Community members held a midday demonstration Thursday in response to the most recent police shootings of black men in Louisiana and Minnesota. "We have to deal with the fact that for decades white people have been brainwashed to believe that black people are dangerous," said Traci Wilson-Kleekamp of Race Matters, Friends, a local racial justice and social equity group.
