In the past couple of newsletters, you have read about the Child Care Facility we are attempting to provide for University staff. Becky Bohlmeyer, Chair of the Staff Benefits Committee for SAC, has provided this information to pass on to you.......

We are now into the final stages of negotiations with La Petite for a Child Care Facility that will be located on the MU Campus east of Ronald McDonald House. We hope to have these finalized and ready to present at the March meeting of the Board of Curators.

The advantages of having a Child Care facility on Campus are numerous. It will be close to everyone's work place, which should be especially advantageous to nursing mothers. The extended hours, 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m., should help those employees who work shifts other than 8 to 5. Being located on Campus also gives parents the opportunity to drop in during the day, especially at lunch time, to check out the programs that La Petite provides and see how their child is doing in that environment. Wouldn't you also love to be able to have lunch with your children more often? La Petite has an "open door" policy, so you would be welcome to visit the facility at any time.

A couple of other "pluses" we are hoping to work out are a sick care facility in conjunction with the University Hospital, and an educational affiliation with the College of Environmental Sciences.

I know a lot of you are asking, is this going to save me money and, if I don't use the facility, am I still going to be paying for it? The rates are comparable to other facilities in Columbia, with rates for infants and toddlers running a bit less. If you have more than one child attending this facility, there is a 10% discount for the 2nd child and 50% for each remaining child. You will also have two weeks per year that your child may be absent without charge. If you DON'T send your children to this facility, there will be NO cost to you.

As a member of the Staff Benefits Committee, I have been involved in the selection process and I am very excited about having La Petite build and run this facility as a part of the University of Missouri. I have no children of my own, but I was so impressed with La Petite's facility in Kansas City, and their management, that I know I would love for a child of mine to be in such a facility.


