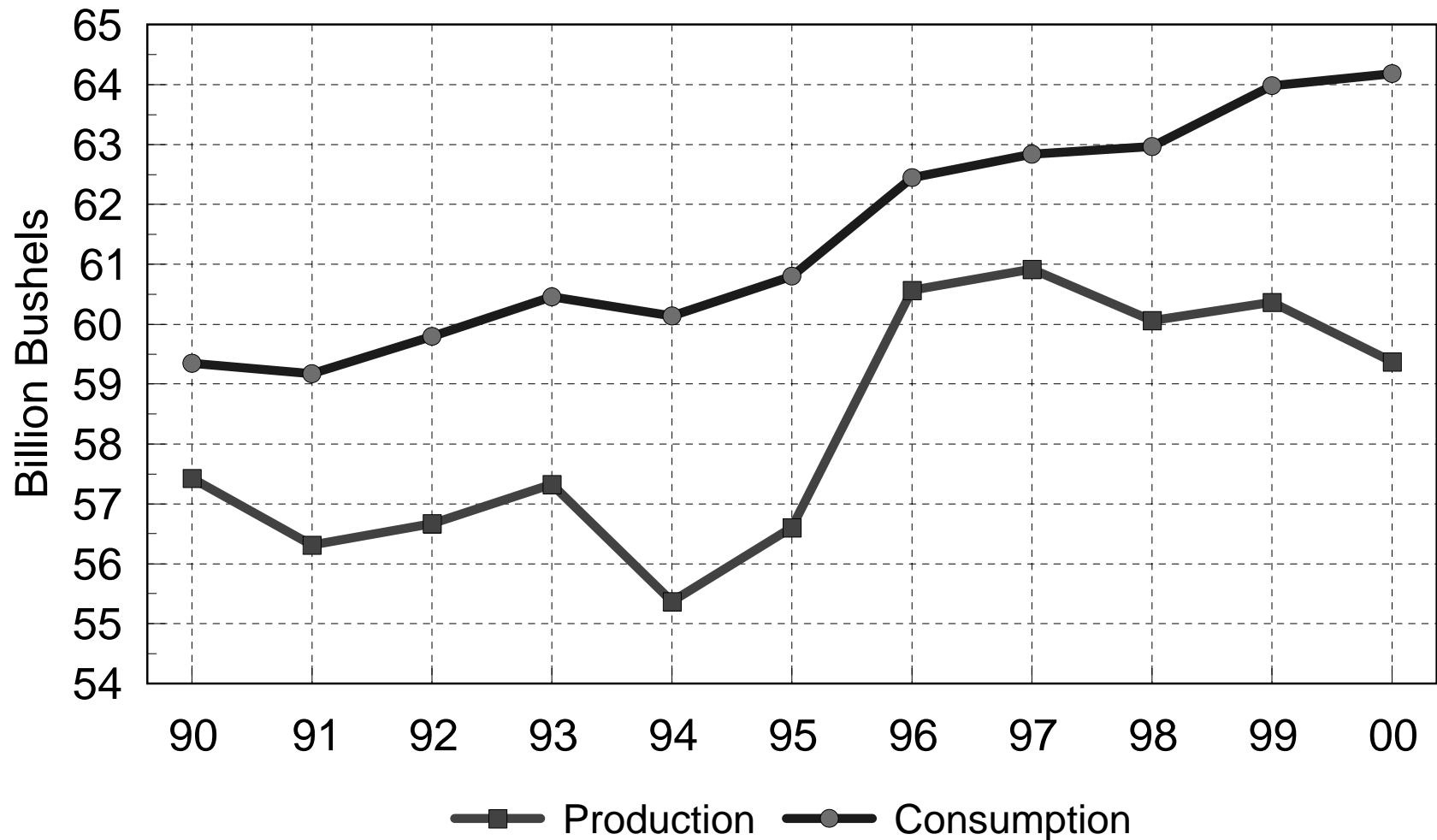

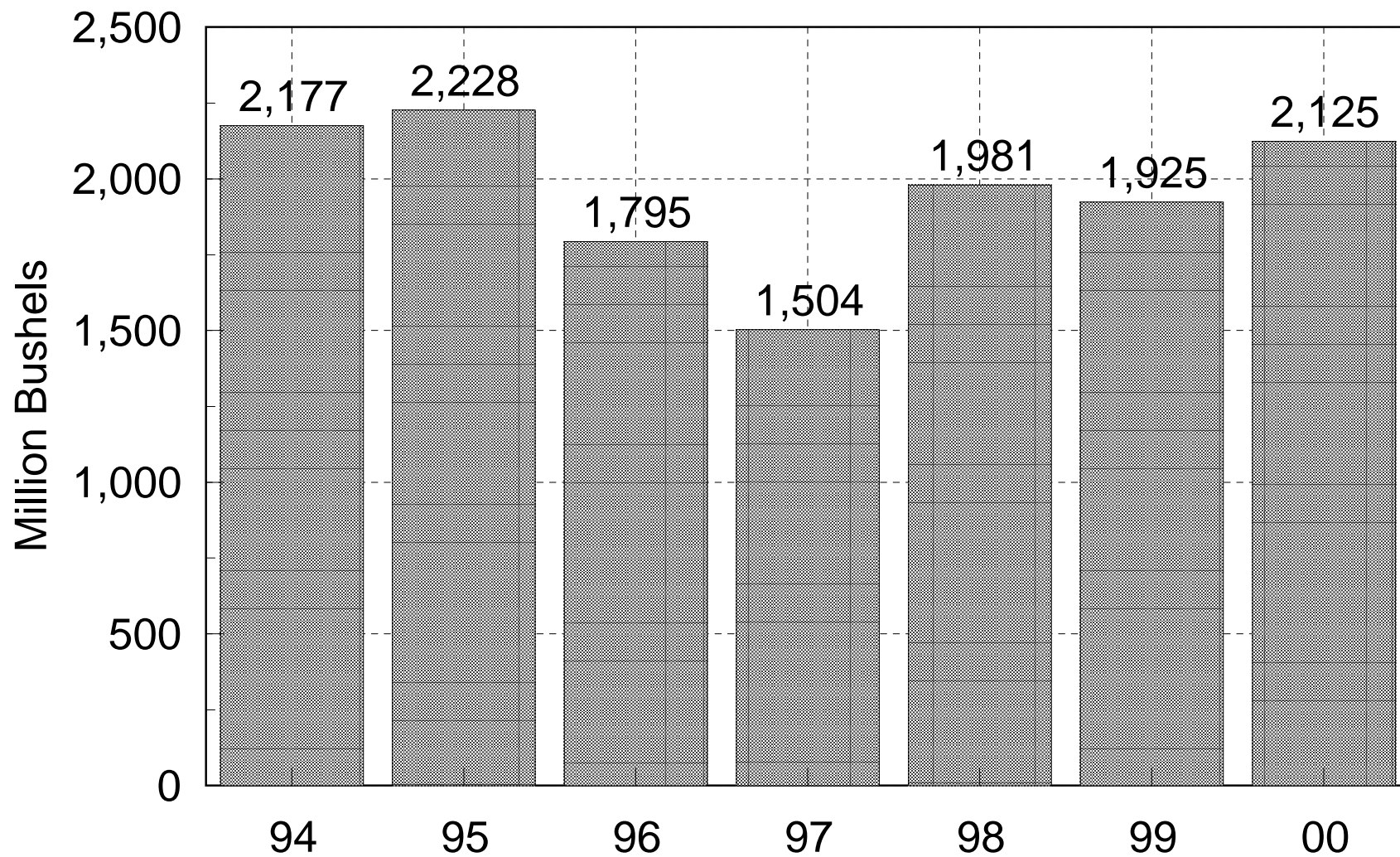
Foreign Grain Production & Consumption

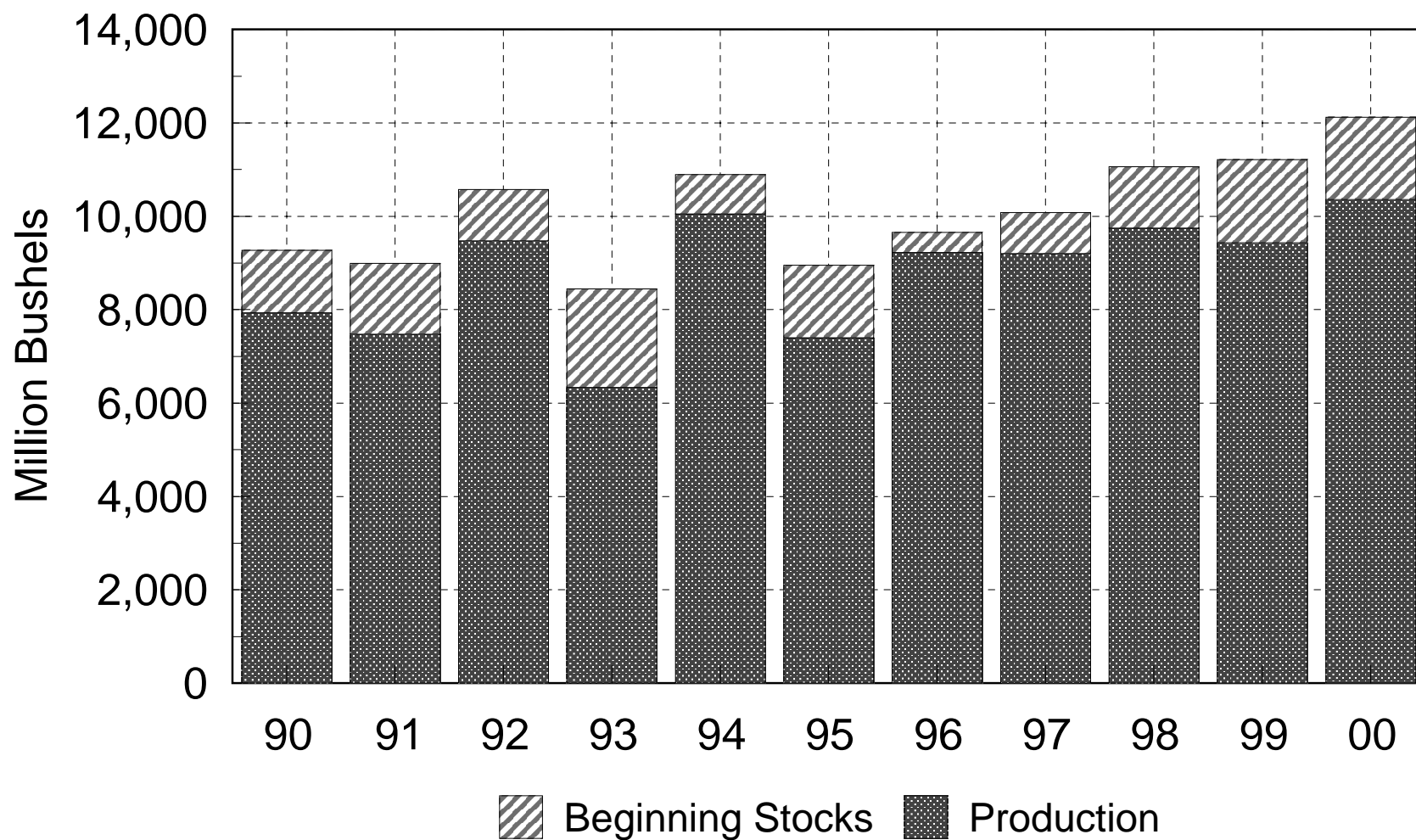
U.S. Corn Exports

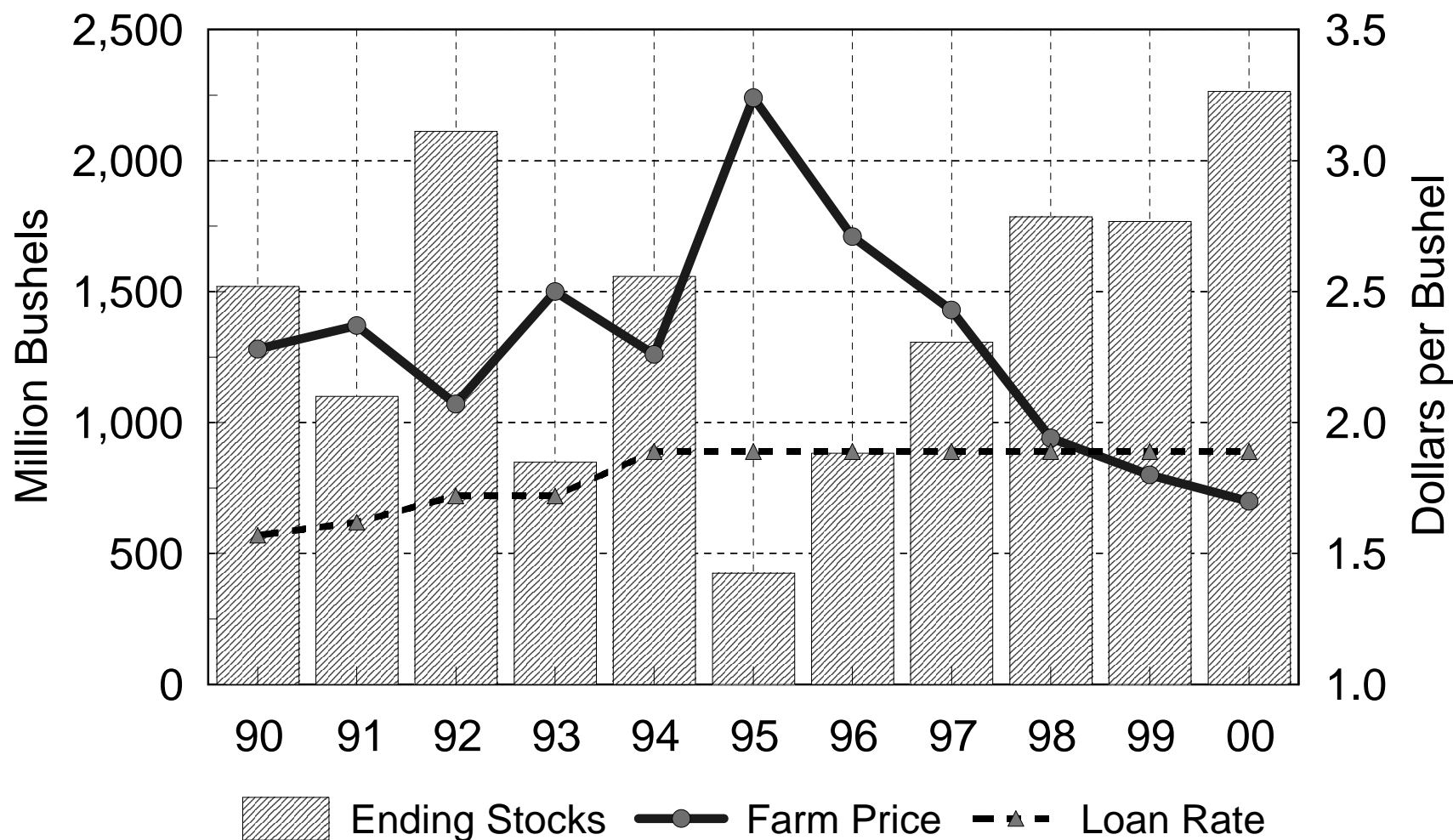
