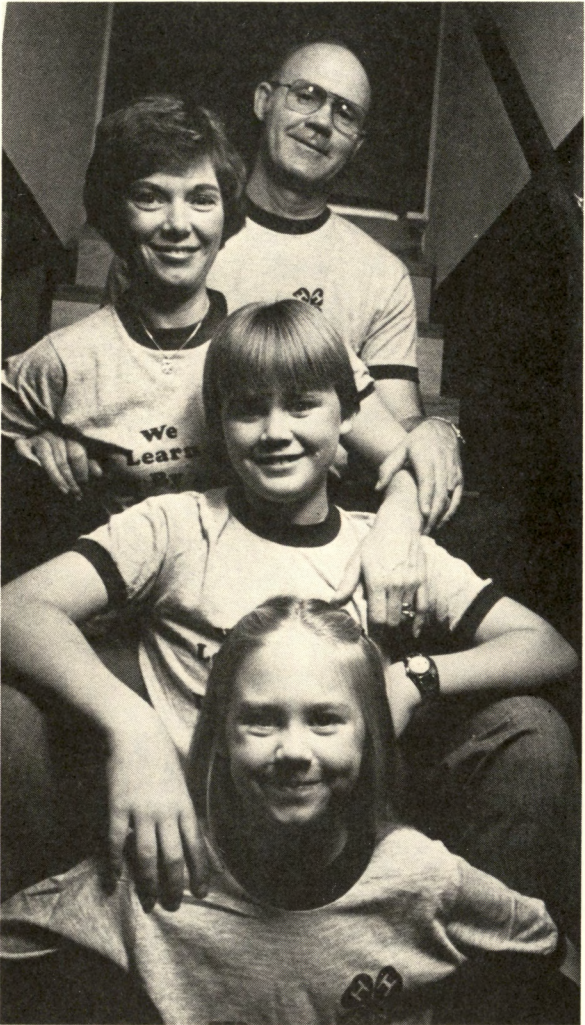

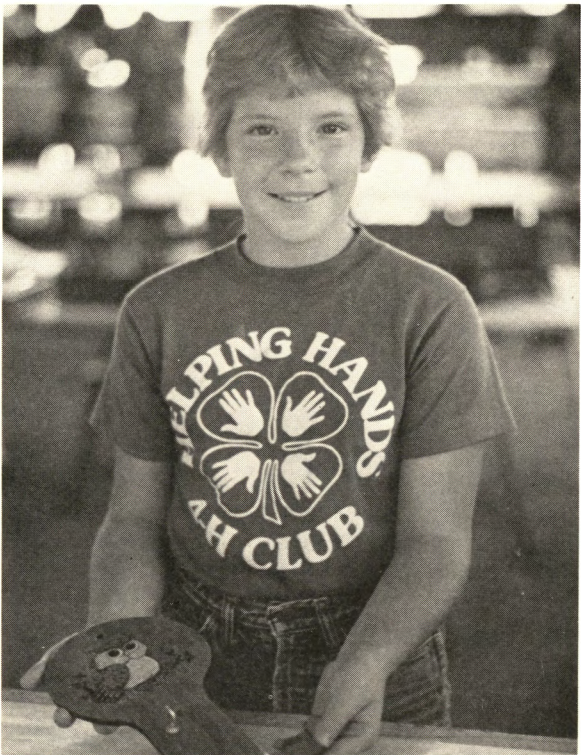

4-Hers Also Have An Opportunity To Learn From...

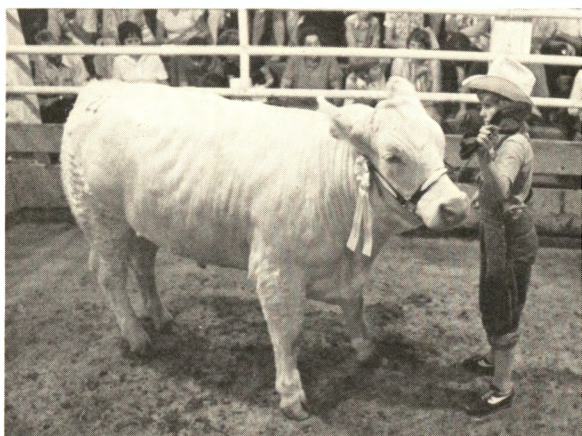

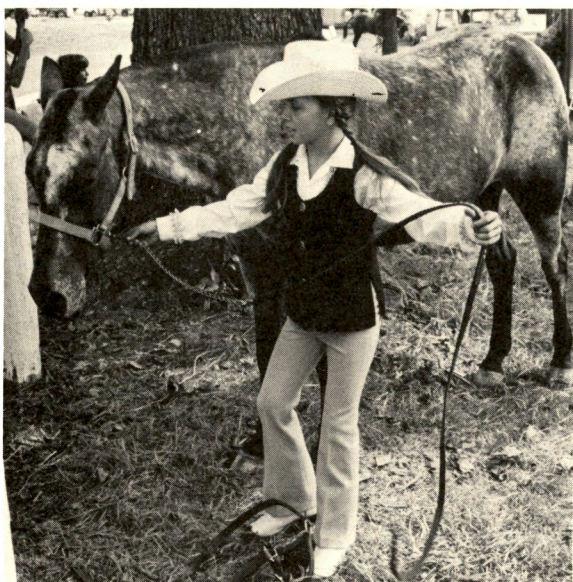

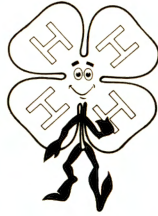
