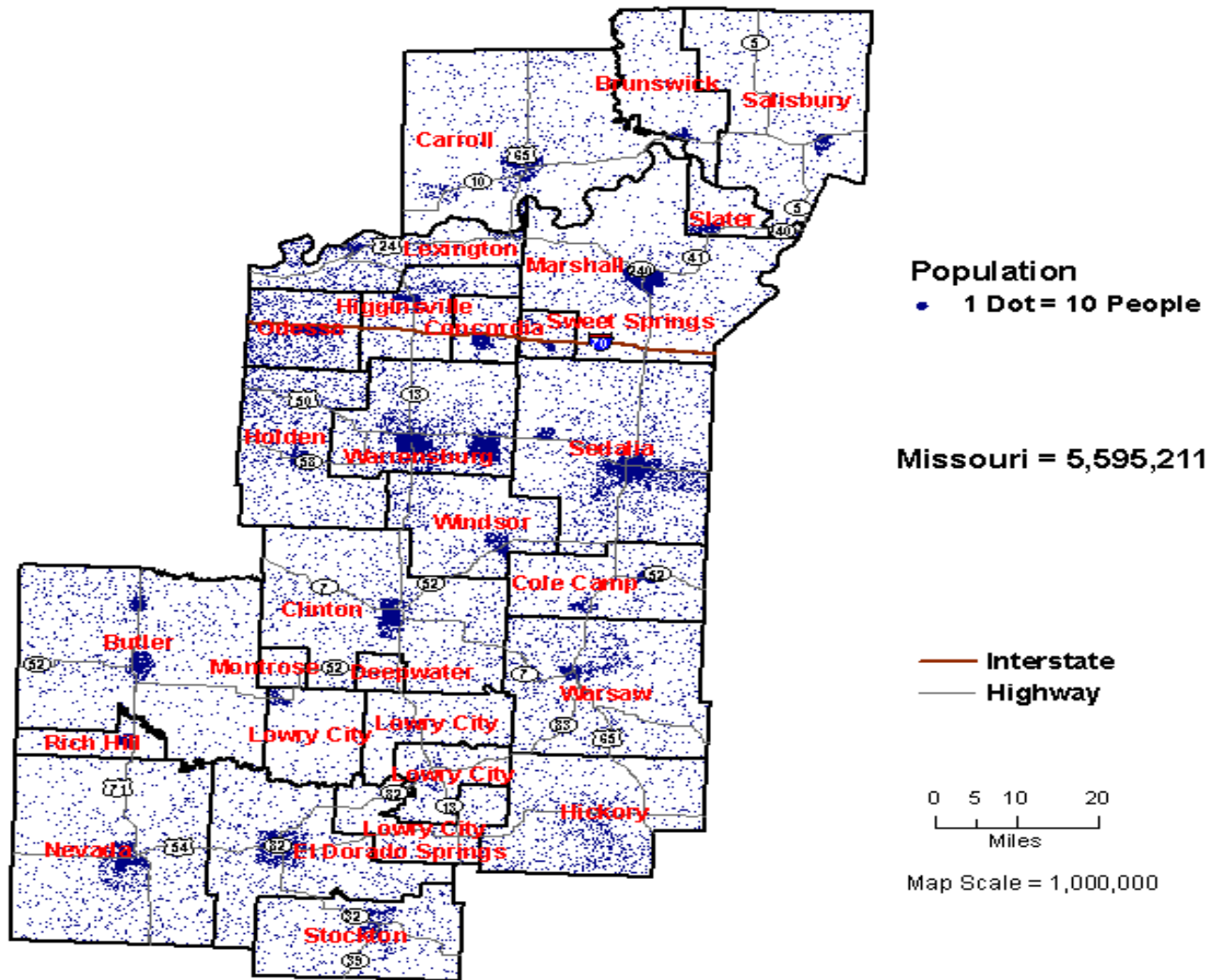

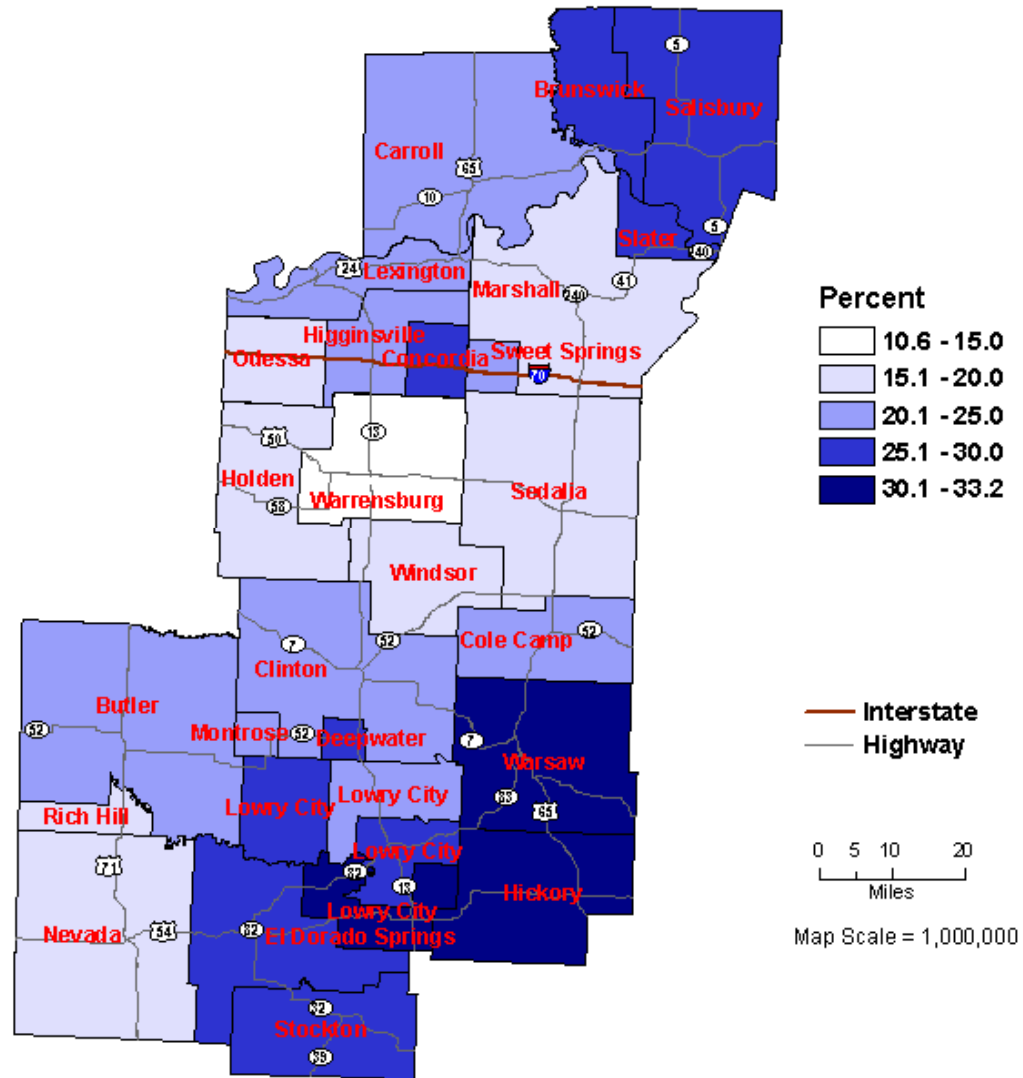

