## *Keynote Speaker: David S. Ferriero*



David S. Ferriero was named the 10th Archivist of the United States by President Barack Obama in 2009. Previously, he served as the Andrew W. Mellon Director of the New York Public Library and as university librarian and vice provost for library affairs at Duke University. Prior to Duke, he worked in a variety of positions in the Massachusetts Institute of Technology libraries.

Ferriero earned both a bachelor's and a master's degree in English Literature from Northeastern University in Boston, Massachusetts. His education was interrupted by service in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam War. He served as a Navy hospital corpsman assigned to a Marine unit in Danang, and on a hospital ship in Vietnamese waters. Following his military service, he earned an additional master's degree in Library and Information Science from Simmons College. He is the first professional librarian to serve as Archivist of the United States.

In overseeing the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA), Ferriero has committed the agency to three principles of open government — transparency, participation and collaboration. As a result, NARA has embraced social media and encouraged public participation both in identifying historical federal records and in sharing knowledge about them. Since 2011, the mobile application, “Today’s Document,” has provided a daily glimpse into the vast array of documents and photographs that reside in the National Archives. More than 1.3 billion hits have also been recorded on the over 4,000 Wikipedia articles currently sharing NARA content. When asked why NARA works so closely with the internet and social media, Ferriero has a simple answer: “Because that’s where the people are.”
