## Call for Abstracts and Posters

**The deadline for poster abstract submissions has been extended to October 4, 2010.** Questions about abstract preparation should be directed to Bandhana Katoch: [katochb@missouri.edu](mailto:katochb@missouri.edu). Authors will receive an email notification of receipt within one week of submission.

**Final notification of acceptance for poster presentation submitted for the Missouri Technology Showcase will be made via email within the next two weeks.** Travel expenses and meeting registration remain the responsibility of the author. If you are presenting a poster at the conference you must register for the conference.

### Abstract and Poster Guidelines and Formats

The Program Committee reminds the attendees that the material deemed appropriate for presentation at the symposium should have the following characteristics:

- Original and new scientific work.
- Chosen abstracts will be presented in a poster session.

### Required format for ABSTRACTS

Abstracts submitted must adhere to the following specifications:

- Abstracts are to be authored, co-authored and must be limited to 300 words under the headings of background/hypothesis; materials and methods; results; and conclusions.
- Abstracts should be in English and must be formatted as a Microsoft Word document.

### Authors & Institutions

- Group the authors together - last name followed by first initial and middle initial. Omit academic degrees and titles. End list of authors with a period.
- Group institutions together, and provide institution names, cities, states/provinces. End list of institutions with a period.

### Guidelines for PRINT POSTERS

Poster guidelines for the print version of your poster are very general. The poster boards are 4x4 feet square. Your poster can cover the entire space or whatever portion of the space you choose, but should not exceed the board size.