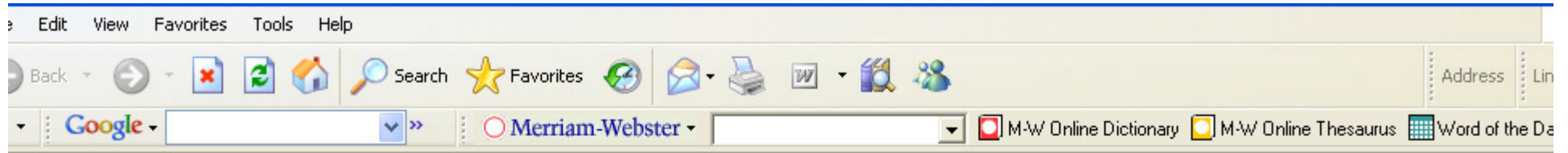

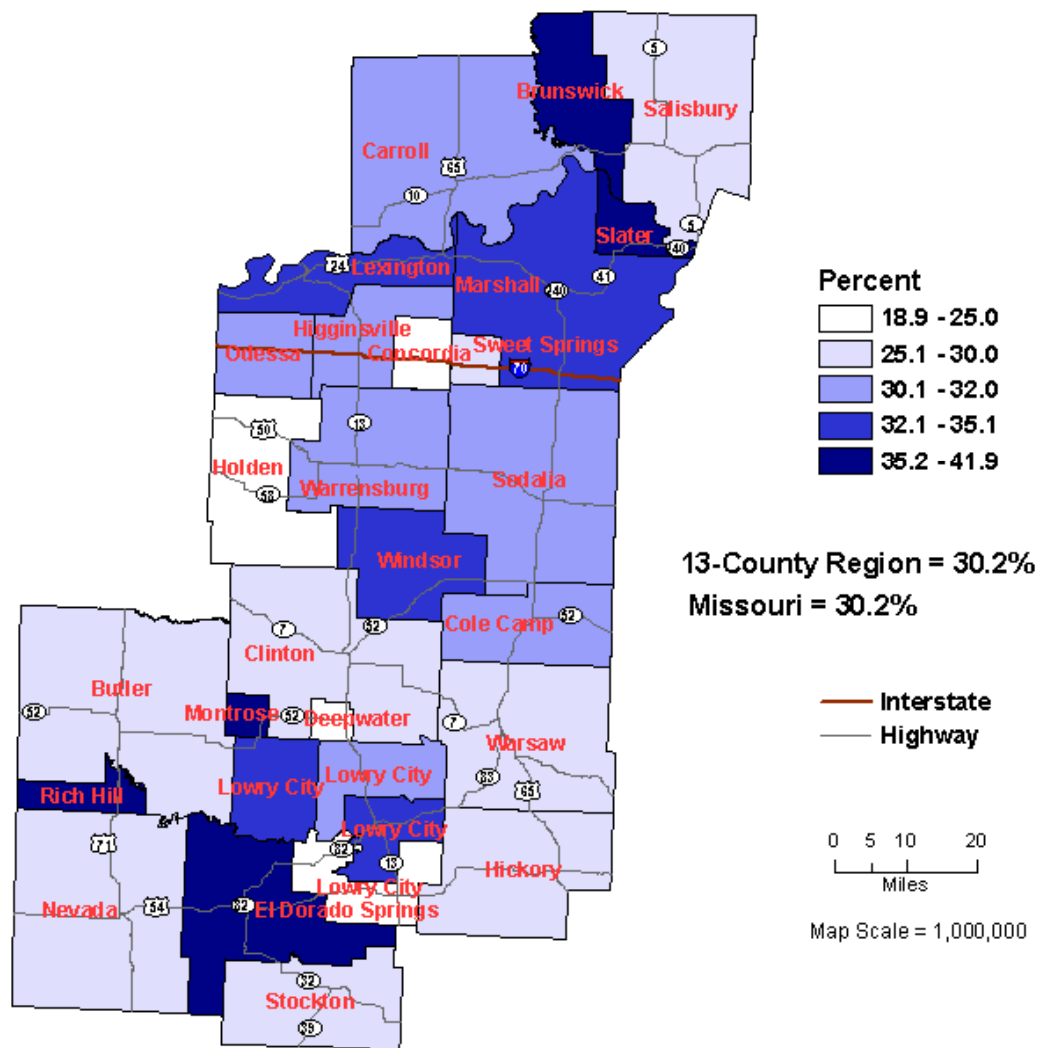

