Archbishop Desmond Tutu Honored at UMKC

On September 24, 1990, Archbishop Desmond Tutu received an honorary doctorate from the University of Missouri-Kansas City. In his address to the convocation, Archbishop Tutu recognized the UM/UWC exchange program and its significance both to UWC and to UM.

UM President C. Peter Magrath, who also addressed the convocation, stated, "Today's convocation is a milestone in our relationship with UWC. We celebrate the unity of purpose that enables us to work together, and we honor the Chancellor of the University that chose to join us in the process of learning and transformation."

Dr. Eva Louise Frazer, President of the University of Missouri Board of Curators, conferred the degree and said, "One of the outcomes of this exchange has been a deep and abiding appreciation of the University's role in the anti-apartheid, non-racial democratic movement in South Africa, and of the University's Chancellor, Archbishop Desmond Tutu."

Archbishop Tutu, who serves as Chancellor of UWC, was the 100th participant in the UM/UWC exchange program.

UWC to Honor Nelson Mandela & Oliver Tambo

Later this year, Mr. Mandela and Mr. Tambo will receive honorary doctorates from UWC. An announcement of this event was made recently by UWC Rector Jakes Gerwel.