U.S. Corn Supply

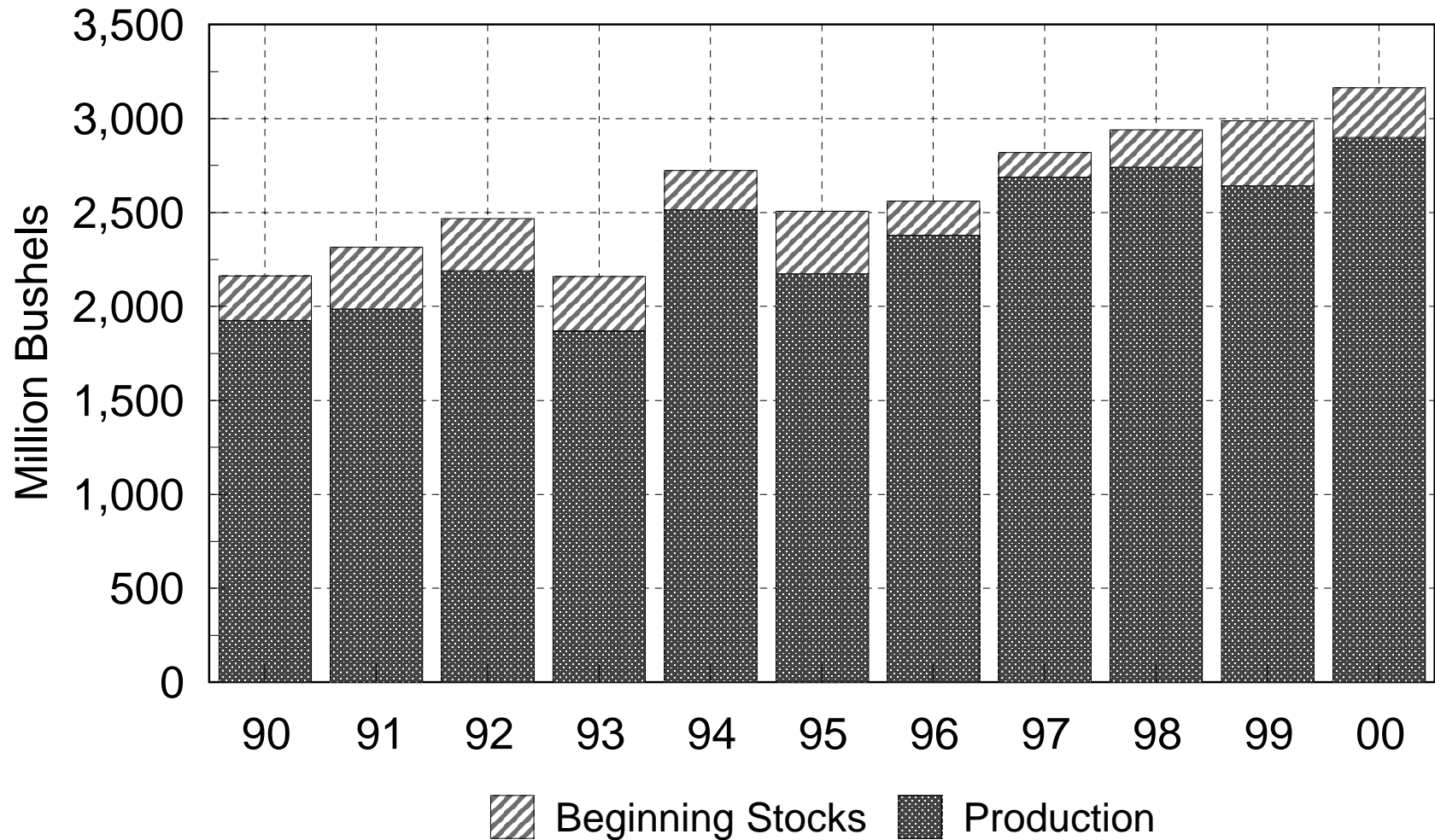
US Corn Stocks vs Farm Price