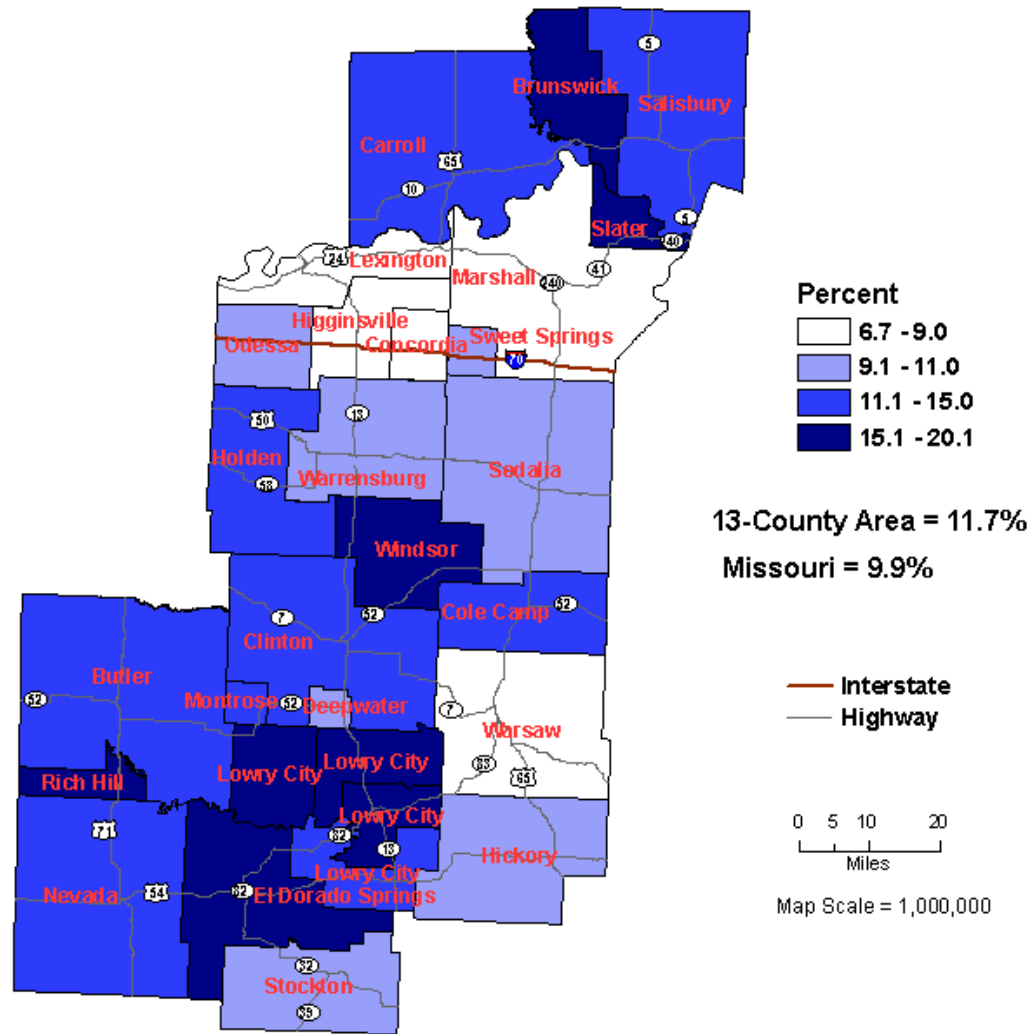

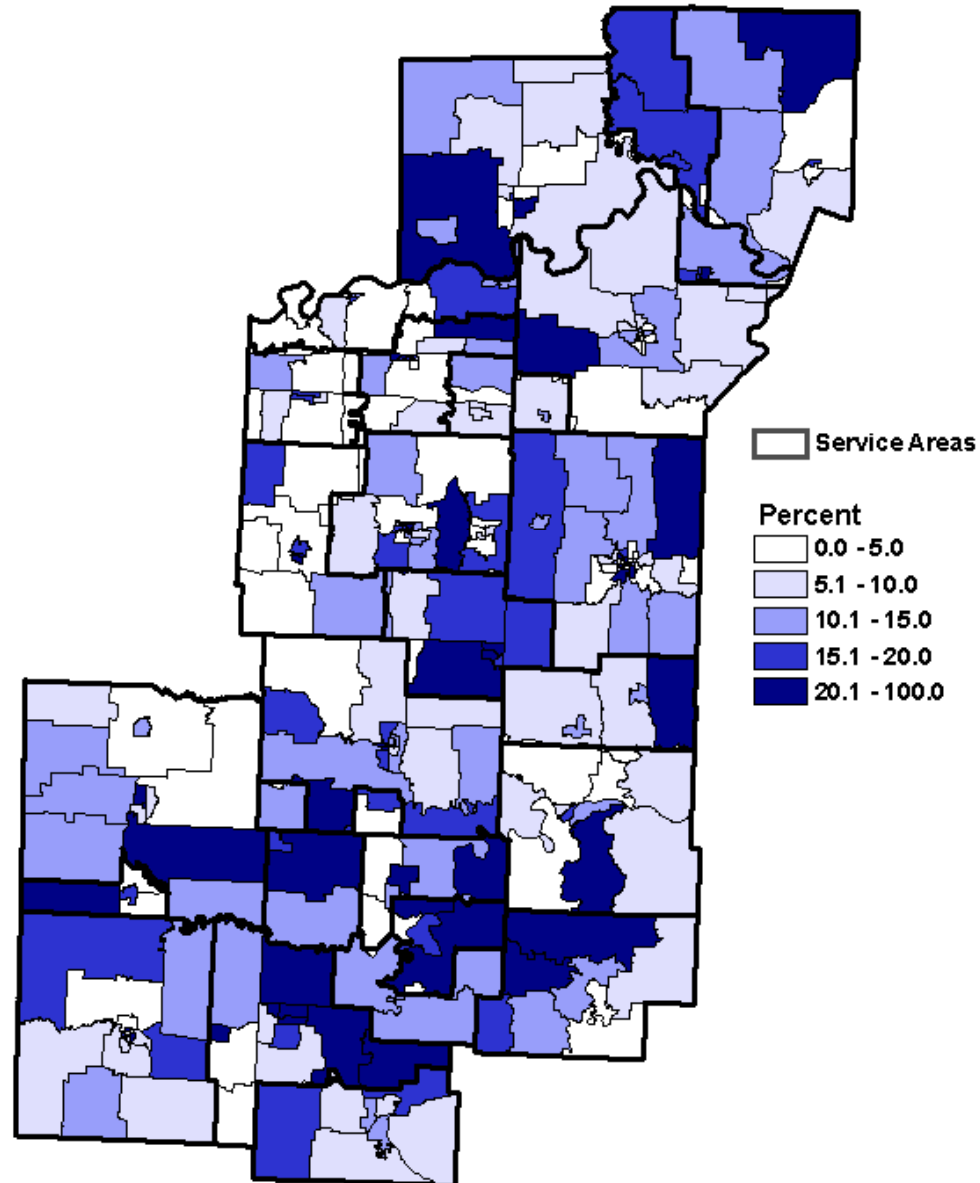

