

## **Dental CE Seminar Scheduled for April**

The University of Missouri College of Veterinary Medicine and Pfizer Animal Health will offer the 2014 MU Zoetis Dental Continuing Education Weekend April 26-27 at the CVM. Lectures will be held at the Adams Conference Center and the Auditorium. Wet labs will be in the Anatomy Lab (W169) in the Veterinary Medicine Building.

Board-certified veterinary dentist and oral surgeon, Bill Gengler, DVM, will lead the weekend of dental education. Dr. Gengler is a long-time private practice owner who started the respected Dental Program at the University of Wisconsin. He is known for practical and entertaining lectures as well as being a state-of-the-art oral surgeon and dentist.

There will also be a dedicated program for veterinary technicians. Susan Crowder, DVM, a board-certified veterinary dentist from the Kansas City area, will lead the program for veterinary technicians, assisted by MU CVM dental technician Kacey Lundy and her dental technicians. How-to guides for complete professional dental cleanings, easy and inexpensive instrument sharpening, positioning for diagnostic oral radiographs, performing oral nerve blocks and dental equipment and instrument care will be provided.

In addition to Gengler and Crowder, Richard Meadows, DVM, MU College of Veterinary Medicine Curator's Distinguished Teaching Professor and the director of the Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital's Community Practice Section, and Dr. Ken Lee, DVM, an MU alumnus whose practice is limited to veterinary dentistry, will also be presenting. There will be three Community Practice DVMs present to help, Drs. Jackie Kleypas, Carrie Duran and Alisa Hutchison.

Practical information and skills for both DVMs and veterinary technicians will be the priority. There will be detailed how-to guides for taking and interpreting oral radiographs, extracting teeth, raising flaps and common periodontal surgery procedures.

Lectures are available on an open basis. Attendance at the lectures is required for entry into the wet labs. The lab portions will be hands-on and practical with a good teacher-to-student ratio. Attendance at the Sunday (DVM only) wet lab will be limited to 36 veterinarians. In the bonus lab session Sunday afternoon, to the extent possible, lab attendees' requests to learn specific procedures will be accommodated.
