

Violinist EVA SZEKELY has been awarded prizes of excellence in her native Rumania and Italy, and studies with Ivan Galamian and Christine Dethier at the Juilliard School as well as with Franco Gulli at Indiana University. She has concertized extensively in the United States, Canada, Brazil, Chile, Argentina, and Venezuela. Miss Szekely has recorded for CRI and Spectrum Records and is first violinist of the Esterhazy String Quartet and artist in residence at the University of Missouri-Columbia.

Born in New York, DANIEL SCHENE studied piano there and in Charlotte, North Carolina. He has appeared in solo concerto and chamber music concerts across the United States and Canada. Recently he performed with cellist Zara Nelsova and violinist Dénes Kovács. Mr. Schene holds degrees from Indiana University where he was a student of György Sebök, Rebecca Penneys, and Enrica Cavallo-Gulli. He has recently been appointed head of Keyboard Studies at Webster University in St. Louis.

The duo of Eva Szekely and Daniel Schene first performed together in 1976 at Indiana University and has since then appeared regularly on the concert stage.