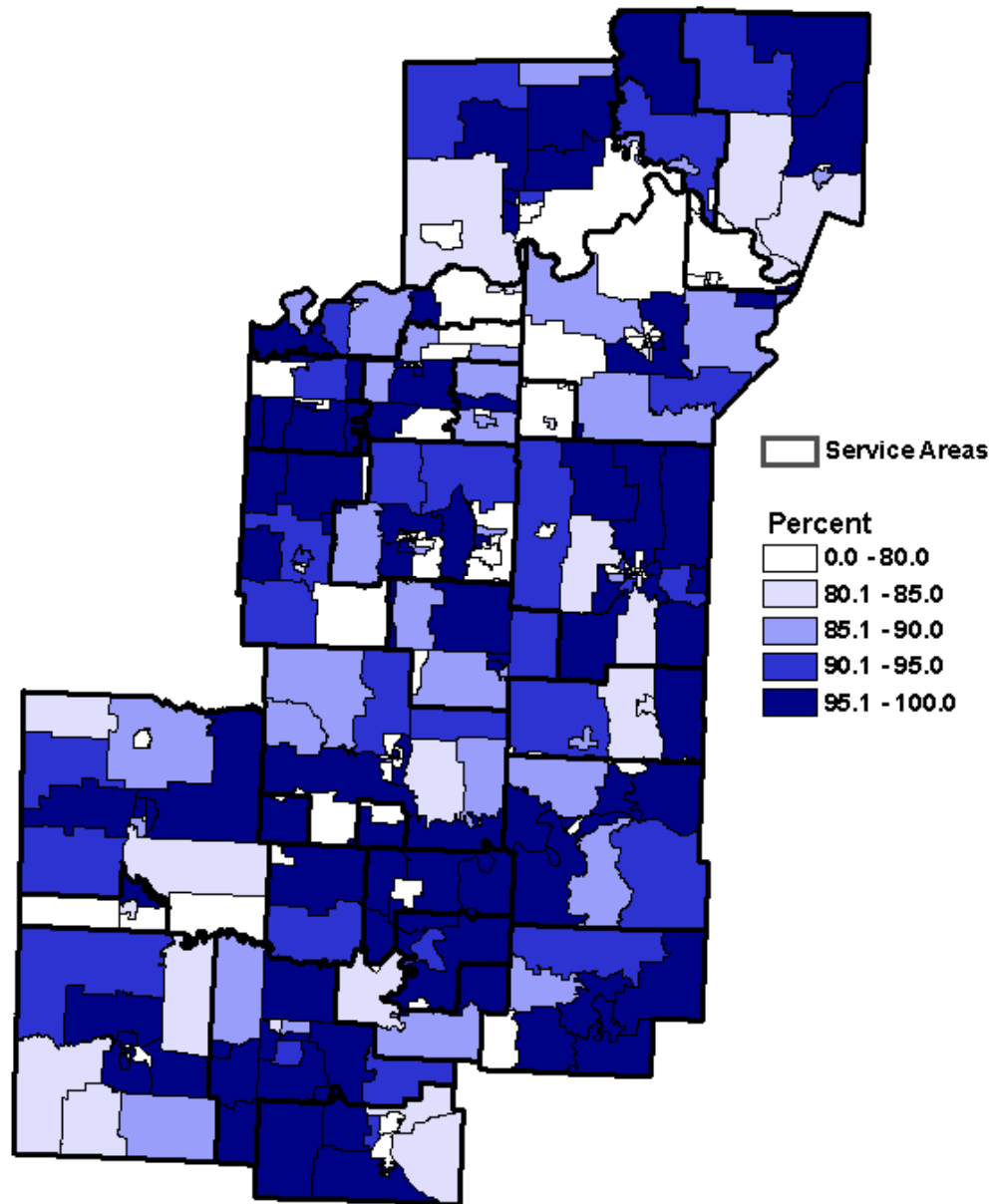

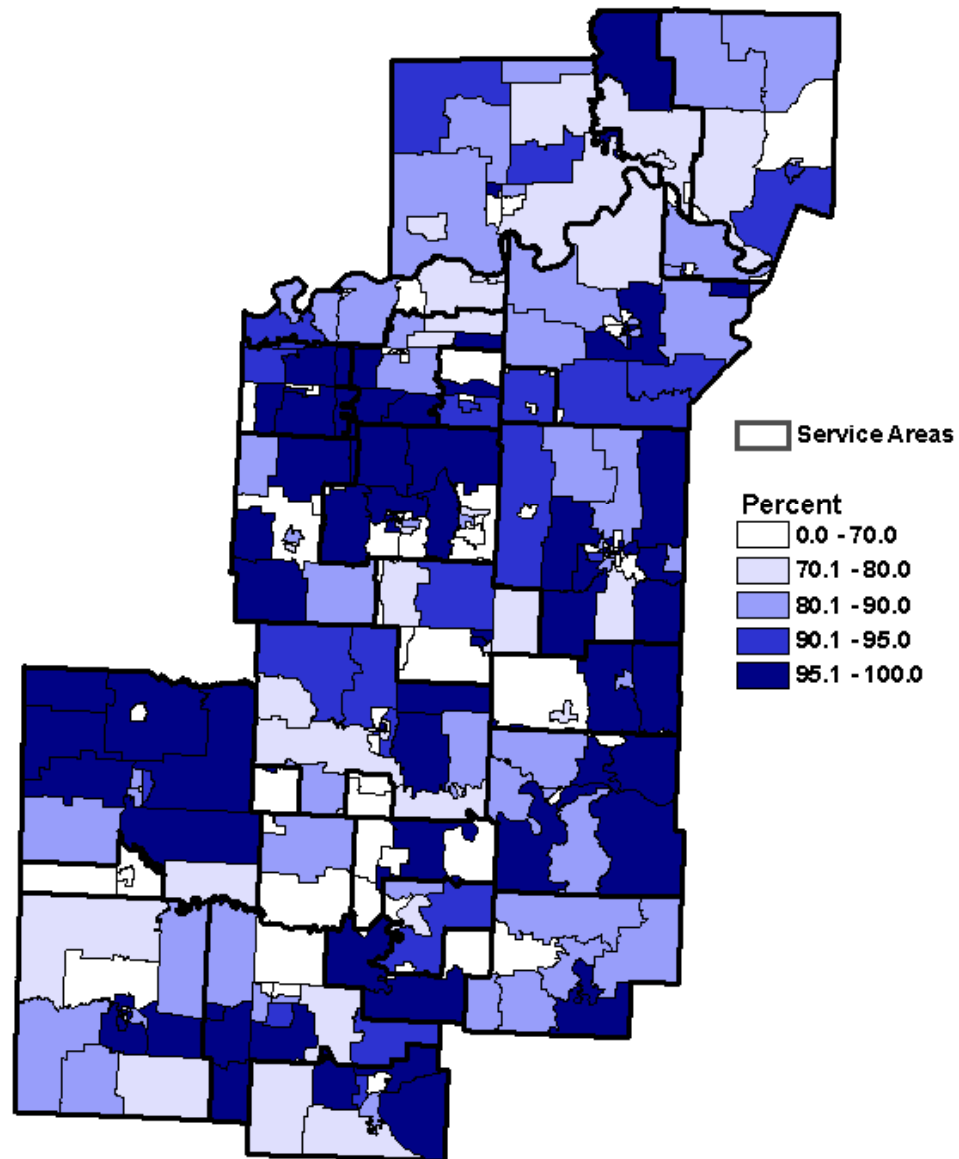

