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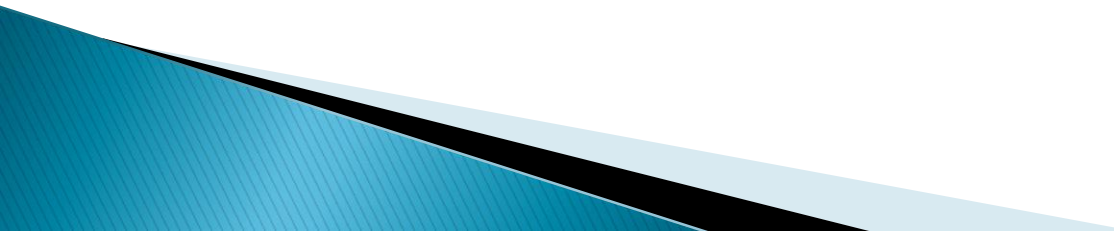

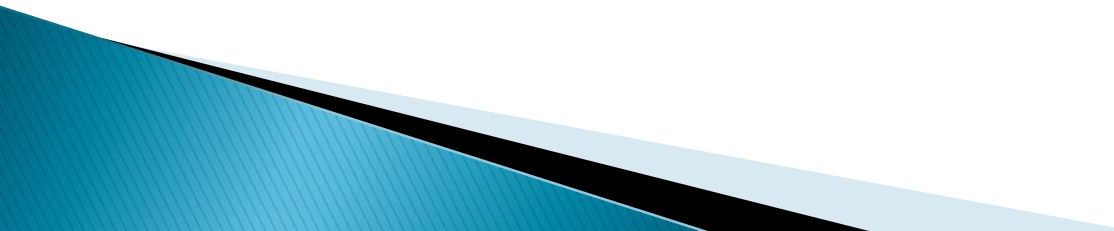

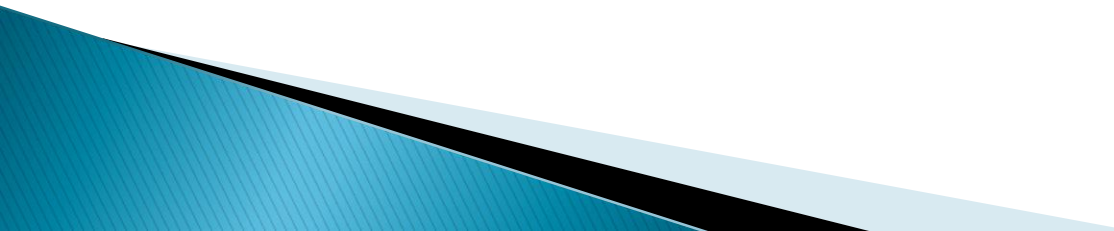

American Community Survey

- ▶ Conducted by the Census Bureau.
 - ▶ 250,000 households sampled every month of every year.
 - ▶ Collects the data that formerly came from the decennial census long form.
 - ▶ No long form in 2010 census.
 - ▶ Trade-off between timeliness and statistical reliability for small areas/universes.

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General Information

The American Community Survey is the ambitious new national survey from the U.S. Census Bureau that is **replacing the long form portion of the decennial census** for the new millenium. While some version of this survey has been in the field since 1999, it was not fully implemented in terms of coverage until 2006. In 2005 it was expanded to cover all counties in the country and the 1-in-40 households sampling rate was first applied. However, persons living in group quarters (such as nursing homes, dormitories and prisons) were not added to the survey until 2006. (The original plan was to begin GQ coverage in 2005 but last-minute budget reductions delayed it for a year.) The full implementation of the (household) sampling strategy for ACS entails having the survey mailed to about 250,000 households nationwide every month of every year and was begun in January 2005. In January 2006 sampling of group quarters was added to complete the sample as planned (albeit several years later than originally planned.) In any given year about 2.5% (1 in 40) of U.S. households will receive the survey. Over any 5-year period about 1 in 8 households should receive the survey (as compared to about 1 in 6 that received the census long form in the 2000 census). Unfortunately, receiving the survey is not equivalent to participating in it, since the Bureau has adopted a strategy of sampling for non-response. This has resulted in something closer to 1 in 11 households actually participating in the survey over any 5-year period.

Data Release Plan Based on Size of Geographic Area

Data based on the ACS surveys for any calendar year will be published in the late summer of the following year for **geographic areas with a minimum of 65,000 population**. For smaller areas the Bureau will only publish data based on surveys for multiple consecutive years as follows:

