

EBASE ECONOMIC BASE

OBJECTIVE

This program estimates the economic base of a non metropolitan area from income and/or employment data. Once the economic base has been estimated, the impact of employment or income changes on various sectors of the local economy is projected.

CREDITS

This program was developed at the University of Missouri by John Kuehn, Bill Elder and Mimi Hess. It is based on research reported in "Economic Base Multipliers and Community Growth" by John Kuehn, Curtis Braschler and John Croll.

REQUIRED INPUT DATA

Employment and Income data for various industry classification are required. This data is compiled by the Bureau of Economic Analysis of the U.S. Dept. of Commerce and is available for Missouri counties thorough the Missouri Cooperative Extension Service, Office of Social and Economic Data Analysis, 809 Clark Hall, Columbia, Mo. 65201. 314-882-7396.

RUNNING THE PROGRAM

You will be given an opportunity to read the program instructions and then if you proceed you will be asked to identify the county you wish to analyze. You will need to indicate whether the county has a town with a population of 2500 persons. This factor adjusts the multiplier values. Next, you will be presented with a menu to determine whether you wish to run employment or income estimates and depending on your response, you will be prompted for the input data described on the attached form. Once you have entered the employment or income data the totals will be checked, any discrepancy noted and changes in the values made as you indicate.


When the totals are correct, the economic base table will be printed and you will be asked if you wish to analyze the impact of changes in the base.

If you do, you will be asked to identify the industry sector and the amount of change in employment or income. A low, average & high estimate of the impact will then be printed for elements of the local economy. The main program menu will then reappear so that you may select another option.

ERROR ANALYSIS

Various error messages are possible. Each message describes what has happened and what to do next. Most often the program will ask you to reenter a value. If the same error runs repeatedly, the program will end automatically.

There is a special error routine associated with the input of employment and income data. The program will not proceed until the items total exactly. When there is a difference the program will continue to note the discrepancy for you, offer options to resolve it; and act on your selection until the total is correct.
