MU Leaders Address Independent Council's Findings

Loftin and Wolfe speak about Sasha Menu Courey.

University of Missouri System President Tim Wolfe and University of Missouri Chancellor R. Bowen Loftin issued separate statements today following the release of the Dowd Bennett law firm's findings from its investigation into the experiences of former MU student-athlete Sasha Menu Courey while attending the university.

The independent counsel report stated: "While we do not conclude that the University 'violated the law,' we do conclude with certainty that the University ... acted inconsistently with the Department of Education's guidance about the requirements of Title IX and did not act in accordance with what would be expected of

a university with a robust Title IX compliance program.”