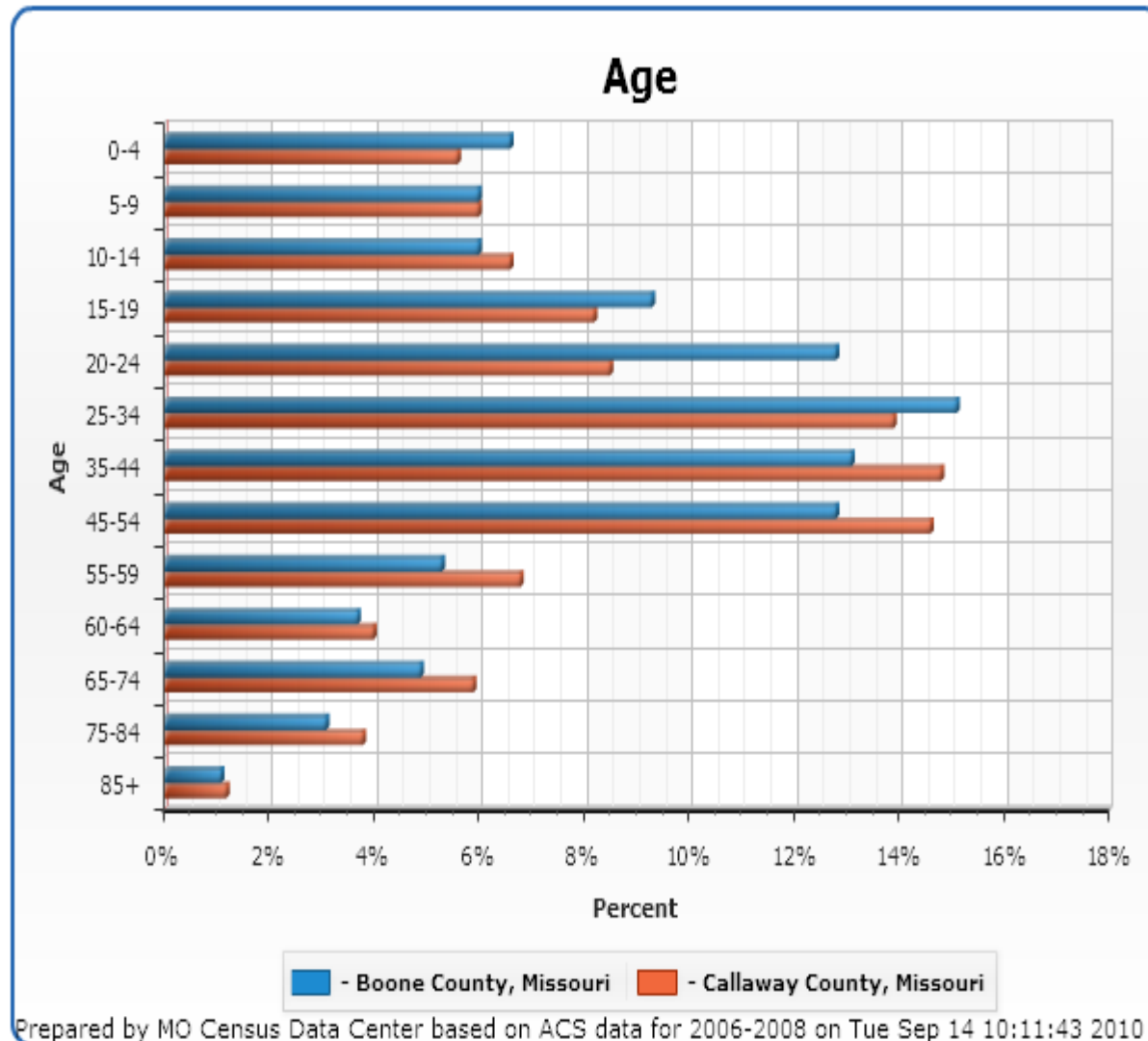