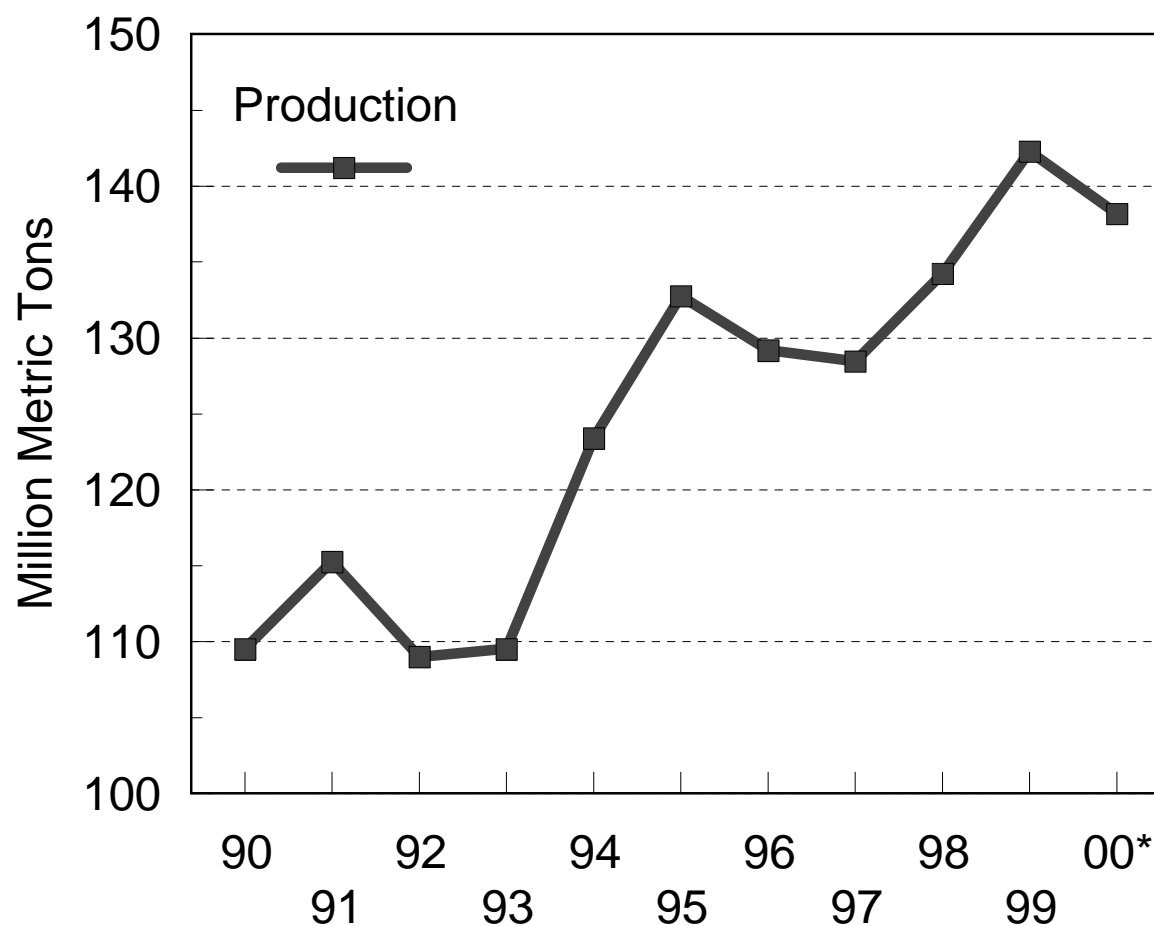


Prospects for Other Oilseeds

 - Rapeseed in Canada and EU
 - Sunflowerseed in Argentina
- Current estimates will lead to tighter stocks by the end of the 2000 marketing year.

