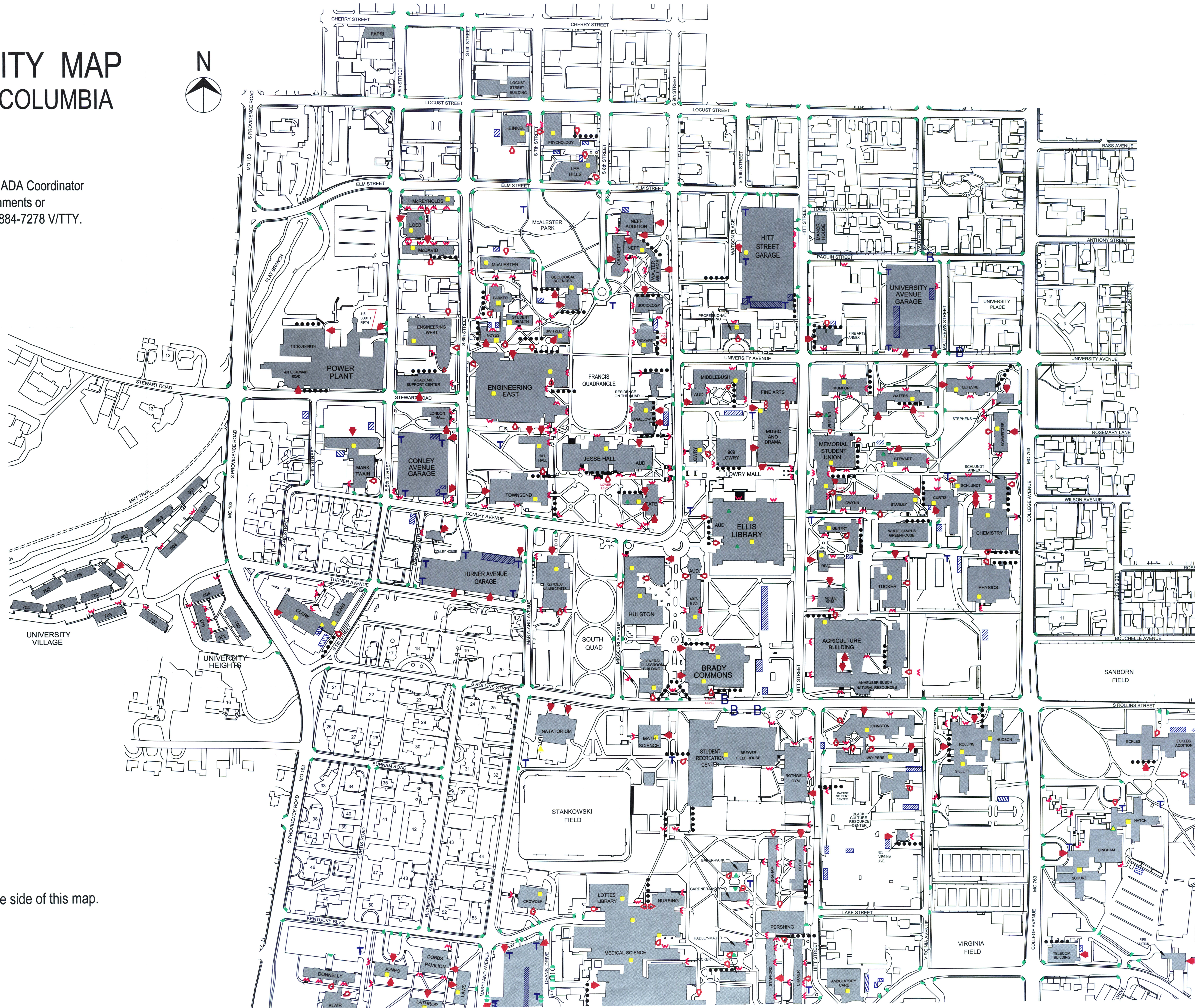

GENERAL BUILDING INFORMATION

Restrooms:

At least one set of restrooms in each academic and administrative facility is accessible (meets or exceeds ADA accessibility guidelines). Operations such as Residential Life, Athletics, Hospitals and the Unions all have accessible restrooms at designated facilities. The accessible restrooms are generally, but not always, on the entry level floor.

Assisted Listening Devices:

In auditoriums and classrooms with fixed seating for 50 or more, transmitters for assisted listening devices have been installed. Receivers, which may be checked out for a few days or for a semester, are available at the Office of Disability Services at A038 Brady Commons (882-4696).

Visual Fire Alarms:

Visual fire alarms have been installed in all restrooms and library book stacks. New fire alarm systems installed in campus facilities in the future will include both visual and audible fire alarms.

Wheelchair seating:

Areas for wheelchair seating are available in all accessible auditoriums and classrooms.











Signage:

All signage on campus complies with ADA accessibility guidelines. Signage that designates permanent rooms and spaces has both tactile (raised) and brailled characters.

TDD/TTY:

Text telephones are located at the following facilities: Brady Commons (Rooms A038 & A116), Ellis Library (Room 51), Hearnes Center (Rooms 258 & 344), Heinkel Building (Room 104), Memorial Union (Room N106) and the Reynolds Alumni Center (Room 208A).
