To a great extent, the value of your degree depends on how well MU continues its mission of teaching, research and service. Your goodwill and support are essential to secure its future and the success of students who follow you.

The University is more than its buildings, more than its faculty and more than the students present at any one time. The University

consists of all who enter and leave its halls, who are affected by and carry on its pervading principles.

A University and its alumni are inseparable. Graduation day creates a stronger-than-ever bond of mutual interdependence. Your continued interest and concern — and your enthusiastic help beyond today — is important to Mizzou. You are your University.

UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI-COLUMBIA

In the course of its history, the University of Missouri-Columbia has committed itself to three missions: teaching since its founding in 1839 as the first state university west of the Mississippi River, research as part of the land-grant mandate in the late 1800s, and extension services since the early 1900s.

The largest of the four institutions of the University of Missouri System, MU enrolled 22,313 students this year. Mizzou is a complete university, offering its large student body diverse, inclusive training at undergraduate, graduate and professional levels.

The origin of the University can be traced to a clause in the federal Act of 1820, which admitted Missouri to the Union. The act authorized the sale of two tracts of public land with the proceeds earmarked "for the use of a

seminary of learning." The land was sold in the 1830s, and sentiment mounted for the establishment of a university. By 1839 the fund amounted to about \$100,000, and the General Assembly passed two acts that provided for the establishment and location of the University of Missouri. One act specified that the University be built in one of six central counties. The county that offered the greatest inducements in land and money would obtain the University. Boone County won the bid with \$117,921.25 in cash plus land, and in 1839 the University of Missouri was founded in the frontier town of Columbia.

Two momentous changes occurred in 1870. Under terms of the Morrill Act, the University was accorded land-grant status, prompting the legislature to authorize a School of Agriculture and Mechanical Arts for Columbia and to open a second campus to house the School of Mines and Metallurgy at Rolla. The University of Missouri System was created in

1963 with the addition of campuses in St. Louis and Kansas City.

MU has schools and colleges in accountancy; agriculture, food and natural resources; arts and science; business and public administration; education; engineering; fine arts; health related professions; human environmental sciences; journalism; law; library and informational science; medicine; natural resources; nursing; social work; and veterinary medicine.

Mizzou's breadth and depth enables both students and teachers to take an interdisciplinary approach to intellectual inquiry.

The University is a source of pride for all Missourians, setting the standard for higher education in the state and establishing a reputation for excellence known throughout the world.

SCHOOLS & COLLEGES

AGRICULTURE, FOOD & NATURAL RESOURCES

Dr. Roger Mitchell, dean

The mission of the College of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources includes quality teaching, cutting-edge research and the extension of that research to the people of Missouri.

From entering freshmen to postdoctoral scientists, students receive personal attention in preparing for a wide range of careers. Professional development through campus organizations and special interaction with business and industry prepares our graduates to have an impact in the food system, business, government policy, environmental awareness, law, medicine and other areas.

New technology in animal, biochemical, social, plant, food and natural resource sciences is developed through the Missouri Agricultural Experiment Station to keep the state's agribusiness system competitive in world markets and to provide consumers with a safe, low-cost food supply.

Technology reaches the people through the College's Missouri Agricultural Extension Program. State specialists within the College and area specialists in county centers interact with the public for real-life application in problem solving use of research.

Finally, the College helps Third World countries become trading partners by developing their economies through improved agriculture. This also provides a valuable exchange of knowledge and understanding with students, teachers and scientists from many cultures

ARTS & SCIENCE

Dr. Larry D. Clark, dean

The College of Arts and Science, established in 1841, is the oldest and largest academic division in the University, with more than 9,000 students, 29 departments and programs and 400 full-time faculty members.

It provides a wide range of undergraduate and graduate degree programs in the humanities, the arts and the natural and social sciences.

The broad liberal education it offers is a solid foundation for professional or other specialized studies.

The School of Fine Arts, including the departments of Art, Music and Theatre, is a part of the college and contributes to the academic life of the campus and to the cultural life of the University and the community.

The college encourages excellence in teaching and scholarship among its faculty, seeks to provide traditional and innovative undergraduate curricula of the highest quality, and allows a flexibility in individual courses of study that enables its students to take the best possible advantage of the many resources at their disposal.

BUSINESS & PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

Dr. Bruce J. Walker, dean

The College of Business and Public Administration, established in 1914, educates students for their growing responsibilities in business, government and society. The college includes the School of Accountancy (the first established at a major public university), the School of Business (composed of the departments of finance, management and marketing), and the Department of Public Administration.

The educational experiences of the students are enhanced through the scholarly activities of the faculty who conduct research on significant, timely

issues. Students in the college are exposed to relevant theories and concepts applied to real-world operations of private and public enterprises. Students gain added practical insights through internships, field trips, guest speakers and executives-in-residence. Continuing education programs are provided for practitioners in the fields of business, government and accountancy.

EDUCATION

Dr. Richard Andrews, dean

The College of Education is the oldest teacher-education program west of the Mississippi River. The college offers programs leading to a variety of career opportunities in the education profession as well as in education-related human-service occupations.