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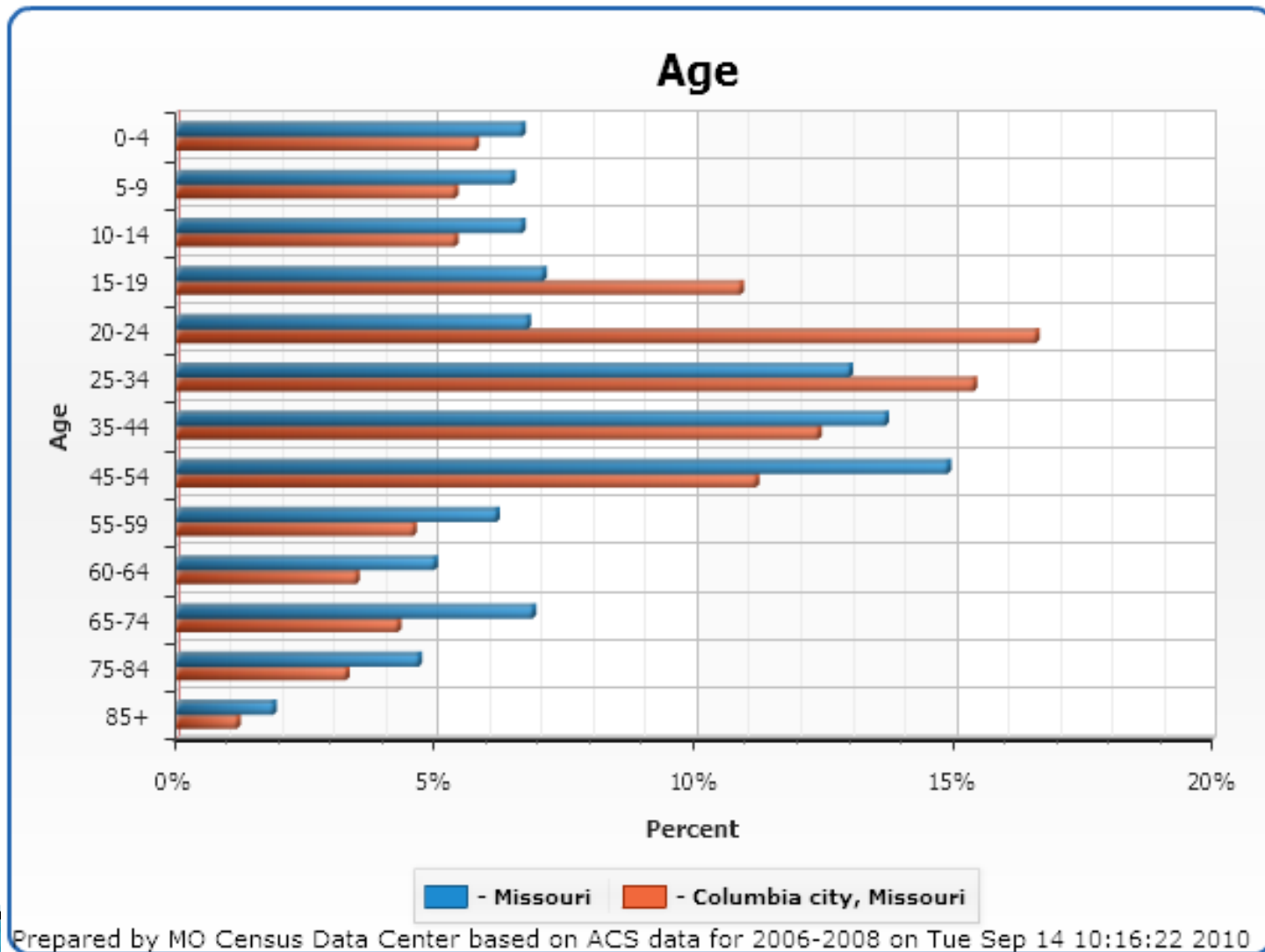

