# SCHEDULE OF COURSES

## SECOND SEMESTER, 1936-37

1. **Credit.** In general the number of hours for each course is given in parentheses following the name of the course, thus (3). In case the credit is variable, to be fixed in consultation with the teacher, that fact is indicated by a dagger (†) following the course.

2. **Fees.** The amount of the Library, Hospital and Incidental Fee is variable, depending on the division in which the student enrolls and the number of hours for which he registers. The fee is \$3.50 per credit hour, except for courses in the School of Law, where the fee is \$4.00 per credit hour, and in the School of Medicine. The fee in all departments of the School of Medicine is \$4.25 per credit hour.

There are no laboratory fees.

**Note:** For students enrolled in the School of Nursing there is no fee for courses in the Department of Nursing. Such students will pay the regular charge for courses in other departments.
