MU CVM Dean Announces Plan to Step Down

Neil C. Olson, DVM, PhD, dean of the University of Missouri College of Veterinary Medicine, has announced that he will step down from his current position and join St. George's University in St. George's, Grenada, as the dean of their School of Veterinary Medicine, effective Aug. 15, 2017.



Olson will oversee the St. George's School of Veterinary Medicine's academic units, centers, and initiatives, while providing leadership for the planning, development, implementation, assessment, and improvement of the school's programs, policies, and infrastructure. He will lead a contingent of more than 100 faculty and