Age Distribution: Boone vs. Callaway



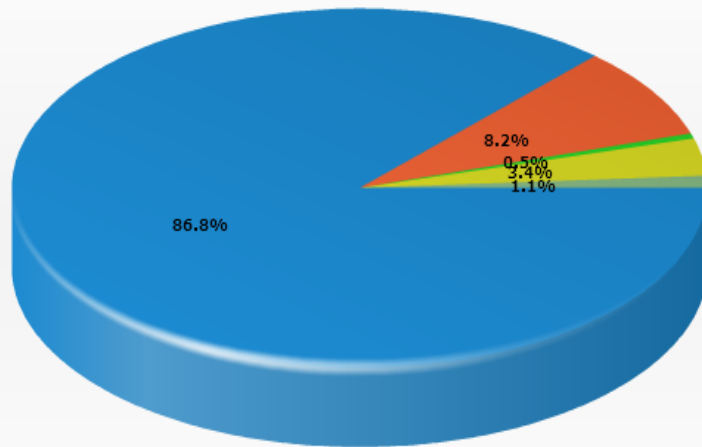
Age Distribution: Columbia and MO

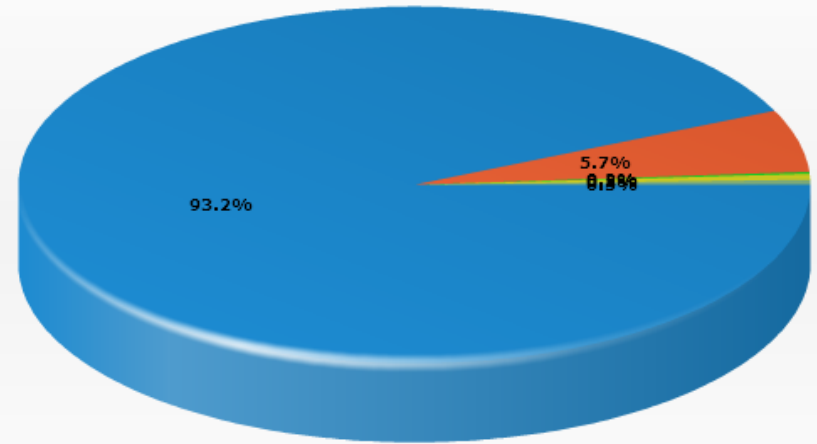

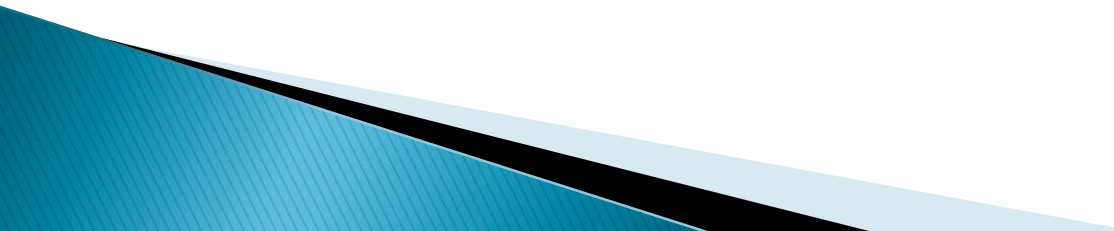

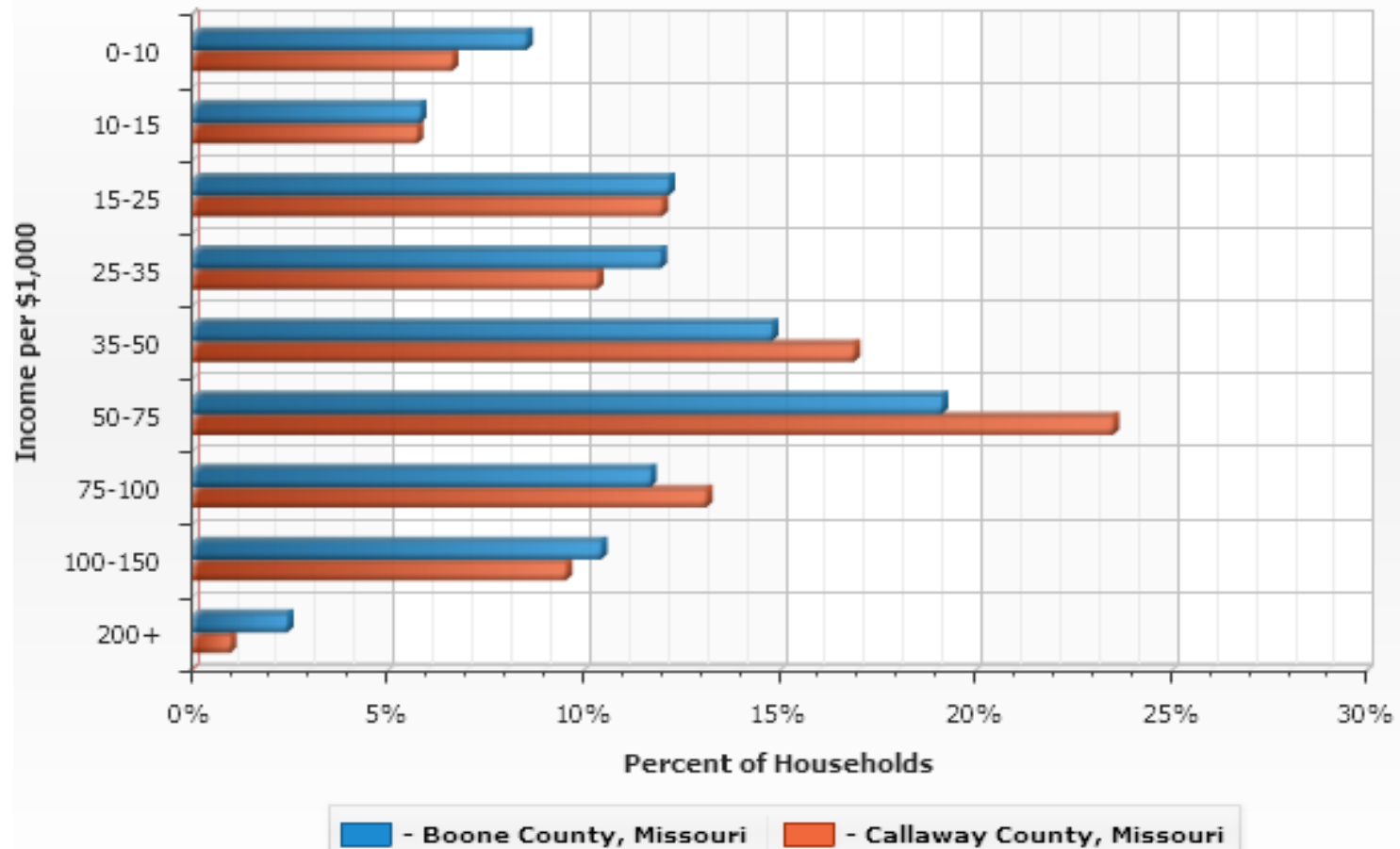

Hispanic Population

- ▶ *“Hispanic is not considered to be a race by the Census Bureau/OMB, but rather a separate ethnic category”*
 - ▶ In 2009 Boone county had an estimated 4,157 Hispanic persons, or 2.7%
 - ▶ Callaway county had an estimated 672 Hispanic persons, or 1.5%

