[MU LGBTQ Community and allies march in annual pride parade](#)

As part of the LGBTQ Resource Center's Pride Month activities, over 60 people marched in the Pride Parade last Wednesday. The parade went through MU's campus, including Francis Quadrangle, Speakers Circle and Tiger Plaza. Pride Month is celebrated nationally in June to commemorate the 1969 Stonewall Riots, but MU's LGBTQ Resource Center celebrates it with events in April because the school year ends in May.

[**LBC executive cabinet aims to serve and strengthen the Black community**](#)

The Legion of Black Collegians new executive cabinet's main objectives for the upcoming year is to re-establish LBC as a political organization and respond to the difficulties Black students have faced on campus. LBC is the only Black student government in the nation that receives university funding.

[**Staff open forum addresses budget restraints, job security**](#)

A panel of seven MU administrators answered questions and concerns from staff regarding job security, career paths and salaries. Due to recent budget cuts and a decline in enrollment, raises for staff are unlikely. A conversation took place about job protection for staff who speak out in support of student protesters.

[**Missourian: Prescription drug take-back tops collection record**](#)

A take-back event on April 26–27 collected almost 900 pounds of unwanted or no longer necessary medications. The event, which began in 2010, was sponsored by the Boone County Sheriff's Department. The Student Center contributed 12 pounds. The drugs will be taken to the DEA for disposal.

Let's dig a little deeper.

The Legion of Black Collegians was established at Mizzou by Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. in 1968. It has served as the voice for black students on campus through student government. LBC has five standing committees that help organize programs and activities.

In 1969, LBC wrote [a letter of demands](#) to the chancellor at the time, which included an increase in Black faculty, the implementation of a Black Studies program and the establishment of a Black culture center. In 1970, the Black Studies program was established at Mizzou.

In addition, there was strict confidentiality surrounding the board's search for a new president, which left the community unaware of the decision-making process and the narrowing search.

[Presidential search committee approves position profile](#)

A "position profile" document was approved by the UM System presidential search committee on Wednesday with search firm Isaacson Miller. It includes sections such as a history of the system, the list of qualifications wanted for the next president, and opportunities and challenges presented by the presidency.

[Missourian: Missouri House passes bill to allow guns at college campuses](#)

The bill allows full-time employees at colleges to be able to carry guns on campus with some exceptions, and allows people to carry concealed guns on buses and other forms of public transportation. It will head back to the Senate again for approval.

[Missourian: Missouri Ethics Commission reverses course, will investigate Schaefer](#)

The Missouri Ethics Committee will look into allegations against state Sen. Kurt Schaefer. The allegations say he misused his office to persuade UM System officials to prevent MU law professor Josh Hawley from seeking the Republican nomination for attorney general. This is a reversal of the decision the committee made last week.

Let's dig a little deeper.

The allegations against state Sen. Schaefer were made by the Foundation for Accountability and Civic Trust. The commission said last week it would not investigate whether Schaefer, R-Columbia, used his office for personal gain, but the foundation resubmitted its complaint Tuesday, saying the commission was required by law to investigate the allegations.