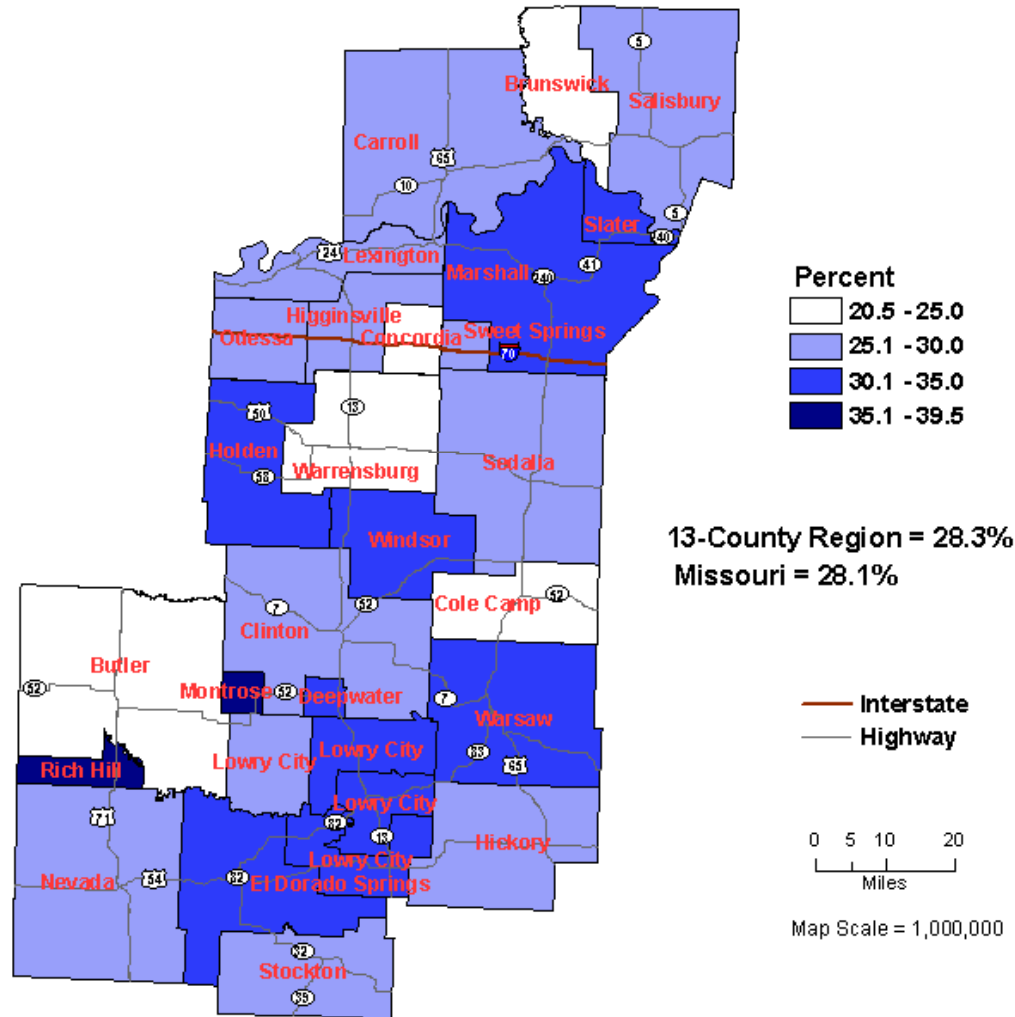

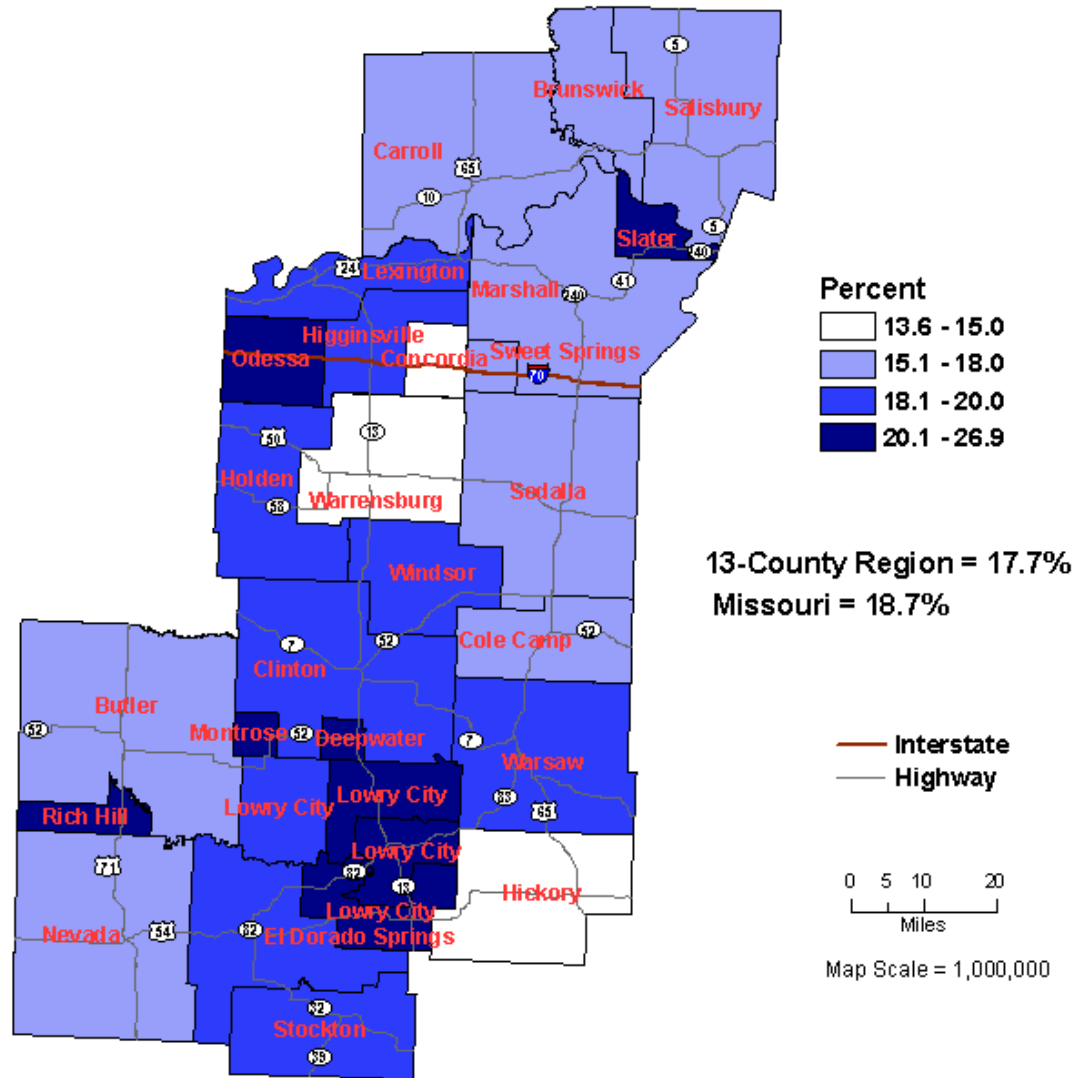

Percent Population 65 & Older With a Physical Disability by Service Area Within the 13-County Region 2000