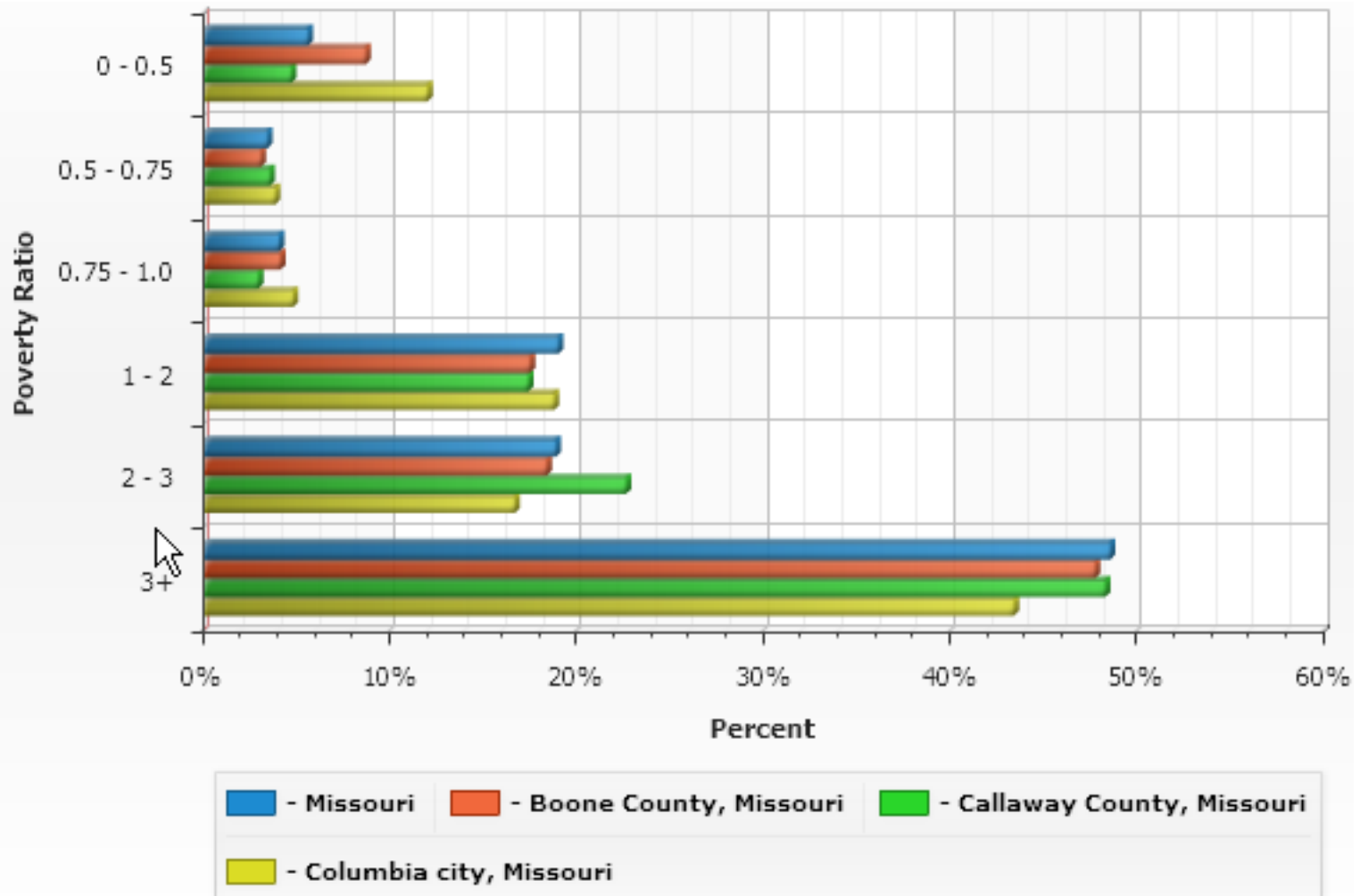
HH Income Highlights

- ▶ Mean retirement income is highest in Columbia (\$27,426) and Boone (\$24,687) and lowest in Callaway (\$16,720).
 - ▶ 19.4% of Callaway HHs receive retirement income vs only 12.5% in Columbia.
 - ▶ **Median** HH income in Callaway is highest of the 4 areas, and Columbia is the lowest. Why?
 - ▶ **Mean** HH income is highest in Boone followed by Columbia and Callaway. (doctors?)

Mean Poverty Ratios

- ▶ One's *poverty ratio* is a good measure of economic well-being.
- ▶ By averaging those ratios for a geographic area you get a good overall measure of well-being.
- ▶ Boone, Callaway and Missouri all have the same *Mean Poverty Ratio* value of 3.2, while Columbia has a value of 3.0
- ▶ Unfortunately, the way poverty is defined makes college towns like Columbia appear to have more “true” poverty than they do.

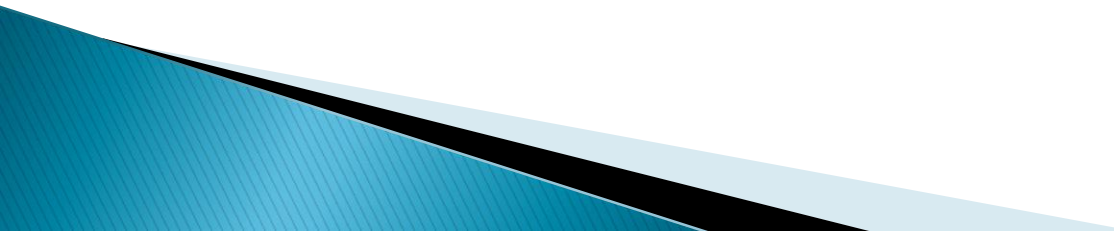
Poverty Ratios for the 4 Areas



Poverty Rates (See Profiles Table E4)

- ▶ Columbia has an overall poverty rate of **20.9%** compared to **11.5%** for Callaway.
- ▶ For persons aged 18–64 the poverty rates for these 2 areas are **23.5** and **11.5**, resp.
- ▶ Columbia has a slightly lower poverty rate than Callaway for seniors (**5.0** vs. **5.7%**).
- ▶ The poverty rate for “unrelated individuals” is **34.8%** (!) in Columbia and **15.4%** in Callaway.
- ▶ In Columbia it’s all about the students.