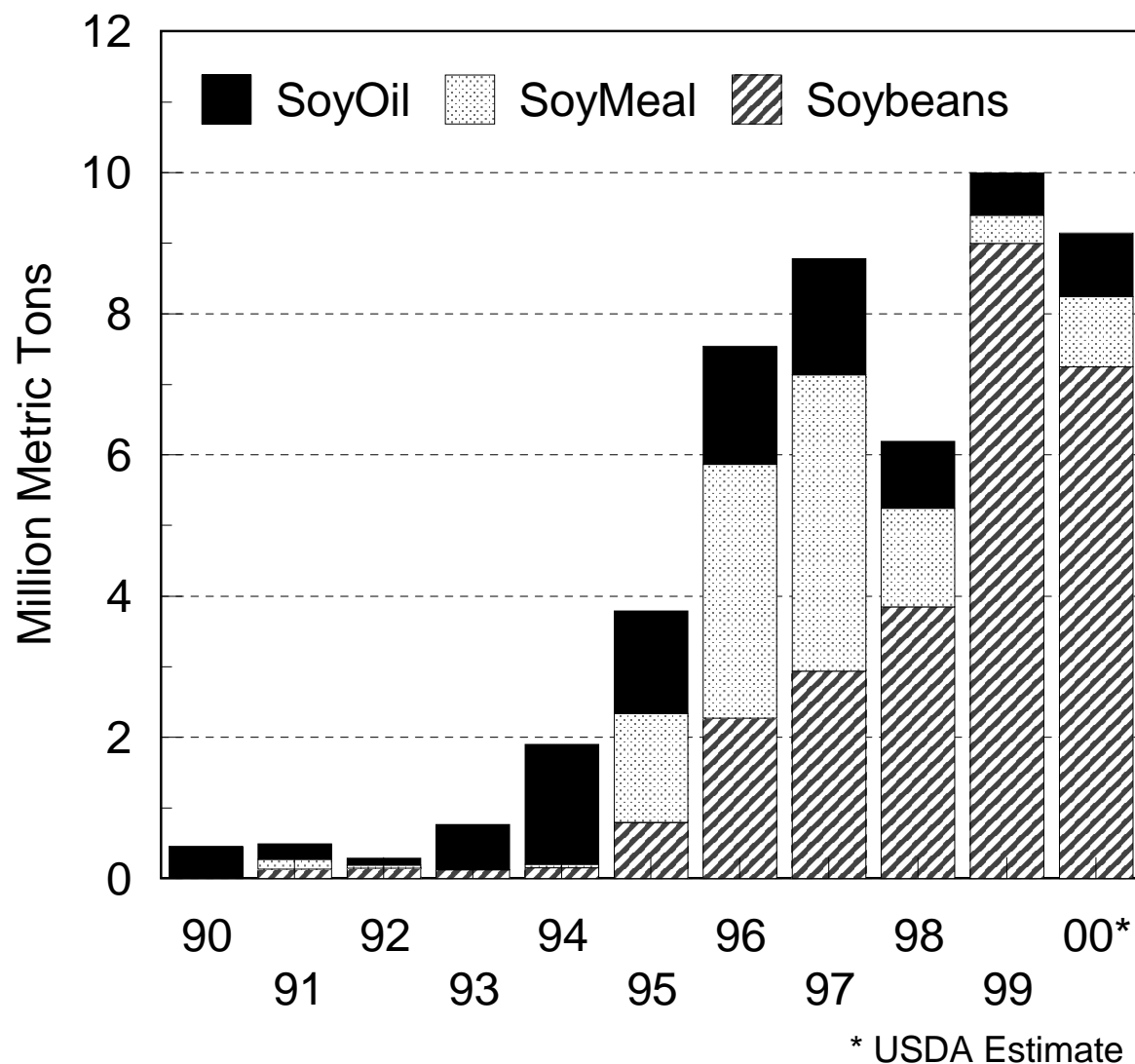
Global Oilseeds, Excluding Soybeans



Chinese Soy Imports