The bachelor of science in education degree leads to certification to teach at the early childhood, elementary or secondary levels in Missouri as well as most other states through reciprocal agreements. The bachelor of educational studies degree is designed for individuals interested in human-service careers.

In addition to the two undergraduate degrees, the College of Education offers graduate study leading to the master's, educational specialist and doctoral degrees. The college serves the education profession of the state through research studies, continuing education and a variety of services to state and local education agencies.

ENGINEERING

Dr. James E. Thompson, dean

When engineering classes at the University of Missouri began in 1849, a strong tradition was born that continues to grow. Initially part of the College of Agriculture and Mechanical Arts, engineering became a separate unit in 1877. Now the college is the second-largest undergraduate division on campus. It includes the first electrical engineering department established in the nation, the only industrial engineering program in Missouri and a Coordinated Engineering Program located in Kansas City.

The college offers fully accredited degree programs in agricultural, chemical, civil, computer, electrical, industrial and mechanical engineering on the Columbia campus; and civil, electrical and mechanical engineering on the Kansas City campus. Most programs offer undergraduate and graduate degrees. Graduate degrees in nuclear engineering also are offered. Naval science is under the academic administration of the college as well.

Engineering Building East, completed in 1992, houses administrative offices, the engineering library and the Engineering Computer Network, as well as numerous classrooms and student laboratories. The building connects with the renovated 1892 structure, giving the college seven acres under roof for the largest academic building on campus.

Students may participate in any of the 25 student professional and honor societies. The college's Undergraduate Honors Program gives qualified students the unique opportunity to pursue an individualized honors research project, which can provide a smoother transition for those continuing to graduate school. A new Undergraduate Research Fellowship

program provides stipends and research experiences starting at the freshman level. Scholarships provided by alumni, industry and friends make available over \$300,000 each year to qualified students pursuing an engineering degree.

GRADUATE SCHOOL

Dr. John P. McCormick, interim dean

An atmosphere encouraging academic inquiry and stimulating intellectual activity at the University of Missouri-Columbia has been recognized as fundamental to a superior education for graduate students.

The University of Missouri System is the only state-supported institution in Missouri to offer professional and doctoral degrees. Many of these degrees are available only on the Columbia campus. The Graduate School, which offers degree-granting programs in more than 90 departments and areas, is a member of the Association of Graduate Schools and the Council of Graduate Schools. Of 3,976 degree-seeking graduate students, 40 percent are doctoral candidates.

The University granted its first master's degree in 1846. Since that time, more than 49,300 have been conferred. The first doctor of philosophy degree was granted in 1899 and, to date, more than 9,200 have been awarded.

HUMAN ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES

Dr. Bea Smith, dean

The College of Human Environmental Sciences ranks among the top 10 human ecology units in the nation because of its outstanding faculty scholarship and strong programs. Its intellectual commitment is to the relationship of individuals to their immediate social and physical environments in both the private and public sectors. The well-being of youth, families, and communities is the focus of teaching, research and outreach. Undergraduate and graduate programs

are offered in consumer and family economics, environmental design, food science and human nutrition, human development and family studies, textile and apparel management, and social work. Accreditation has been earned by the total College and by individual programs.

Human Environmental Sciences is unique among professional peers in its comprehensive use of advisory boards, drawn from business, government, education and the social services. These experts provide guidance and support from their specialized fields to students and faculty, and contribute powerful perspectives to vanguard curriculum development.

JOURNALISM

Dr. Dean Mills, dean

The University established the world's first School of Journalism in 1908 to strengthen the effectiveness of public communications in a democratic society.

The school's national reputation attracts students from nearly all states and several countries.

Students receive both a broad general education and training in the skills and responsibilities of journalism through daily performance under deadline pressure. They work under faculty supervision on the commercial newspaper, the *Columbia Missourian*; KOMU-TV, an NBC affiliate; and radio station KBIA, a public radio station.

The school's objective is to develop within students an appreciation of the professional journalist's role — to provide society with a basis for understanding and mutual confidence upon which diverse people can find common principles and goals.

LAW

Timothy J. Heinsz, dean

Graduates of the School of Law, established in 1872, serve at the highest levels of local, state and national governments. Law school graduates and faculty members have written the majority of laws that regulate the lives of all Missourians. Faculty scholarship has affected legal change at the national, state and local levels. The Law School is housed in an award-winning, state-of-the-art facility, John K. Hulston Hall.

Courses, materials and teaching approach develop in each student the basic traits that characterize the good and able lawyer: analytic ability, substantive legal orientation, basic working skills, familiarity with legal institutional contexts, awareness of nonlegal environments and ethical concern.

Nearly 80 percent of the graduates practice law in Missouri.