Unemployment Data

- ▶ These days the 3-year ACS period estimates of unemployment have to be considered out of date.
 - ▶ Fortunately, we have more recent and more reliable figures from the BLS.
 - ▶ As of May, 2010 the unemployment rates for Boone and Callaway were 5.6% and 7.2%, respectively. The Missouri state rate was 8.7% .
 - ▶ The corresponding rates from the ACS (2006–2008) were 5.1, 4.8 and 6.3.

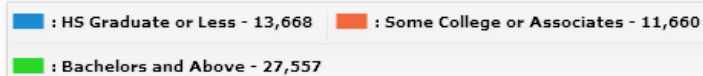

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Population Estimates for Missouri and the U.S.

NOTE: All estimates from the Census Bureau for this year (2010, with vintage 2009 estimates) have been released and processed by the MCDC.

Note that the Bureau is not planning to release any estimates next year (2011) since they would be vintage 2010 and we are going to have the results of the 2010 census by that time. Who needs estimates when they have actual counts? What they are planning to release, and what we are anxious to see, is a revised set of "inter-censal" figures. These are population estimates at the county level with demographic detail (age, race, sex, Hispanic) for each of the intercensal years 2000 to 2009 that have been adjusted to reflect the results of the 2010 census. We plan to do a report documenting the differences between the original ("post-censal") and these revised figures.

7-13-10: The MABLE database has been updated to include 2009 county level population estimates. Now when you run the **MABLE/Geocorr** web application you will be able to select 2009 population estimate as your weight variable. This makes it very easy to generate reports such as **this one** showing the latest estimates for all counties within CBSA's in a state (Missouri in this example.)

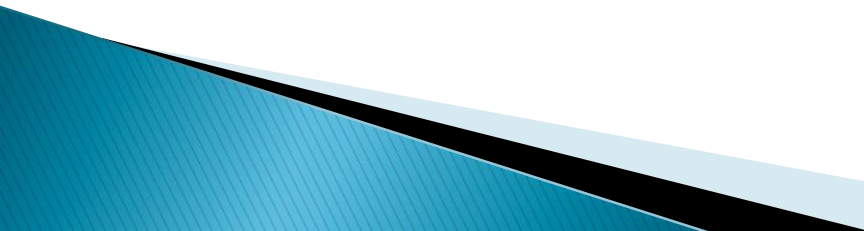

Boone County estimates highlights

- ▶ County grew by **20,531** persons or **13%** since (4-1)2000. July 1, 2009 estimate is **156,377**.
 - ▶ **16,338** of that growth came from Columbia and another **4,236** from the unincorporated areas of the county. Ashland actually lost 24 people. No growth in that area?
 - ▶ The state of Mo grew by only **6%** over the same period.