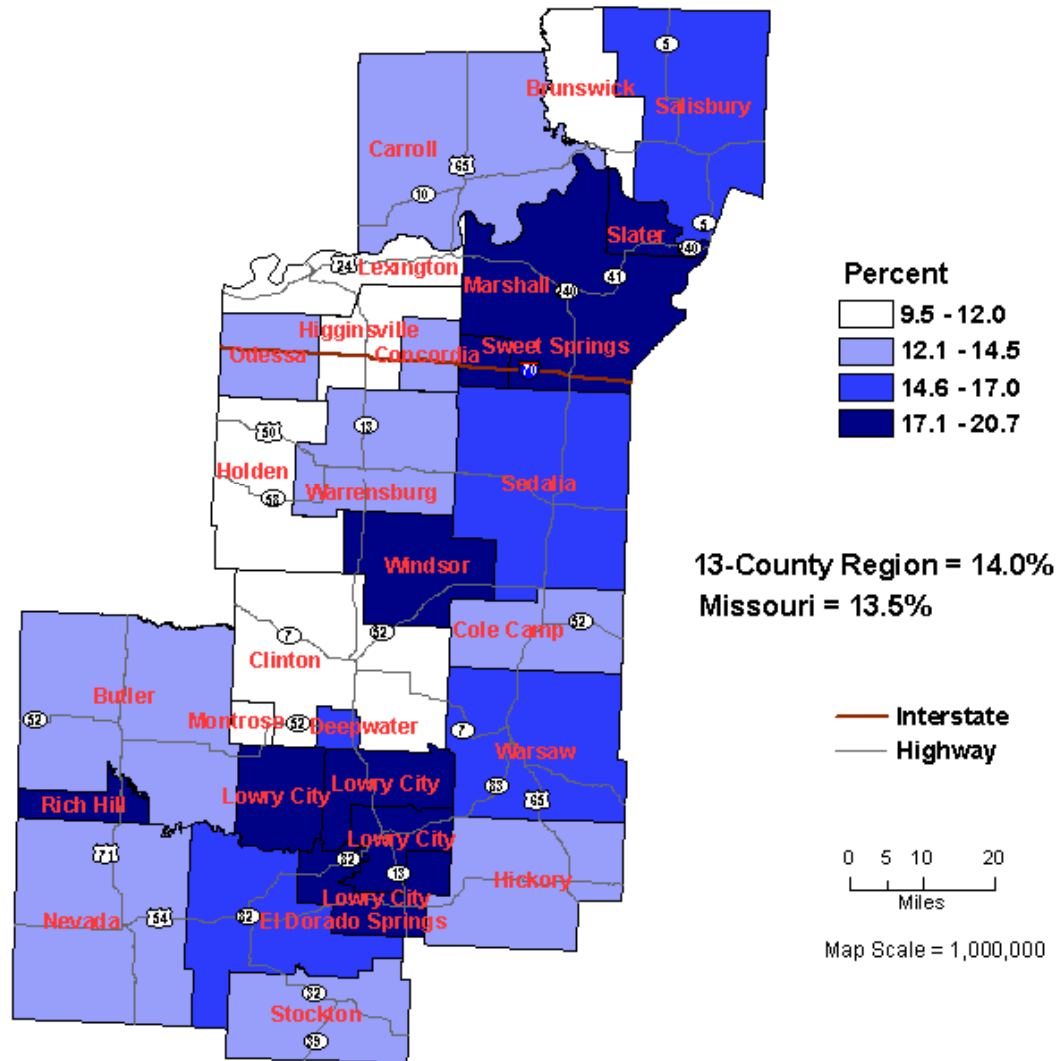

Percent Population 65 & Older With a Go-out-of-home Disability by Service Area Within the 13-County Region 2000



