Title:Diversionsary Diplomacy Domestic Political Effects on US-Directed Foreign Policy in Russia

Looking at the relationship between domestic Russian politics and foreign policy toward the United States, this paper seeks to determine whether states use more aggressive diplomacy to divert attention away from domestic troubles. The analysis shows that this effect exists, but only in the short term.
