








### In Memory of Dr. Matthias J. Hourigan

Dr. Matthias J. Hourigan, 59, Lake Quivira, an associate professor in the University of Missouri-Kansas School of Dentistry, died April 14, 1992, in Merriam.

Dr. Hourigan had taught oral surgery at the dental school for nine years. Earlier he taught oral surgery at the University of Southern Illinois. He lectured nationally on dentistry. He retired from the Army as a colonel in 1981, was a veteran of the Vietnam War, and received the Bronze Star with an oak leaf cluster.


He was a 1958 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh School of Dentistry and received an advanced degree in oral surgery at the University of Pennsylvania.


The superior and inferior jaws with complete artificial dentures.



Teeth are made from bones of the Ox, Mother of Pearl, Hippopotamus teeth, or human teeth obtained from prisons or insane asylums. The bases are best carved from seahorse teeth or made from gold plate. The best combination is the new incorruptable porcelain tooth attached to plate gold bases.

Note—Teeth procured from cemeteries are of inferior quality as their enamel is dull and yellow from decomposition they crack and break easily.

# Odds and Ends



16th century BC Ebers-Papyri, ancient Egyptian medical writings contain prescriptions for toothaches.

1st century AD Jingles satirizing people who wear false teeth and try to pass them off as their own, by the Roman Poet Martial.

#### 1st century AD

Cascellius of Rome grows rich in serving fine ladies by curing tooth disease. First known dentist.

#### MORRISON CHAIR

First came on the market in 1870-model illustrated was crankoperated and patented in 1887.

The first hydraulic chair was the Wilkerson chair of 1877 that could be had in green or garnet plush or leather for \$180.00 or for \$15.00 more in Turkish style which meant puffed silk velvet trimmed with silk cord, and with an extra carpet thrown in.

16th century AD Eustacius and Fallopius give detailed descriptions of teeth and their development. 1836 Arsenic introduced for the killing of pulp. 1851 Patent for hard rubber (Vulcanite) granted to Nelson Goodyear.



1855 Dr. Tindall opens first dental office in Kansas City.

- 1941 Kansas City-Western Dental College merged with University of Kansas City as School of Dentistry, University of Kansas City.
- 1963 University of Kansas City became University of Missouri-Kansas City.
- 1970 University of Missouri at Kansas City School of Dentistry building completed.