LIBRARY & INFORMATIONAL SCIENCE

Dr. Mary F. Lenox, dean

The School of Library and Informational Science offers the only graduate program in library and information science in Missouri accredited by the American Library Association. The School's two departments, Library Science and Information Science, combine a strong research initiative with a commitment to graduate education for beginning professionals in a rapidly changing information world. Students completing its 36-hour curriculum are awarded the master of arts degree in library/information science. The school offers a statewide extension program and a national continuing education program for those in the field

Alumni are professionals in public, university, school, law, business and other special libraries and information agencies in Missouri, the nation and several countries. The school's placement record of more than 90 percent within one semester of graduation, reflects the strong demand for its graduates.

MEDICINE

Dr. Lester R. Bryant, dean

In 1841 the University established its medical school in affiliation with Kemper College in St. Louis. The first state medical school west of the Mississippi River, the School of Medicine in Columbia was approved in 1872. At first the school offered a basic-science program, and students transferred to other schools for their clinical years. In 1956 the medical curriculum expanded to a full four-year program.

Within the School of Medicine, the School of Health Related Professions was established in 1978 in an effort to meet the increasing need for qualified health professionals in Missouri. The School of Health Related Professions offers degree programs in communicative disorders, occupational therapy, physical therapy, radiologic sciences, nuclear medicine and respiratory therapy.

Thus, the School of Medicine educates physicians and other health professionals of the highest competence through undergraduate, postgraduate and continuing medical education, while the teaching hospital provides highly specialized care for patients from every county in Missouri.

NURSING

Dr. Toni Sullivan, dean

The nursing program began in 1901 with the establishment of Parker Memorial Hospital Training School. The official founding date is 1920, at which time the University assumed full responsibility for the program. The bachelor of science degree in nursing has been offered since 1940, and the master of science degree in nursing has

been offered since 1968. The doctoral degree in nursing began to be offered in 1993-94.

The baccalaureate program prepares students for the general practice of nursing; the masters program prepares advanced-practice nurses for clinical specialist, nurse practitioner, administrator and educator roles. The doctoral program prepares nurse researcher/scholars for clinical, academic and policy roles. The continuing-education program serves practicing nurses throughout the state to update and increase nursing knowledge and skills.

VETERINARY MEDICINE

Dr. H. Richard Adams, dean

Missouri's only College of Veterinary Medicine, established in 1946, has educated more than 2,000 veterinarians. They pursue careers in private practice, industry, government, education and the armed services. Sixty-four new students are enrolled annually in the vigorous four-year curriculum leading to the doctor of veterinary medicine degree.

After two years of fundamental classroom study, students begin rotating through hospitals, clinics and laboratories, where they receive hands-on training in diagnosis, prevention, treatment and control of diseases of animals.

The college is the state's only complete animal-health facility. Its education, research, patient care, diagnostic and public information programs support the state's livestock industry, its companion-animal owners and its veterinary medical practitioners.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic institutions throughout the world have created a variety of customs, including distinctive dress, color and ceremony to indicate the accomplishments of scholars. English traditions originating at Oxford and Cambridge led to the development of American academic regalia. By the 20th century, institutions of higher learning in the United States had adopted a well-defined code of academic costume, which now includes identification of the different academic degrees by distinctive gowns, hoods and colors.

For instance, the baccalaureate gown, generally worn closed, is identified by long, pleated front panels and long, pointed sleeves. The master's and doctoral gowns may be worn open or closed. The master's gown has long sleeves closed at the bottom, and wearers place their arms through an opening in the front of the sleeves. Doctoral gowns are distinguished by velvet panels around the neck and down the front of the gown. On the sleeves are three horizontal velvet bars in black or the colors representing the doctorate.

In the United States, the hood is the most colorful feature of academic regalia. The bachelor's hood, not usually worn, is 3-feet long with a 2-inch-wide velvet edging in a color representing the degree received. The master's hood is 6 inches longer with a 3-inch-wide velvet edging. The doctoral hood, at 4 feet, reaches far down the wearer's back, and is bordered by a 5-inch-wide strip of velvet. The hoods are black on the outside. The lining, which is folded out, bears the official colors of the institution granting the degree. The doctor of philosophy hood from MU has a dark-blue border, for philosophy, with a black-and-gold lining. The border colors represent the degree earned, not the academic major. The doctor of philosophy candidate in engineering, for instance, would wear the dark blue of philosophy on the hood instead of the orange of engineering.

The color of the master's hood, if

worn by an MU master's candidate, may represent either the degree earned, such as white for the master of arts or gold yellow for the master of science, or the candidates's academic discipline. Traditionally, candidates at MU choose the color of their hood based on the discipline. A master of science candidate in nursing, for example, would normally wear the apricot of nursing instead of the gold yellow for the master of science degree.

Because most MU faculty members did their graduate work at institutions other than MU, there is a variety of

academic attire in today's procession. Some degree holders wear no hood because their academic robe symbolizes the degree awarded, as with the scarlet gown of Oxford University. The official robes worn by members of the University of Missouri System Board of Curators are gold.

The standard cap is the mortarboard, always black. It is the custom at MU for the color of the tassels to indicate undergraduate students' academic majors. Doctoral degree candidates wear black or gold tassels; master's candidates wear black.