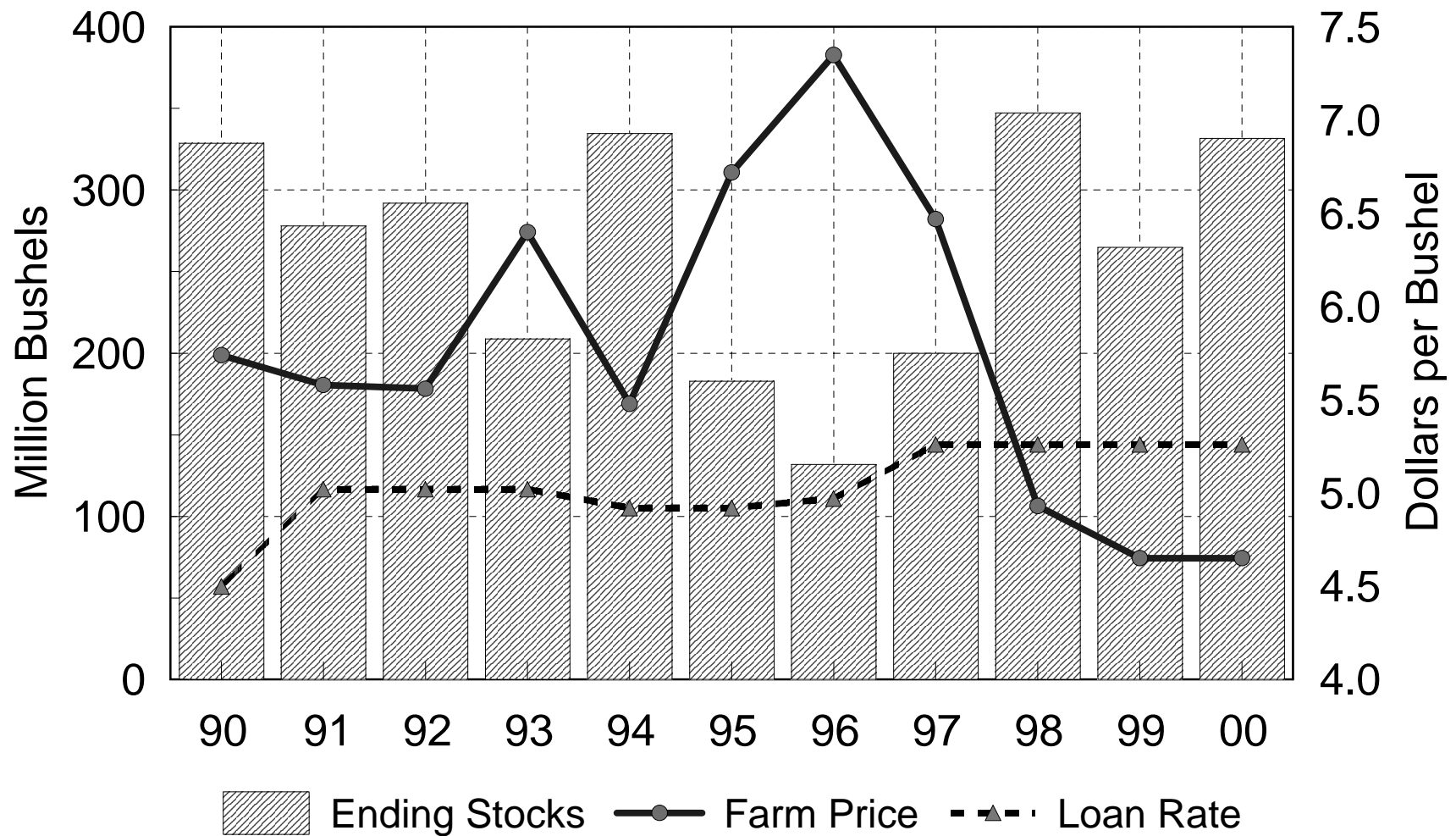

- In recent years, there's been a shift from products to the whole bean.



