Get involved in your community through the Teen Teacher Program, offered now by the University of Missouri Extension Youth Programs.

This program is designed specifically for those of you who are 16 to 19 years old and who are interested in sharing your lives and talents with others. In doing so, you will develop your own leadership skills. (Teenagers under 16 may enroll, but your requirements will be slightly different. You may check these with your Area Youth Specialist.)

vey on the back of this folder and return it to the University of Missouri Extension Center in your county. Most Extension Centers are located at the county seat.

Teen Teacher is a part of the Teen Leadership Program. It is especially beneficial for those of you planning a career in the group leadership field. This program can help you in many ways. You'll be able to communicate more effectively and also understand better some of the problems and concerns facing people with careers in group leadership.

Teen Teachers make things happen!

Teen Teachers help groups of younger boys and girls with special interest activities and projects. As a Teen Teacher serving in this way you would:

—Pick a subject you enjoy teaching. To start you thinking, pick up some of the literature that is available on many different subjects at your local University of Missouri Extension Center.

—Recruit and organize a group of youngsters. It's up to you to pick the place to meet and set the times.

—Develop and guide learning experiences for your group to assist the youngsters in planning and working out their projects.

—Offer your help in some way at school or

church. For instance, you might tutor one or more youngsters in a school subject.

When you have finished your teaching, you will receive a framable Teen Teacher certificate. Your school will also receive a certificate for your school cumulative records.

The subjects you can teach are as varied as your interests—it all depends on you! You can even develop your own subject if you want to. In this case, just get the approval of your Area Youth Specialist.

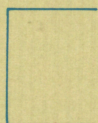