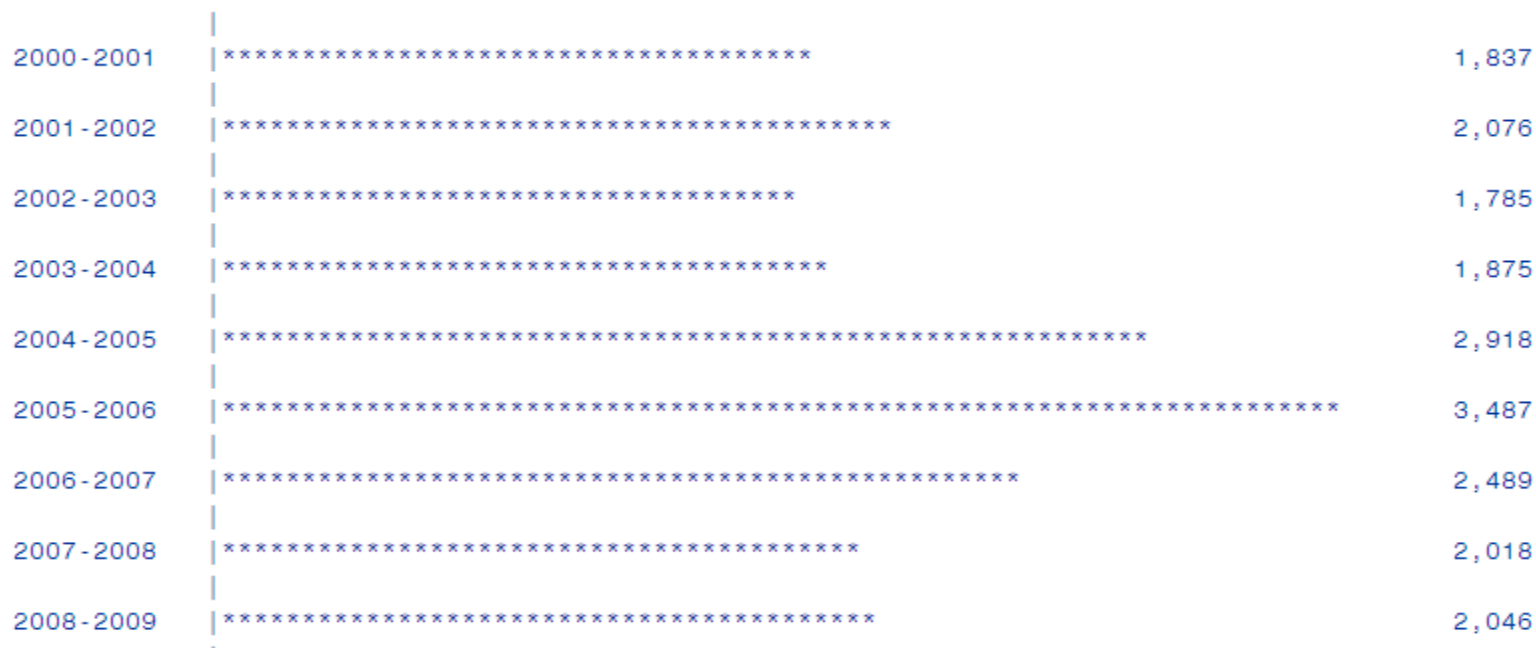

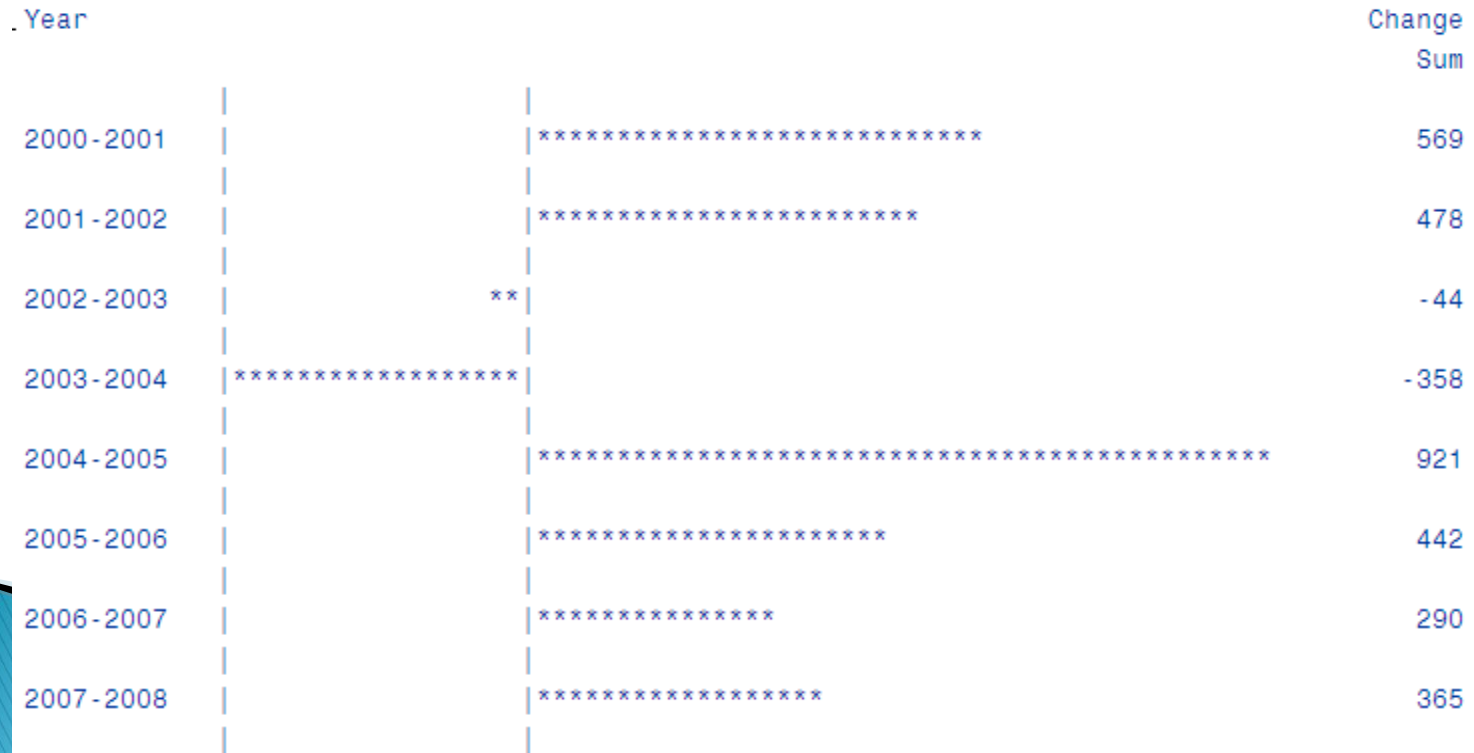


- ▶ County grew by **2,802** persons or **6%** since (4-1)2000. July 1, 2009 estimate is **43,727**.
 - ▶ Over half of that growth came from Fulton (+**628**) and Holts Summit (+**861**), and another **1,154** from the unincorporated areas of the county.
 - ▶ A lot of the growth is in the area across from Jefferson City.
 - ▶ The **6%** growth rate matches that of the state.

