


#### Message to the Class of 1996













# What's Your Objective?

After completing a pre-medical undergraduate degree at the University of Santa Clara, Santa Clara, California, James Daly went on to medical school at Loyola University from 1951-1956. He spent an intern year at St. Mary's Hospital in Gary, Indiana, then completed his residency at the Wilford Hall USAF Hospital in 1962. Dr. Daly continued his education with a fellowship in gynecology at the University of Texas, MD Anderson Hospital and Tumor Institute from 1962-1963.

Dr. Daly served in the Air Force as a medical officer from 1956-1968. After his military service, Dr. Daly went to the University of Florida, Gainesville. He spent 1968-1977 as an Associate Professor, and in 1977 he was promoted to full Professor.

In 1982 Dr. Daly moved to Omaha, Nebraska to become Professor and Chairman of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Creighton University. He served there until 1988 when he was chosen by the University of Missouri to become the Chairman of our Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

While here, he has served on the Utilization and Review Committee from 1989 until retirement. He was on the Medical Ethics Committee from 1988 until retirement and he served on the HSC Strategic Planning Committee.

After practicing medicine for over 35 years, Dr. Daly deserves a wonderful retirement. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Professor Emeritus, William Griffin, is serving as interim chairman of the department until a permanent replacement can be found.

#### People in the News



President Bill Clinton prepared for a new political battle: the 1996 presidential election. Early in the election process, the 49-year old Democratic president faced nearly a dozen Republicans looking to be the nominee torun against the President who had not even announced he was a candidate. But President Clinton had other concerns—taxes and Medicare reform needed attention and, for the first time in many years, the Republican-ruled Congress.



Senator Bob Dole, a Republican from Kansas, wanted to be president to the United States. When school began in September, Dole, the Senate Majority Leader, was a leading conservative candidate. The run for the high office was nothing new for Dole. He ran for vice president once, in 1976, and for president in the primaries of 1980 and 1988. If he won this time, he would be 73-years-old when he entered office, older than any newly elected president.



Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin, the war hero turned political leader who fearlessly pursued peace with the Palestinians, was assassinated on November 4, 1995. He was 74 years old when he was gunned down after a political rally.



The much-traveled Pope John Paul II returned to the United States for his fourth papal trip. The 75-year old Pope at that time showed no signs of slowing down, but later suffered health setbacks. He repeatedly spoke of leading the Roman Catholic Church into Christianity's third millennium. He was elected Pope in 1978. As the Polish Pope, he is the first non-Italian to head the church in 455 years. As one of the most charismatic pastors in centuries, he has made over 67 trips outside Italy.



Bill Gates made computer headlines when he introduced Windows '95, the long-awaited upgrade to the Windows computer software program. It was billed as revolutionary and innovative, and the musical group the Rolling Stones were turned into software pitchmen. Gates, the 39year-old chairman of Microsoft Corporation, was also crowned the richest man in the United States, with a net worth of about \$14.8 billion.



Miss Oklahoma, Shawntel Smith, got an extra birthday present for her 24th birthday: she was crowned Miss America. But she had to share the attention. Swimsuits also took center stage as television viewers voted overwhelmingly to retain the swimsuit competition, keeping with 75 years of pageant history. Detractors of this part of the competition tried to have it eliminated.



Timothy McVeigh is a well-guarded prisoner. He and one other man, Terry Nichols, are charged with 11 counts in the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City. The explosion on April 19 killed 169 people and injured more than 500.




The murder trial of O.J. Simpson ended. Not guilty. It took the jury less than four hours to reach a verdict in the sensational trial that lasted eight months. The jury of 10 women and two men found that Simpson did not kill his former wife, Nicole Brown Simpson and her friend, Ronald Goldman in June, 1994. The trial twisted an turned through a maze of scientific evidence and dozens of expert witnesses. Judge Lance Ito presided over the trial in which Los Angeles Police Detective Mark Furhman's racial slurs and attitudes became one of the focal points of Simpson's defense. Simpson remains accused by the Goldman and Brown families.

Baltimore Orioles shortstop Cal Ripken marched into the record books when he broke Lou Gehrig's record and played in 2,121 consecutive baseball games. Gehrig had held the record since 1939. Ripken broke the record on September 6, 1995, and went on to finish the season having played in 2,153 consecutive games -- the last 70 of them without an error.



Dallas Cowboys' Emmitt Smith goes for a long gain as the Cowboys went on to beat the Pittsburgh Steelers 27-17 to win Super Bowl XXX. For the Cowboys it was the fifth Super Bowl title, matching a feat achieved by San Francisco last year. It was also the Cowboys' third championship in a four-year span.



Mickey Mantle was one of the greatest baseball players who ever lived. From the time he broke into the major league in 1951, six months shy of his 20th birthday, until he retired following the 1968 season at the age of 37, Mickey Mantle inspired generations of fans with his power and ability. He died of a fast-spreading liver cancer at the age of 63, two months after a liver transplant.


It was nearly three decades ago, after a series of race riots in Los Angeles, Newark and Detroit, that a commitment began to use race-based programs to improve the lives of blacks. It was called affirmative action. But in 1995-96 affirmative action plans began to get weaker. The Supreme Court issued decisions making it harder to justify giving minorities and women preferences in the awarding of federal contracts; and the Clinton Administration was re-evaluating federal affirmative action programs.



Hundreds of thousands of black men marched in Washington in a spirited rally for unity and brotherhood. The Million Man March was organized by Nation of Islam leader Louis Farrakhan. Participants were optimistic that one of the outcomes of the peaceful day of praying, singing, and speechmaking would be more understanding between blacks and whites.



The Atlantic region's hurricane season this year was so active that it has produced the most named storms since the National Hurricane Center started assigning names in 1953. Storms are named in alphabetical order, but names beginning with Q, U, X, Y, and Z are excluded because of their scarcity. This year, officials were preparing to reach the end of the list and begin naming storms after the Greek alphabet, starting with Alpha.