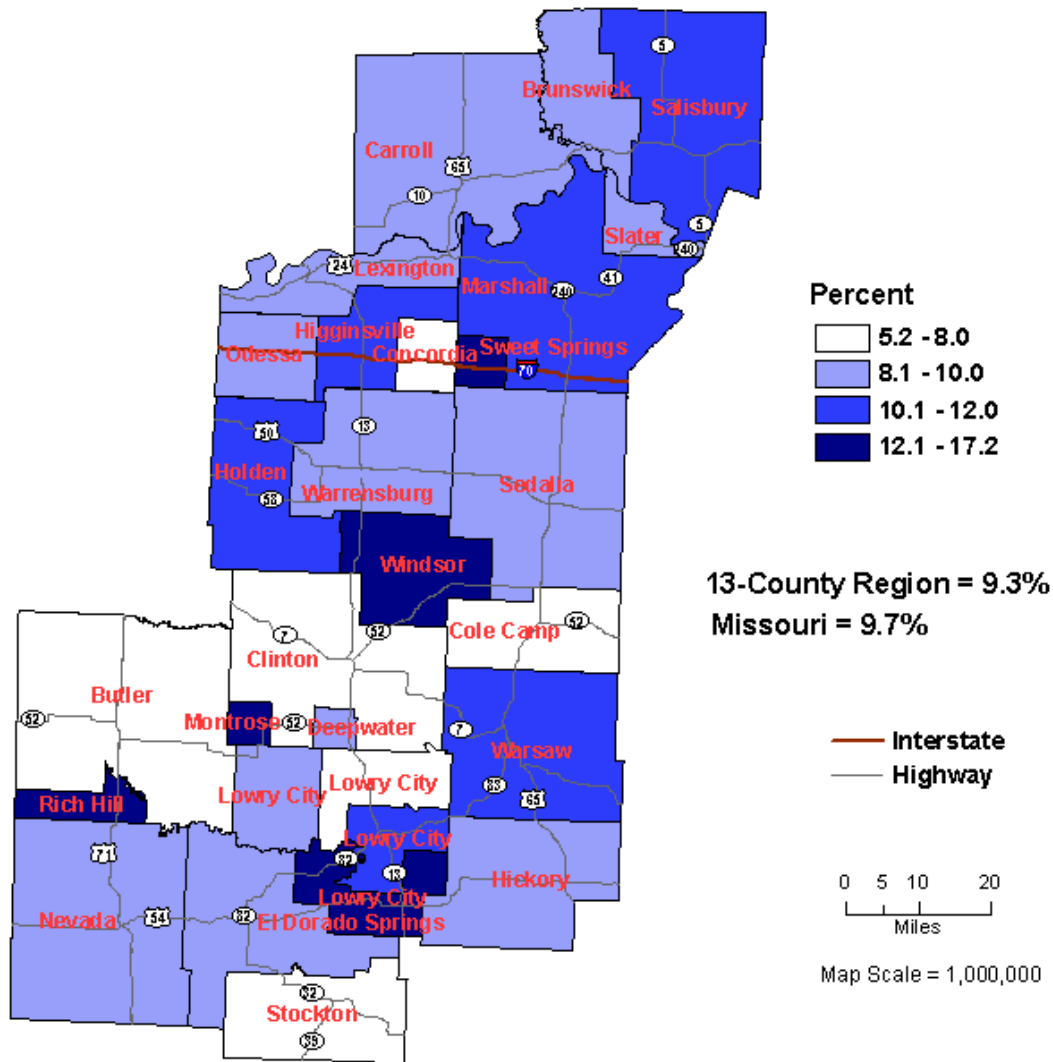

Percent Population 65 & Older With a Sensory Disability by Service Area Within the 13-County Region 2000



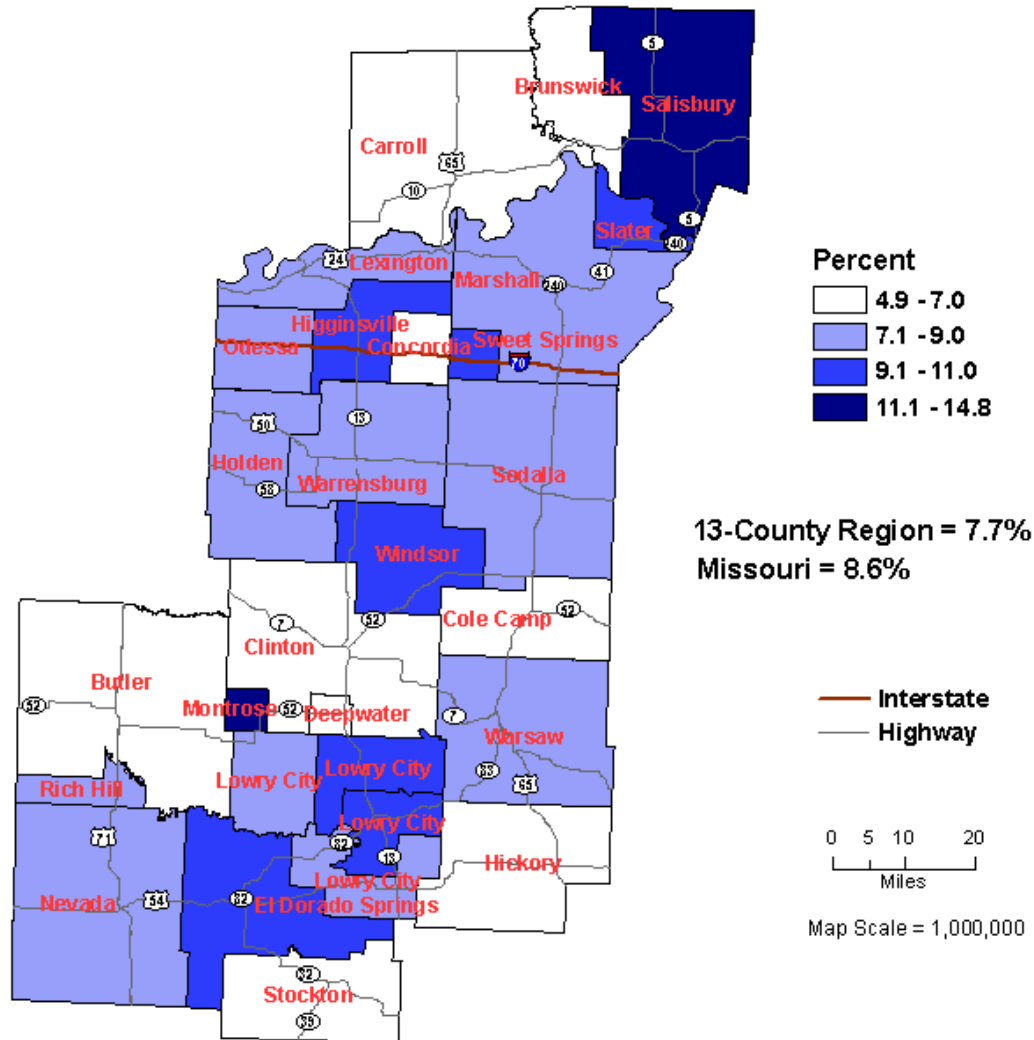
