Evan Bush is executive editor of <u>Project 573</u>, a student-run multimedia website that tells stories of how the Great Recession is disrupting life in mid-Missouri and how people are adapting. Story formats include audio, text, video, still photographs and infographics. A dozen students came together from the J-School's broadcast, convergence, magazine, photojournalism, print and digital news, and strategic communication areas to work together on in-depth stories. "Being able to collaborate with other students has been extremely valuable because they have knowledge that they've gained from their professors and their interest areas," Bush says.