Annual Change in Population, 2000 to 2009 Callaway County, MO

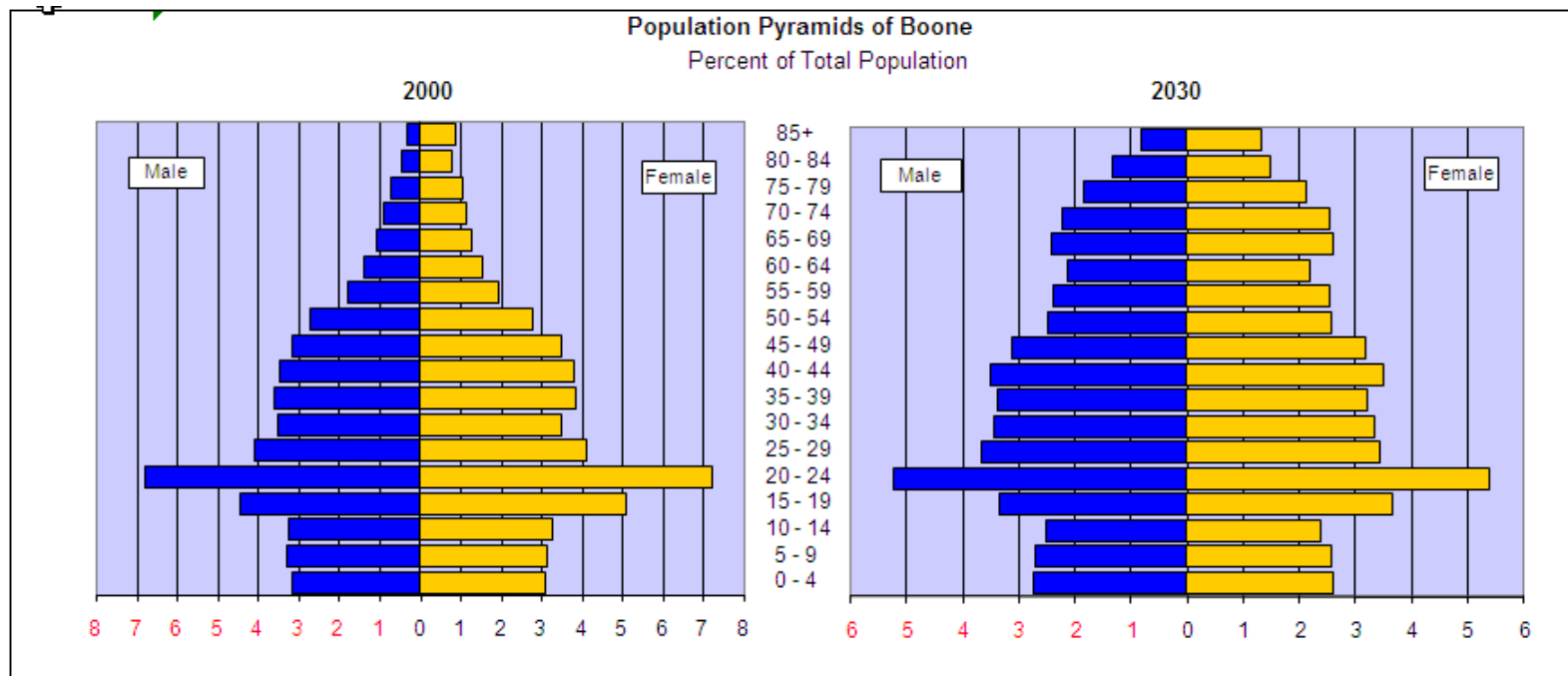

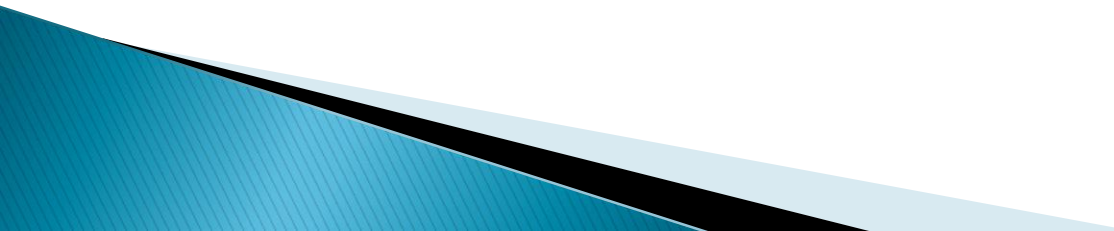
Summary / Highlights

- ▶ Boone county is about 3.5 times larger than Callaway: 156K to 44K (2009 estimates).
- ▶ Columbia has 52% college grads, while Callaway has 52% who never attended college. (Boone has 44.7% college grads).
- ▶ Boone appears to have a bit of a poverty problem but if you ignore “student poverty” it is not serious.
- ▶ Boone has slightly more racial/ethnic diversity than Callaway.
- ▶ Callaway has a significant number of retired persons with relatively low levels of retirement income.
- ▶ Boone is projected to grow faster than Callaway over the next 20 years: in 2030 it will have 204k to Callaway’s 55k. Growth is projected to be much faster in the older cohorts (everywhere).

Coming Soon (more data)

- ▶ **Vintage 2009 ACS data.** Single-year data for areas of 65,000+ pop (Boone, but not Callaway) to be released September 28. **2007–2009 period estimates** next January. **2005–2009 period estimates** due in December (5-year data for all geographies!)
- ▶ First sub-state results of **2010 Census** in March, 2011. The “redistricting” (aka “PL-94”) file by law must be released by April 1.
- ▶ 2010 census only has basic demographics but has it for small geographic areas (down to blocks). No long form, so no data re income, poverty, education, etc. All that comes from the ACS now.
- ▶ ACS data gets reweighted using Census results (for next year’s 2010 vintage data).