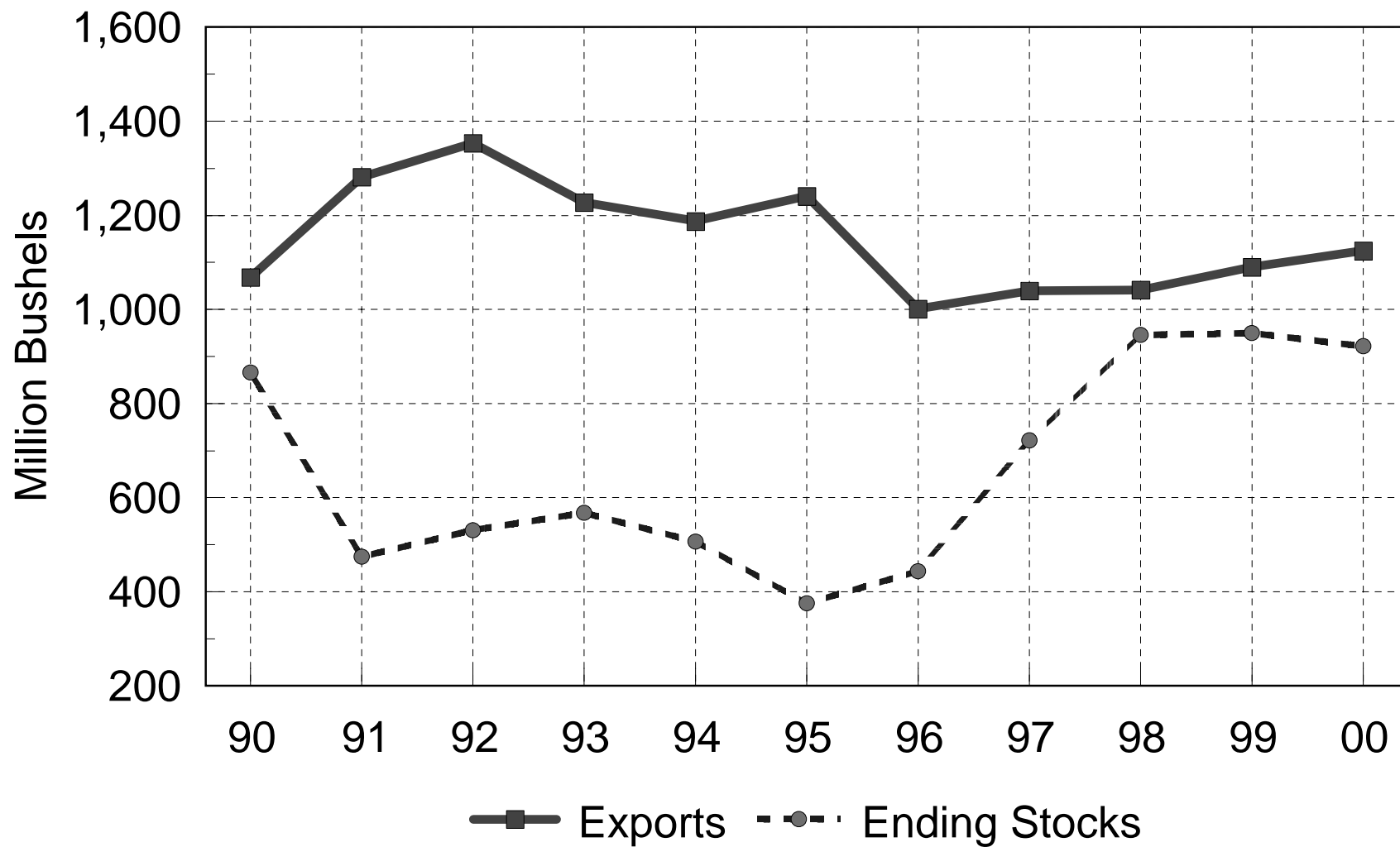
US Soybean Stocks vs Farm Price

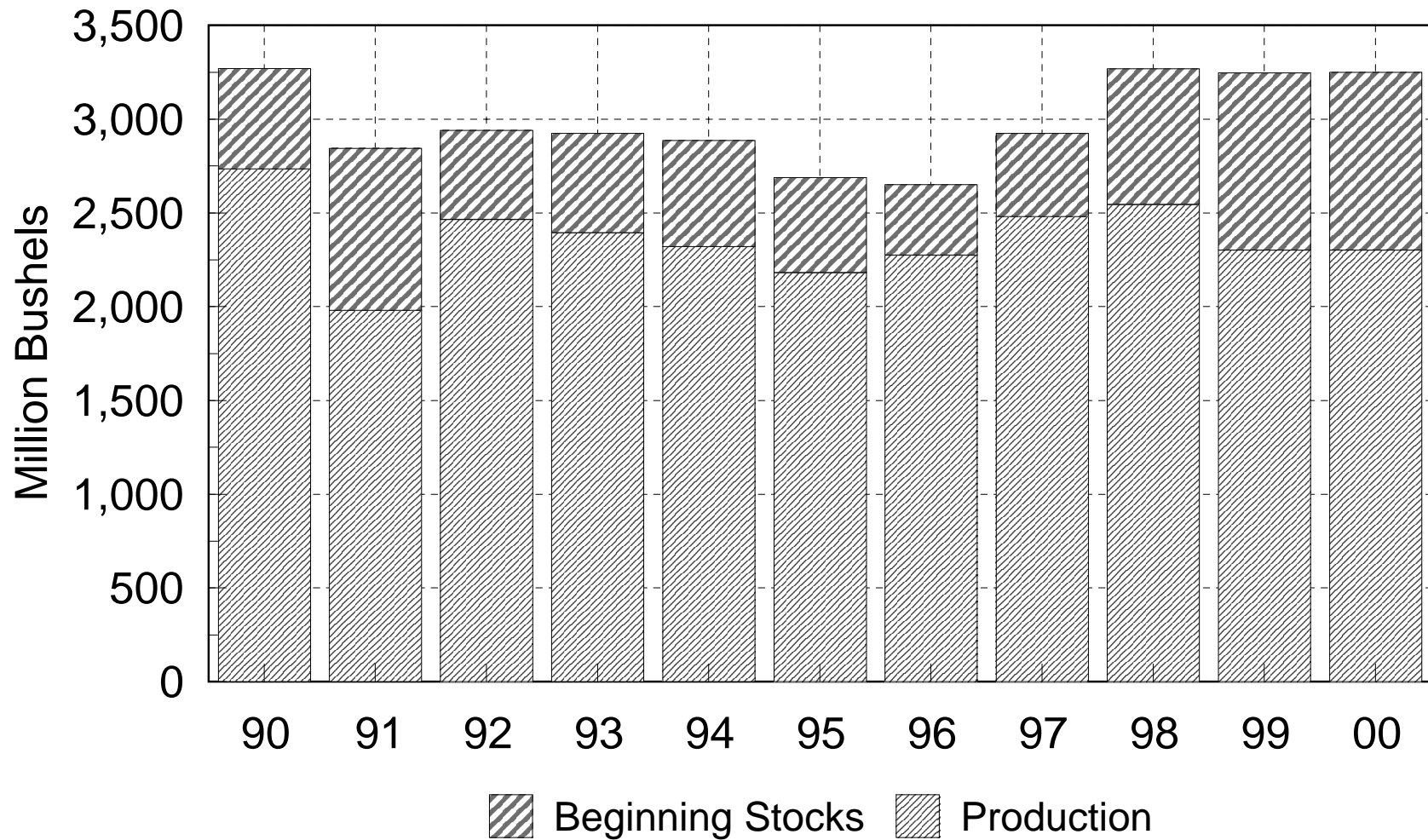
US Wheat Demand
